Step 1


Fitting dowels

a: Insert cross dowel for into the hole on top of each leg 1.

Note: Ensure the horizontal marking on each cross dowel is facing out as shown.

b: Insert threaded bolt **B** into the hole on each leg **1**.


Tighten threaded bolt **B** into the hole of cross dowel **A** that are already concealed in each leg **1** as shown.



Step 2

Attaching legs

a: Lay table top 2 on a flat, stable, clean and soft surface.

Step 2 - continued

b: Attach leg 1 onto table top 2 by inserting bolts B into the pre-drilled holes of metal corner bracket as shown.


b: Insert flat washer **(C)**, lock washer **(D)** and hex nut **(E)** onto the two threaded bolts **(B)** on leg **(1)** and in order as shown.


○ followed by **○**. **○** followed by **○**.

Tighten top hex nut then tighten bottom hex nut using spanner as shown.

Note: Do not over tighten.

Repeat Step **b** and **c** with the remaining 3 legs.





Step 3

Stand the table upright

Turn thumbscrews clockwise to lock table top in place.

With help, carefully stand dining table upright.



Important:

LOCK table top before righting the table.



Warning:

The dining table is heavy.
Lift with care.

Step 4

Extending table

a: Locate thumbscrews under table ends and turn counterclockwise until clear of locking holes on underside of table top.

Pull table top apart as shown, until butterfly leaf is clearly visible underneath.




Important:

UNLOCK table top before extending the table.

Pull top piece of butterfly leaf up and lay flat as shown.


Step 4 - continued


b: Push ends of table inwards until no gap is visible.

Note: Make sure dowels line up with holes on mating panel to avoid damage.

C: Turn thumbscrews clockwise to lock table top in place.

Note: To close table, reverse the procedure.





Step 1


Attaching aprons

Position aprons 4 and 5 onto back leg frame 1.

Note: Ensure the tenons are aligned correctly with mating back leg frame to avoid damage.

Fix aprons 4 and 5 to back leg frame 1 using 4 bolts A as shown.

Use allen key **D** to turn fitting **A** clockwise to fix.




Step 2

Attaching front leg frame

Position front leg frame 2 onto aprons 4 and 5.

Note: Ensure the tenons are aligned correctly with mating front leg frame to avoid damage.




Step 3

Fixing front leg frame

Carefully stand chair upright.

Fix front leg frame 2 to aprons 4 and 5 using 2 bolts A as shown.

Use allen key to turn fitting A clockwise to fix.




Step 4

Placing seat pad.

a: Place seat pad 3 on a flat, stable, clean and soft surface as shown.

b: Lower the constructed chair frame onto seat pad **3** as shown.

Note: Ensure wooden locator block is inside front leg frame 2 as shown.



Step 5

Fixing seat pad.

a: Insert 2 seat brackets
into the slots on aprons 4 and 5 as shown.


Note: Align holes on seat brackets © with holes on seat pad 3.

b: Insert 2 bolts B into the holes of seat brackets and the holes of mating seat pad 3 as shown.

Use allen key to turn fitting B clockwise to fix.

Repeat complete process for second chair.

Assembly is complete.
