

- Check you have all the components and tools listed on pages 3 and 4.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.

#### Care and maintenance


- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do not use bleach or abrasive cleaners.



#### Tools required



Flatblade screwdriver (Medium)



Hammer



Phillips screwdriver (Medium & large)

#### Ruler - Use this ruler to help correctly identify the screws

### Step 1

Knock down the Dowels A into the holes indicated on top/bottom 3 and the back plinth 4 using a small hammer.

Press the magnets M into holes indicated.


### Step 2

Fix the support for hanger rail L to the sides 1 and 2 using screws T.

Fix the crossplates P to the sides 1 and 2 using the premounted screws. See details. position the crossplate exactly as shown.

Screw the bolts D into the holes indicated.

Fix the angles V to the sides1 and 2 using screws E. Place the angles as shown.
See details.




### Step 3

Place the sides 1 and 2 onto the top 3, the back plinth 4 and the bottom 3


Push cams into holes indicated, arrows pointing towards sides.

Turn the cams C to the right to fix the top and bottom 3 and the back plinth 4.
See details.



## Step 4

Fix the front plinth 5 onto the angles V using screws E.



### Step 5


Place the backs 7 into rebates in the sides 1,2 and into the H-profile 15.



Important!
Make sure the angle between the top and the sides is 90° when the back is attached.

Fix the backs to the sides 1,2, the top 3 and the back plinth 4, using nails i.

Use the nail holder Yd and a small hammer.




### Step 6

Place the cup hinges Q into the holes indicated on the doors 8.

Fix the hinge Q using screws T.


Place the magnet catches N in the holes indicated on doors 8, using a small hammer.




### Step 7

Place the top rail 6 onto the top 3.

Fix the top rail to the top using angles W and screws T







### Step 8

Place the hanger rail 10 into the support L.

To fix the doors 8, slide the cup hinges Q onto the crossplates P. Fix the hinges using the pre-mounted screw in the crossplates. See details.

Fix the wooden knobs G to the doors using screws R.




## Step 9



Warning! The wardrobe is heavy. Lift with care.

Its recommended that the wardrobe is fixed to the wall.

Use the fittings J. Follow the instruction included with the fittings.



#### Step 10

## Adjusting the doors left/right.

a:

To adjust the door towards the left hand side - turn the adjusting screw to the right.

b:

To adjust the door towards the right hand side - turn the adjusting screw to the left.

## Adjusting the doors forwards/backwards.

a:

Loosen the fixing screw.

b:

Push the cup hinge/the door forwards or backwards to adjust.

c:

Tighten the fixing screws of ALL the crossplates.

## Adjusting the doors up/down.

a:


Loosen the two pre-mounted screws of each crossplates, BUT ONLY as much as it will allows the crossplates to move up and down.

b:

Push the door up or down to adjust.

c:

Tighten the pre-mounted screws of ALL crossplates.
