LET'S TALK SAFETY Basic Safety Precautions

This air purifier is intended for household use only and NOT for commercial or industrial use.

- Only use the air purifier indoors and keep away from wet areas.
- Keep fingers, hair and loose clothing away from moving parts and openings whilst using the air purifier.
- This air purifier can be operated by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge, if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the air purifier in a safe way and understand the hazards involved. Children shall not play with the air purifier.
- Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children without supervision.
- Always position the air purifier on a flat, stable, solid surface and never over stretch the power cord.
- Position the air purifier where dirty air is not drawn across your body or head while sitting or sleeping.

X Don't

- Place the air purifier near sources of heat, such as stove tops, ovens, radiators, open fires, candles or computers.
- Move or tilt the air purifier when in use.
- Use the air purifier if the power cord or plug is damaged. Please contact our Customer Service Line on 0330 026 8455.
- Use the air purifier if it has been dropped, damaged or left outdoors.
- Run the power cord under rugs, runners or carpets as it can be a trip hazard.
- Pull, carry or trap the power cord under doors or sharp edges.

- Handle the plug or air purifier with wet hands.
- Unplug the air purifier by pulling on the power cord.
- Use the air purifier in an area with toxic/explosive vapours/liquids, oxygen water tanks or near to flammable, combustible materials (lighter fluid, petrol, kerosene, chlorine, bleach and ammonia drain cleaner etc).
- Use the air purifier with incorrect voltage as this may result in damage or injury to the user. The correct voltage is listed on the ratings label.
- Use without all filters in place.

✓ Do

- Inspect the air purifier regularly and remove any dust/dirt build up as this may affect the airflow.
- Keep all openings/grills clear and free from obstruction and sources of heat, and open flames (including candles). Don't attempt to remove blockages with sharp objects as this may cause damage to the air purifier.
- Turn off all controls on the air purifier before disconnecting or connecting the power cord.
- Always replace the fuse in the plug with a 3amp fuse. Always protect the power cable from heat.
- Use only CE approved 13amp extension cords, non-approved extension cords may overheat.
- Take care to arrange the extension cord as it can be a trip hazard.
- Always switch off and unplug the air purifier before performing maintenance or troubleshooting checks.

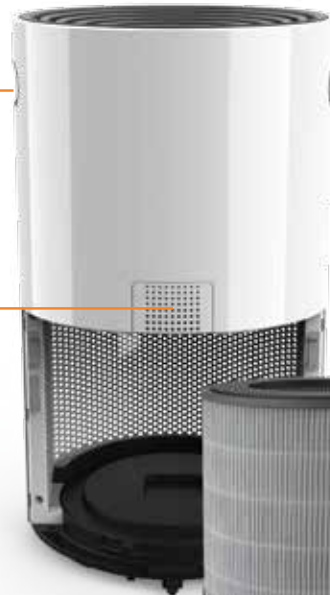

Auto mode

Switches fan speed to auto depending on the air quality indoors.

Switches power to low and dims the lights on the display panel.

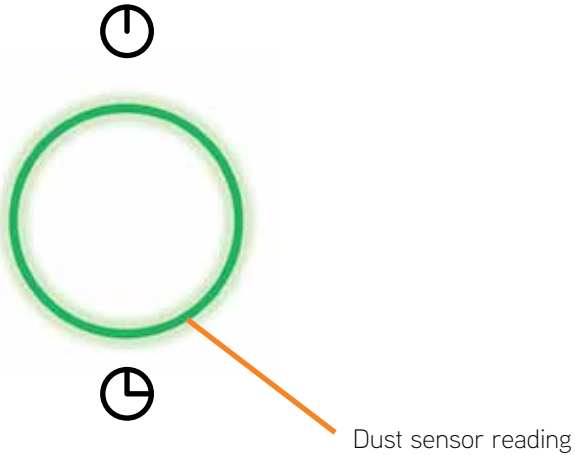

Getting started

IMPORTANT

CHECK the air purifier has a filter. Be sure the supplied filter is properly in place and **all plastic is removed** before turning the air purifier on.

PLACE the air purifier on a hard surface such as the floor, a table or desk. Be sure the grilles are not blocked by other objects, and there are no candles or flames near the air purifier.

PLUG IN into nearest standard electrical outlet.

LIGHTLY TOUCH - the on/off button to switch the air purifier on. Touch the power button again to turn the air purifier off.

SELECT THE FAN SPEED - lightly touch the fan speed button until the desired speed is reached.

ADJUST THE TIMER - lightly touch the timer button to set a run time for 1 hour, 2 hours, 4 hours, 6 hours or 8 hours. The unit will turn off once it runs for the selected hours.

Note: The air purifier will run continuously if no time has been selected.

CHECK FILTER LIGHT - the filter light will illuminate when the filter needs to be replaced. Once the filter has been replaced press the filter replacement indicator for 5 seconds to reset, the filter indicator light will go out. To order a replacement filter visit vax.co.uk

HOW THE AIR PURIFIER WORKS

An air purifier draws in room air from its air inlet, lets the air pass through the filter that consists of a pre-filter and HEPA filter inside of the unit, then releases clean purified air from its air outlet. The air purifier repeats this process by moving its internal fan. As air passes through the HEPA filter, it removes airborne particles such as smoke, dust, pollen, and other potentially harmful particles which could cause allergies, asthma and hay fever.

