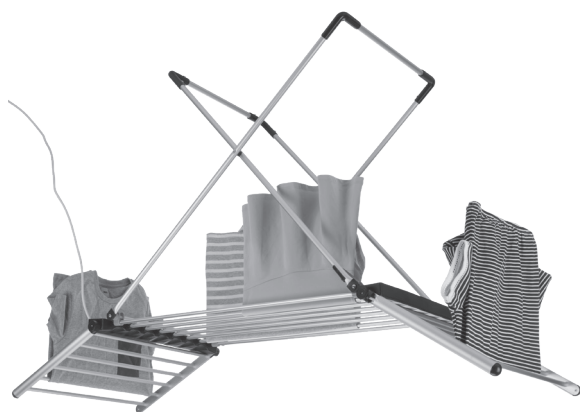




Minky 12m Heated Clothes Airer Instruction Manual



Before using this appliance, please read the following instructions carefully and keep for future reference.

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

1. Do not use this appliance near a shower, bath or a place where it can easily get splashed by water.
2. Keep the power cord away from any parts of the appliance that may become hot during use.
3. Keep the appliance away from other heat emitting appliances.
4. Do not run the power cord under carpets, rugs or anywhere where it may present a trip hazard.
5. Do not immerse the appliance or plug in water or any other liquid.
6. Do not operate the appliance with wet hands.
7. Do not remove from the mains power supply by pulling the cord. Switch off and remove the plug by hand.
8. Do not use the appliance for anything other than its intended use.
9. Do not use the appliance with a programmer, timer, separate remote-control system or any other device that will switch the appliance on automatically.
10. If the power cord is damaged it must be replaced by the manufacturer or qualified electrician in order to avoid a hazard.
11. This appliance can be used by children aged 8 years and above and people with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience or knowledge only if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved.

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12. Do not allow children to play with the appliance.
13. Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children without supervision.
14. This appliance is intended for drying garments washed in water only.
15. Not for use with delicate textiles i.e. silk.
16. Not for use with any non-colourfast garments.
17. When using this product, ensure all garments have been spun well in a washing machine beforehand.
18. Do not leave the appliance unattended whilst connected to the mains supply or when in use.
19. Check that the voltage on the rating plate of the appliance corresponds with your homes electricity supply and that the mains socket is earthed and has the correct rating.
20. Do not use this appliance if the heating elements are damaged.
21. The use of an extension cord with this appliance is not recommended.
22. If the external wire device needs repairing, the power must be completely cut off.
23. Do not move the appliance whilst it is in use.
24. This appliance is intended for domestic use only. It should not be used for commercial purposes.
25. Always unplug the appliance after use and before any cleaning or maintenance.
26. Not to be used outside.
27. Do not load with more than the 16kg weight limit - 11kg on the middle section and 2.5kg per arm.

- 1. Remove the appliance from the packaging
- 2. Store or dispose of the packaging safely

OPERATING THE APPLIANCE

- 1. Ensure the 'Assembling the appliance' instructions have been followed.
- 2. Once the appliance is ready to be used, load the heated arier with damp garments.
- 3. Ensure as much water as possible is removed from the garments beforehand to ensure they do not exceed the maximum weight allowance of 16kg - 11kg on the middle section and 2.5kg per arm.
- 4. When fully loaded, turn the appliance on using the On/Off switch. The button will illuminate indicating that the appliance is turned 'On'.
- 5. Once the garments are dry, turn the appliance off by pressing the On/Off button to the 'Off' position. The illuminated light switch will turn off.
- 6. Remove your garments with care as the appliance may still be hot.

STORAGE

- 1. Simply fold the wings inwards, turn the appliance upside down and slide the leg to the other side.
- 2. The appliance will fold flat for compact storage.

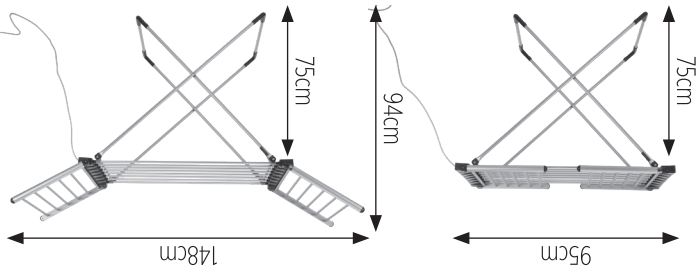
CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

- 1. Before cleaning, ensure the appliance is unplugged from the mains power supply and allow to cool fully.
- 2. Clean the appliance with a soft damp cloth and dry thoroughly.
- 3. No not clean the appliance with scourers or harsh detergents as this could damage the appliance and impair its functionality.
- 4. Do not immerse the appliance into water or any other liquid.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

ASSEMBLING THE APPLIANCE

- 1. The appliance needs to be assembled before plugging into the mains power supply.
- 2. Turn the appliance upside down and move the power supply away from the bars.
- 3. As indicated on the figures below, slowly slide the inside leg towards you until it reaches the end of the rails.
- 4. Turn the appliance the correct way and fold out the wings. The arier should now be free standing.
- 5. The appliance can now be plugged into the mains power supply.
