Assembly Instructions

Step 1

Fixing to wall.

It is recommended that the unit is fixed to a wall.

Mark fixing hole on wall.

Fasten wall strap (A) to the wall using a suitable wall screw/plug system.



Warning: Before drilling, check wall for hidden pipes and cables.


Step 2
