Step 1

Prepare the drawer front

Screw 2 metal dowels B into the drawer front **4**.

Note: Tighten the metal dowels up fully against the panels.



Step 2

Prepare the drawer sides

Insert a small locking nut C into the hole shown on the left drawer side **5** and the right drawer side 6.

Note: The arrow on the locking nut **must** point towards the hole in the edge of the panel.


Step 3

Attach the drawer sides to the drawer front


Push the left drawer sides **5** and right drawer sides 6 onto the back of the drawer front 4.


Turn the small locking nuts **C** on the left drawer side 5 and right drawer side 6.

Note: Turn the locking nuts C clockwise to secure panels - more than 1/2 a turn.










Step 4

Fit the drawer base

Slide the drawer base **8** down the grooves in the drawer sides **5** and **6** and down into the groove in the drawer front **4**.



Step 5

Fit the drawer back


Fit the drawer back **7** between the drawer sides **5** and **6**. Make sure that the drawer base **8** fits into the groove in the drawer back **7**.


Hold the drawer back **7** in position and tap the knock-in pegs **()** through the holes in the drawer sides **5** and **6**.

Step 6

Fit the wedgefixes

Turn the drawer assembly over and slide 2 wedgefixes **1** into the front and back grooves, as shown, and tighten up the screws.









Prepare the left side

a: Place a runner **J** on the left side **1** as shown. Slide back the top of runner and use the 2nd hole from the front to fit the 1st screw **F**.

b: Slide the runner **J** back the other way and fit the 2nd screw **F** into the corresponding hole in the left side **1**.

Screw 4 metal dowels **B** into the left side **1**.





Prepare the right side

a: Place a runner **J** on the right side **2** as shown. Slide back the top of runner and use the 2nd hole from the front to fit the 1st screw **F**.

b: Slide the runner **J** back the other way and fit the 2nd screw **F** into the corresponding hole in the right side **2**.

Screw 4 metal dowels **B** into the right side **2**.



Step 9 Prepare the top and the base Insert 4 large locking nuts **D** into the top **3** 3 and 4 into the base 3. 

Use a screwdriver to tighten the 4 large locking nuts **D** fitted to the top **3** and base **3**.

Fit the back


a: Square up the unit by making sure that measurement **x to x** equals y to y.

b: Place the back **9** onto the unit.

Nail **G** around the outside edges of the back **9**.

Note: Nails should be evenly spaced out.

a: The measurement from top corner X to bottom corner X must be equal to the measurement from top corner Y to bottom corner Y




Step 14

Fit the 4 plastic nails

Tap 2 plastic nails (A) into the bottom edge of each of the sides 1 and 2.

Stand the unit up for the next step.



Step 15

Fit the drawer

Slide both the runners forward and locate the drawer sides **5** and **6** between them, lining up the holes in the drawer wrap with the 2nd 'threaded' holes in the runners **1**.

Working from the inside of the drawer, insert 2 screws (a) through the drawer sides and out into the 2nd threaded hole in the runner.

Note: Do not overtighten the screws **(B)**. If they catch on the runner you may need to loosen them slightly.

Step 1

Prepare the 4 drawer fronts

Screw 2 metal dowels B into each of the drawer fronts **5**.

Note: Tighten the metal dowels up fully against the panels.



Step 2

Prepare the drawer sides

Insert a small locking nut **C** into the hole shown on the left drawer side **6** and the right drawer side 7.

Note: The arrow on the locking nut **must** point towards the hole in the edge of the panel.



Fit the wedgefixes

Turn the drawer assemblies over and slide 4 wedgefixes **(K)** into the front and back grooves, as shown, and tighten up the screws.










Prepare the left side

a: Place 4 runners **J** on the left side **1** as shown. Slide back the top of runner and use the 2nd hole from the front to fit the 1st screw **F**.

b: Slide the runner **J** back the other way and fit the 2nd screw **b** into the corresponding hole in the left side **1**.

Screw 6 metal dowels **B** into the left side **1**.





a: Place 4 runners **J** on the right side **2** as shown. Slide back the top of runner and use the 2nd hole from the front to fit the 1st screw **F**.

Screw 6 metal dowels **B** into the right side **2**.



Insert 4 large locking nuts **D** into the top **3**.



Push the top **3** onto the right side **2**.

Use a screwdriver to tighten the 2 large locking nuts **D** fitted to the top **3**.

Note: Turn the large locking nuts **D** as far as they will go - more than 1/2 a turn.





