

Keys' Functions

- Menu Key: Menu key, short press to exit any sub menu and go back to a upper menu, long press to exit and back to main menu.
- 2. HKey: for previous/next track of option.
- 3. **key:** Play/ Pause, also act as confirm key, long press to turn on/off the device.

Turn on/off device

Push the power switch to ON position to turn on the device, to OFF position to turn off the device.

Volume Control

Short press VOL Select key to access volume control menu, and press •• / •• key to adjust volume level.

Connecting with PC

When the device is either at ON or OFF status, use the USB cable that comes with the device to connect to PC to copy files into the device.

Music Mode

While the device shows Music, press the ▶ key to go into

Music Play: Short press **■** key to start playing, and short press again to pause.

Change Tracks: While playing music, short press **★** / **★** to change to previous/next track..

Fast rewind/fast forward: Long press ₩/₩for fast rewind or fast forward.

VOL Control: Short press M to show volume control window, and press m or m key to decrease or increase volume.

FM Radio

While the device shows FM, press **n** key to access FM radio function.

Scan Stations

When the device is at FM radio function, long press or for backward or forward scanning, the device will stop scanning when it scans a station. Short press for manually fine tune scanning.

System Setting

While the device shows SETTING, short press the M key to enter the system setting and press the M or M key choose sub menus like TIME, SW VERSION, LANGUAGE (only support English), Default Settings, Format Device, Factory Reset, Backlight time, user can short press

• key to access any of these sub menus and set up accordingly.
