
# Safety information

# **Getting started**



- 1. Retractable arch: Extend or shorten the arch.
- 2. Micro SD slot: Play audio from the SD card.
- 3. ON/OFF: Headphone power switch.
- 4. Microphone: Used for voice calls.
- **5. LED status indicator:** Displays Bluetooth and charging status.
- **6. M:** Mode button switches between SD card & Bluetooth modes.

- 7. >/II: Play/Pause button.
- 8. ►► Skip to the next audio track or press & hold to increase the volume level.
- 9. ► Skip to the previous audio track or press & hold to decrease the volume level.
- 10. USB port: Charging socket.
- 11. 3.5mm audio jack (AUX): Connect a 3.5mm audio cable from an audio source such as an mp3 player.

## Charging the headphones

Before use plug the supplied USB cable into a power supply and the charging port (10) of the headphones.

### The LED indicator will show the charging status:

- · Red LED = Charging
- No LED = Charging Complete

Charging time is approximately 3 hours.

When the battery becomes low on charge 4 short beeps every 10 seconds can be heard.

## Switching the headphones on

- **1.** Set the ON/OFF switch (3) to the ON position to power on the headphones.
- 2. Set the ON/OFF switch (3) to the OFF position to power off the headphones.

## Switching modes

**1.** Press the 'M' button (6) to switch between Bluetooth and SD card input modes.

### Volume control

- 1. Press and hold the ►►1 / + button (8) to increase the volume level.
- 2. Press and hold the ►
   button (8) to decrease the volume level.

# Bluetooth operation

### Pairing your device to the headphones

- Firstly you will need to enable the Bluetooth function on your phone or music player. Please refer to the manufacturers instructions to make the device 'discoverable'.
- After the headphones have been fully charged, turn them on by setting the ON/OFF switch to the ON position.
- **3.** Bluetooth pairing mode is indicated by an alternate red & blue flashing LED.
- 4. Search for Bluetooth devices from your phone or music player. The headphones will appear as 'HP8810'. When selected, pairing will take place and the LED indicator will change to a solid blue led.

### Unpairing a bluetooth device

 To unpair a bluetooth device from the headphones refer to your bluetooth devices manufacturer instructions.

## Re-connecting a bluetooth device

Every time the headphones are switched on, they will connect to the nearest, and the last connected device automatically (as long as Bluetooth is enabled on that device).

If the headphones are set to the SD card input when powering off, press the 'M' button (6) to switch to bluetooth mode and the device will automatically connect.

# Listening to music from a bluetooth device

Make sure to fully charge your headphones for 3 hours before the first use.

- 1. After pairing a bluetooth device simply select the music to play on your device as normal and listen through the headphones.
- 2. Press the button ►/III button to begin playback.

  Press again to pause playback.
- 3. Press the button ▶ 1/+ button to skip to the next track. Press the button ► 1/- button to skip to the previous track.

### Answering a call

Follow the below table to operate the headphones with your phone device.

FUNCTION	STATUS	OPERATION
Answercall	Ringing	Short press ►/II
Reject call	Ringing	Long press <b>►/II</b>
Redial last number called	Connected	Short press ►/III twice
Volume up	Conversation mode	Long press►► /+ button.
Volume down	Conversation mode	Long press ◄◄/ - button.




# SD card operation

### Listening to music from an SD card

Follow the below steps to listen to mp3 tracks stored on a Micro SD card.

**1.** Insert a micro SD card into the SD card slot until you hear a click.



Take care to insert the Micro SD card with the top (side with writing) facing towards the other ear cup.

- The input mode will switch automatically when a SD card is insterted, and audio playback will begin from the first track.
- 3. Press the button ►/II button to pause playback.

  Press again to resume playback.
- 4. Press the button ▶► /+ button to skip to the next track. Press the button ► /- button to skip to the previous track.
- **5.** To remove the Micro SD card, press down on the card until you hear a click and the card pops out.

NOTE: Only micro SD cards up to 32GB are supported.



## Warnings

- Read safety instructions before use and adjusting the volume.
- Safe use depends on the exposure time and volume levels
- Volume at 80 dB(A), exposure should be limited to 40 hours a week. At 89 dB(A) exposure should not exceed 5 hour/weeks.