Prepare the 4 rails

Insert 2 large locking nuts **()** into each of the 4 rails **(4**).

Tap 2 wooden dowels (A) into each of the 4 rails (4).

Note: Wooden dowels **must not** stick out from the edge by more than 10mm or they may damage other panels.






Step 12

Fit 3 of the rails

Push 3 rails **4** onto the right side **2**.

Use a screwdriver to tighten the 3 large locking nuts **D** fitted to the 3 rails **4**.






Fit the last rail

Push the last rail **4** onto the right side **2**.

Use a screwdriver to tighten the large locking nut **D** fitted to the last rail **4**.




Note: Support this rail until the left side has been fitted in the next step.

Step 14

Fit the left side

Push the left side **1** onto the assembly.

Use a screwdriver to tighten the 6 large locking nuts **D** fitted to the top **3** and rails **4**.

Fit the back


a: Square up the unit by making sure that measurement **x to x** equals y to y.

b: Place the back **10** onto the unit.

Nail **G** around the outside edges of the back **10**.

Note: Nails should be evenly spaced out.

a: The measurement from top corner X to bottom corner X must be equal to the measurement from top corner Y to bottom corner Y



Fit the 4 plastic nails

Tap 2 plastic nails into the bottom edge of each of the sides **1** and **2**.




Fit the drawers

Starting with the bottom drawer, slide both the runners forward and locate the drawer sides and 7 between them, lining up the holes in the drawer wrap with the 2nd 'threaded' holes in the runners f.

Working from the inside of the drawer, insert 2 screws (a) through the drawer sides and out into the 2nd threaded hole in the runner.

Note: Do not overtighten the screws **(B)**. If they catch on the runner you may need to loosen them slightly.


Step 1

Prepare the left side

Screw 6 metal dowels **B** into the left side **1**.

Push a rail holder (K) into the left side 1. Make sure that it is fitted straight, in line with the panel edges and then secure with screw (F).

Fit 3 hinge plates **(M)** onto the left side **1**, making sure that the slot is facing towards the finished front edge.



Screw 4 metal dowels **B** into the right side **2**.

Fit 3 hinge plates **(M)** onto the right side **(2)**, making sure that the slot is facing towards the finished front edge.

Fit the back panels

a: Square up the unit by making sure that measurement **x:x equals y:y.**

Place the small back **11** and large back **12** down, onto the unit as shown.

Make sure that the 2 backs are pushed up tight against each other and that they meet in the centre of the divider's back edge. **a:** The measurement from top corner X to bottom corner X must be equal to the measurement from top corner Y to bottom corner Y



b: Nail **1** around the outside edges of the 2 backs.


Note: Do not nail where the 2 backs meet and nails should be spaced about 150mm apart.

C: Push the 5 nail screws (c) through the 5 back holders (f) and tap them down between the small back (1) and large back (12) and into the back edge of the divider (3).

Keep tapping the nail screws **G** in until the back holders **H** dig into the small and large back.

Stand the unit up for the next step.

Note: If ever you need to take the backs off to dismantle the unit, the nail screws can be taken out using a screwdriver.



Step 16

Fit the 3 doors


Note: The easiest way to attach each door **9** and **10** is to fit the top hinge first, then align and fit the other hinges.

a: Push the hinge **N** onto the front part of the hinge plate **M**. The recess at the bottom of screw B goes into the slot in the hinge plate.

b: Keep the hinge **N** FLAT against the hinge plate **M** as you slide it across as far as it will go. Tighten screw A.

C: The hinge **N** must be flat against the hinge plate **M** prior to any adjustment.

d: The hinge N must NOT be AT AN ANGLE to the hinge plate N when assembled. This would indicate that the recess at the bottom of screw B had not located in the slot in the hinge plate and the hinge would not be secure. Remove the hinge from the hinge plate and then re-assemble being careful to follow instructions a-c.



Step 17

Adjust the doors if needed

a: Before adjusting the doors, use a spirit level to check the base (or top) of the unit is level, front-to-back and side-to-side in the 3 positions shown. Use suitable packing pieces (not supplied) to make the unit level BEFORE making any adjustment to the hinges, as shown.

b: Height adjustment.


Loosen screws A on hinge plates and move door up or down as required. Retighten screw A.

C: Forward and Back adjustment.

Loosen screw B on hinge plate and move door in or out as required. Retighten screw B.

d: Sideways adjustment.

To move door 'out' loosen screw C. To move door 'in' tighten screw C.


Fit the overbalance protector
