


Important - Please read these instructions fully before use





Let's get started

Power source

Unwind the main adaptor cable to its full length. Connect the end of the cable to the DC IN Socket at the rear of the unit and then connect to the mains adapter to the mains socket.

General operation

Unwind the wire antenna to its full length.

Press (a) to turn the radio on and the display will show "WELCOME".

When DAB mode is activated for the first time, a scan will automatically commence and will play the first station once finished.

If you can receive a DAB signal in your location, the unit will synchronise to the current local time.

Adjust the wire antenna to get good reception if need.

- Press on to switch the unit to ON mode.
- Press (2) to switch the unit back to STANDBY mode.
- Please turn the unit off completely to save energy when not in use

Selecting modes

Press and hold MODE/ MENU to switch between Digital Radio & FM modes.

Adjusting the Volume

Press VOL+ or VOL - to increase/decrease the volume.

Sleep:

The device features a sleep timer function, which switches the radio off after a certain time if no actions have been performed up until then.

- 1. In Standby mode, press and hold (button into Sleep timer selection.
- 2. Press PREV/NEXT to select either OFF-10-20-30-40-50-60-70-90 minutes.
- 3. Press ENTER to confirm your selection.

System settings

Press MODE /MENU to access the menu and then press ENTER to select SYSTEM.

Time

1) Set Time

Press PREV/NEXT to select hour/min/date/month/year, then press ENTER to confirm and saved.

2) Update

Press PREV/NEXT to select 'ANY' or 'DAB' or 'FM', or 'NONE', then press ENTER to confirm.

Please note the time is displayed in 24hr format only. It is not possible to change to 12hr am/pm format.

Let's get started

Dimmer

Press PREV or NEXT to select from "High", "Medium", or "Low" and press ENTER to confirm.

Factory reset:

Press PREV or NEXT select "Y or N" and press ENTER to confirm.

Alarm setting

Note: Check that the radio has the correct time and date before you set an alarm.

- 1. At Standy mode, press $\binom{p_1}{8}$ or $\binom{p_2}{8}$ into Alarm setting.
- 2. Wake Up time: press PREV/NEXT to select hour/min and press ENTER to confirm.
- 3. Source: press PREV/NEXT to select Buzzer / DAB /FM and press ENTER to confirm. When selecting Digital Radio or FM, the radio will play the station that was last listened to as the alarm.
- 4. Frequency: Press PREV/NEXT to select Daily, Once, Weekends or Weekdays, press ENTER to confirm.
- 5. Volume: 1-16, Press PREV/NEXT to select and press ENTER to confirm.

Press PREV/NEXT to select OFF or ON and press ENTER to confirm and saved.

Note: Once the alarm sounds, press SNOOZE/DIMMER to delay the alarm for another 5 mins. The radio will go to Standby mode.

To cancel a sounding alarm, or an alarm in snooze, press 😩

DAB Operation

Press and hold MODE / MENU to switch to DAB mode.

The DAB mode will automatically be selected and the first time the radio is connected to the supply the radio will perform a quick scan. The display will show a slide bar that indicates the progress of the scan, the name of the last station found and the total number of stations found so far.

When the scan is finished the radio will play the first alphanumerically found station. If the radio does not find any stations, 'NO DAB' displayed. Press NEXT to scan again.

To listen to all stations that have been stored use the PREV and NEXT button to scroll through them. Press ENTER when on the required station.

Let's get started

The radio will display station information when you press ENTER. Press multiple times to view all information available.

When you turn on the radio again after it switching off, it will automatically tune to the same station (DAB or FM) that was last selected.

Remarks: In DAB mode, the radio will synchronize with the time and date of the station

Station information for DAB Radio

Signal Strength: Displays a signal bar with the strength of the current station.

PTY (Programme Type): shows the type and description of the program provided by the DAB station.

Station name: Shows station name

Channel and Frequency: Displays the station's transmission channel number and frequency.

Signal Error : Provides details of the signal error rate.

Bit Rate : The date rate which the signal is being transmitted. Time : Shows the hour/min/sec

Time : Shows the hour/min/sec Date: shows DD/MM/YEAR

How to store a preset station (DAB /FM)

Up to 40 DAB+ and 40 FM presets can be stored. To store a station that you are currently playing: Press and hold $\stackrel{\text{\tiny de}}{=}$ or $\stackrel{\text{\tiny de}}{=}$. 'Empty' will show on the display, press ENTER, the display will then show 'Stored'.

Press and hold PRESET, press 'PREV' or 'NEXT' button to select the number (1-40) you want to store the station as. Then press ENTER to save. The display will then show 'Stored'.

How to recall a preset radio station (DAB/FM)

Press $\binom{p}{a}$ or $\binom{p}{a}$ into preset 1 or preset 2 to play the stored station.

Press PRESET, and press PREV / NEXT to scroll through your preset stations. Press ENTER button to confirm.

SCAN

Press MODE/MENU, SCAN will display, then press ENTER to start full scan.

Manual Scan

Select "Manual" by pressing ENTER to choose from 5A 174.928mhz to 13F 239.200mhz, then press ENTER to play.

DRC

Select 'DRC' by press ENTER and press PREV/NEXT to select DRC off/DRC high/DRC low, then press ENTER to confirm.

Prune

If want to delete such stations without signal in the station list, press ENTER, select 'Y' or 'N' by press PREV/NEXT button, then press ENTER to confirm.

Let's get started

FM Operation

Press and hold MODE/MENU to switch to 'FM' mode. The first time you do this, FM frequency '87.5 MHz' will be displayed on the screen.

Press MODE/MENU, SCAN will display, then press ENTER to start full scan, then the stations will be stored at Preset, and play the first station.

Press PREV / NEXT can scan back or forward by each 0.05mhz.

The radio will display station information when you press ENTER, press multiple times to view all information

Scan setting

Press MODE/MENU button to step into, then press NEXT to select 'Setting', press ENTER to

Press NEXT to select DISTANT' or 'LOCAL', then press ENTER to confirm.

Audio setting

Press NEXT to select 'Stereo' or 'Mono', then press ENTER to confirm.

Station information for FM Radio

Signal Strength: Displays a signal bar with the strength of the current station.

PTY (Programme Type): shows the type and description of the program provided by the FM station


Station name: Shows station name.

Audio Type: Displays the audio type of the station you are listening to. It will either be stereo

or mono.


