OPERATION TO LISTEN TO THE RADIO



To turn the radio on, rotate the VOLUME/ON/OFF control until a click is heard. Then, rotate the VOLUME/ON/OFF control to a comfortable level.

Slide the Band switch to the AM or FM position.



Rotate the Tuning control to tune a station.

To turn the unit off, rotate the VOLUME/ON/OFF control until a click is heard.

FM: Extend FM Antenna for best reception AM: Rotate the unit for best reception.

- 3. Tuning Adjust the dial to tune the radio channel

- 5.Telescopic FM Antenna
