How to Charge the Power Bank

- 1. After connecting a general charger or PD adapter to the power bank, the charging mode will automatically start and digital display will light up to show the current battery level. The power bank will then enter normal charging mode with the output current and voltage parameters being displayed. If entering PD mode, the PD indicator will light up; When the powerbank is almost fully charged, the charging current will enter low current charging mode until it is fully charged. When the power bank is fully charged, it will display 100%.
 - and the screen will remain on.
 - To achieve the optimal charging power of 100W or 65W, an E-MARKER cable must be equipped, otherwise the maximum charging power is only 60W

Note: Electrically Marked Cable (E-Mark): A USB Type-C active cable that is packaged with an E-Mark chip. All fully functional Type-C cables should be packaged with an E-Mark (in daily operations, we require current cables above 3A to have an E-Mark chip)

Checking the Remaining Charge

1. Short press to view the current percentage of battery level Note: It is normal for the Juice® Super Max 100W and your device to get warm during charging. They may get even warmer if you use your device to play videos or for gaming while charging.

Charging your Gadgets

Always check the voltage your device can accept before charging with any Juice product, this will ensure full compatibility

- 1. After connecting the PD power bank to your device's cable, the output will automatically turn on, and the digital display will light up to show the current battery level. The power bank will then enter it's discharging state, with the output current and voltage parameters being displayed. If entering PD mode, the PD indicator will light up; If the receiving device is almost fully charged the power bank will enter low current mode, with a charging current of only about 500mAh.
- When the PD power bank automatically stops discharging (Either due to the mobile phone or computer being fully charged or the device is unplugged), the digital display and outputs turn off. The power bank will then enter
- standby mode. To achieve the optimal 100W or 65W charging state, an E-MARKER cable must be equipped, otherwise the maximum charging power is only 60W. (Also confirm that
- your receiving device can support 100W or 65W)

 4. Once charged, simply unplug your device and store your Juice® Super Max power bank until you are ready to use it again. It is strongly recommended you charge the Juice® Super Max before storing. Ensure the power bank is charged fully every 3 months to keep it in optimum condition. Do not store for long periods with zero charge.

Note: Mobile and gadget device manufacturers have different requirements to charge their products, they may also use different cables to charge their devices. These manufacturers may vary the specifications of how to charge a device and they may also introduce other charging methods on their new products, therefore we can not guarantee that the Juice® Super Max 100W power bank will be able to charge all devices. Juice® always suggests that you use the original charging cable included with your device to charge