Choosing a Location

To maximize air circulation, position the air purifier at least 50cm away from walls, or any other large objects that could disrupt the airflow. For optimum results close all windows and doors. For more efficient air treatment, place the air purifier in a central location and make sure the control panel can easily be accessed.

IMPORTANT

This air purifier is equipped with a smart panel that senses your touch. Heavy pushing of buttons is not recommended.

Using your machine

The air purifier can be controlled by using the controls on the air purifier or by using the remote control. When using the remote control always aim towards the control panel on the front of the air purifier

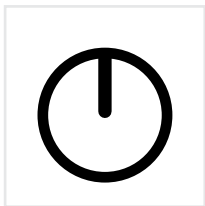
The air purifier will continuously run when all timer lights are off.

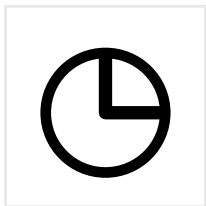
IMPORTANT

The control panel is touch sensitive, lightly press controls.

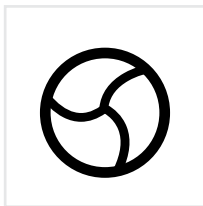


Press on/off control to switch on/off.

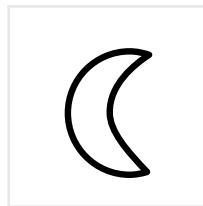
Please note: The air purifier will automatically turn off once the filter cover is removed. The power button will flash and the unit will not turn on until the filter and cover is replaced.



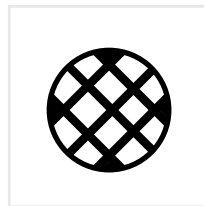
Press timer control. The timer light will illuminate showing the time selected: 1 hour, 2 hours, 4 hours, 6 hours or 8 hours. The air purifier will turn off once the selected time has completed.



Press fan control. The fan speed indicator light will illuminate displaying selected speed.
Auto = The fan speed will automatically adjust depending on the air quality.
L = Low fan speed
M = Medium fan speed
H = High fan speed.



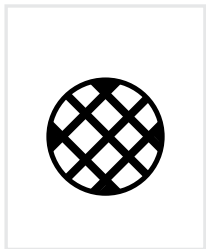
Night mode = Low speed with limited light on the product for easy sleeping. Press the button for night mode. It takes 10 seconds for the lights to go off.



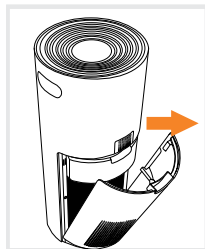
Filter replacement indicator. Press for 5 seconds to reset filter replacement indicator once filter is changed.

Taking care of your machine: replacing the filter

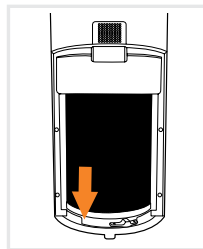
Replace your filter every 3-6 months depending on usage.



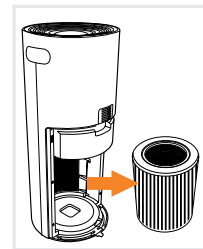
When the filter light is illuminated, switch the air purifier off and unplug it from the power outlet.



Remove filter cover.

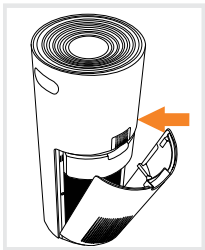


Slide the filter lock to the left. (Unlock position).

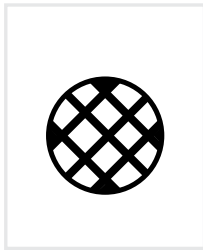


Carefully pull the used filter out. Slide replacement filter into the unit.

Ensure the filter is in the upright position with the open end facing upwards as indicated above.



Lock the filter into place by sliding the filter lock to the right.
Refit the filter cover.



Once the filter has been replaced press the filter replacement indicator for 5 seconds, or until the beep, to reset.

Once the filter cover is removed the power button will flash and the air purifier will not switch on until the filter and cover are replaced.



The filters will need replacing more often when using the air purifier in smoke filled or dusty environments.



Do not wash filters.

CAUTION



What to do if it goes wrong

IMPORTANT Unplug and switch off the air purifier before performing maintenance or troubleshooting checks.

Problem

Why does my air purifier have no power?

Solution

- The plug may not be fully pushed into the electrical socket.
- Check the fuse in the plug. If this needs replacing, always replace with a 3amp British fuse.
- The filter cover may not be secure. Check the filter cover is securely fitted. Go to 'Taking care of your machine'.
- The filter may not be fitted correctly. Check the filter. Go to 'Taking care of your machine'.
- Timer may have finished. Re-set the timer. Go to 'Using your machine'.

Why isn't my fan working?

- Fan speed may be set to L = Low. Change fan speed to desired setting. Go to 'Using your machine'.
- Timer may have finished. Re-set the timer. Go to 'Using your machine'.
- The filter cover may not be secure. Check the filter cover is securely fitted. Go to 'Taking care of your machine'.
- The filter may not be fitted correctly. Check the filter. Go to 'Taking care of your machine'.
- The filter may need replacing. Go to 'Taking care of your machine'.

Why is my air purifier making an excessive noise?

- The air grills may be blocked. Make sure the air inlet is free from any obstruction.
- The filter may need replacing. Go to 'Taking care of your machine'.

Why isn't my remote control working?

- Aim the remote control towards the control panel on the front of the air purifier and press the on/off button.
- The battery may need replacing. Always replace with a CR2025 lithium battery.
