




Fitting a replacement plug

Should it become necessary to replace the mains plug please follow this diagram.

The BROWN wire must be connected to the LIVE (L) terminal. The BLUE wire must be connected to the NEUTRAL (N) terminal.





#### **IMPORTANT** - Please read these instructions fully before installing or operating



#### Unpacking and handling

Open the carton carefully and remove the polystyrene packing. Carefully lift the TV out and place onto a firm stable surface. Lift off the poly bag and retain all packaging for future use. Keep all packaging away from small children and animals. Remove Energy Efficiency label from the screen, this should peel easily, do not use any tool to remove this label.



#### Base fitting

This TV is supplied with a separate base to reduce packaging. See Page 23 for fitting instructions and wall mounting.



#### Positioning your TV

The TV should be placed on a firm table or shelf. If placing in a cabinet ensure there is sufficient spacing for air flow: 10cm above and 20cm at each side.



#### Ventilation slots

Do not allow objects to be dropped inside the ventilation slots, this could cause a short circuit and a possible fire. Do not allow chains to be dangled into the TV, a serious electrical shock may occur.



#### Ventilation and heat sources

Do not place material over the ventilation slots, this will cause the TV to overheat and fail. Do not place the TV in direct sunlight or near heat sources such as radiators or fires.



#### Connections

When connecting the TV to external sources and the mains supply do not place wires that can be tripped over. Do not trap or place heavy objects on the mains cable.



#### Candles and open flames

Do not place lighted candles (such as tealights) on the top or at the sides of the TV, or any other naked flame near the TV cabinet.



#### **Disconnection device**

Where the mains plug or appliance connector is used as the disconnection device, the disconnection device shall remain operable and must be accessible at all times. To be completely disconnected from the mains supply, the mains plug must be removed from the socket completely.



#### Moisture


#### Using the remote control

- Point the remote control at the REMOTE SENSOR on the TV
- The recommended operating distance is up to 3 metres (10 feet)
- Bright sunlight shining onto the remote sensor may cause the TV not to respond correctly



#### Battery fitting

- Open the battery cover
- Fit 2 x AAA batteries. Ensure the battery polarities are correct (+ to +, - to -)
- Replace the battery cover





#### Switching on for the first time

Once you have mains power and an aerial connected, you are ready to switch your TV on and complete the setup and tuning:

No signal? Missing channels? Picture breaking up? Sounds like an aerial issue...

Digital Freeview requires a fairly strong, high quality aerial signal to work fully: a professionally installed outdoor aerial system is recommended.

An indicator of an inadequate aerial signal is the picture and/or sound breaking up, channels missing, or no channels found at all. If tuning to a satellite system, such as Sky, remember to choose ATV as the Auto Scan type.


# **Product Support**

#### Fitting the base stand

To minimise packaging the stand is packed separately as two parts.

Before you begin, check all the stand parts are included:

- 1 x Stand base
- 1 x Stand stem
- 4 x Base screws (short)
- 4 x Stem screws (long)
- Place TV, screen down, on a suitable scratchfree surface.
- Insert the base stem into base of cabinet and secure using supplied screws (x 4)
- Locate the base onto the 4 screw mounts.
- Once in position use the supplied screws (x 4) to secure.






