

SPECIFIC SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Do not touch hot surfaces. Use handle or knobs. The outer surfaces may be become hot when the oven is on.
- To protect against electric shock, do not immerse cord, plug, or any parts of the oven in water or other liquids.
- Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.
- Do not place on or near a hot gas hob, electric burner, or in a heated oven, or in a microwave oven.

- The use of accessory or attachments other than supplied may cause damages and injuries.
- When operating the oven, keep at least 10cm of space on all sides of the oven to allow for adequate air circulation.
- Unplug from the mains when not in use, or before cleaning. Allow it to cool before replacing parts or before cleaning.
- Do not cover CRUMB TRAY or any part of the oven with metal foil. This may cause the oven to overheat.
- Use extreme caution when removing tray or disposing of hot grease or other hot liquids.
- Do not clean with metal scouring pads.
 Pieces can break off the pad and touch electrical parts, creating a risk of electric shock.
- Oversized foods or non-metal utensils must not be inserted into the oven as they may create a fire or risk of electric shock.
- Extreme caution should be exercised when using containers constructed if anything other than metal or glass.

- Do not place any of the following materials in the oven: cardboard, plastic, paper or any other flammable materials.
- Do not store any materials, other than manufacturer's recommended accessories in this oven.
- Always wear protective, insulated oven mitts when inserting or removing items from the hot oven.
- Do not use outdoors.
- The glass Door cannot support goods in the open position.
- To reduce the risk of fire or shock, do not operate unit unless the removable top tray is in place.
- If the electric circuit is overloaded with other appliances, this appliance may not operate properly. The Toaster Oven should be operated on a separate electrical circuit from other operating appliances.
- The temperature of accessible surfaces may be high when the appliance is operating.

- A fire may occur if the appliance is covered or touching flammable material, including curtains, draperies, walls, and the like, when in operation.
 Do not put any items on top of the appliance when in operation.
- All containers placed inside the oven must not be airtight. Also, they need to have enough room to allow for expansion of fluids.
- Clean this appliance regularly as build up of grease may cause a fire. Make sure that this appliance is not placed near curtains, any drapery, or other flammable material.
- In order to prevent accidental burns, always use the handle and knobs to operate this appliance.
- The temperature of the door or outer surface may be high when the appliance operating
- The oven should be cleaned regularly and any food deposits removed. Failure to maintain the oven in a clean condition could lead to deterioration of the surface that could adversely affect the life of the appliance and possibly result in a hazardous situation.


- The appliances are not intended to be operated by means of an external timer or separate remote-control system.



BEFORE USING YOUR OVEN


- Before using your oven for the first time, be sure to:
- Remove all racks and trays. Wash in hot soapy water or in dishwasher
- 3. Thoroughly dry all accessories and re-assemble in oven.
- 4. Place Oven on a flat counter or other stable surface.

NOTE: Do not operate on the same circuit with another appliance.

 Position the Oven so that it is at least 10cm from any surrounding objects. Ensure that nothing has been placed on top of the Oven. Plug the Power Cord into the mains socket.

NOTE: Make sure your local voltage is 230V/240V~, 50Hz.



- 6. After re-assembling your oven, turn the Temperature Knob (A) to 230°C and turn the Timer Knob (D) to 15 minutes to eliminate any oil coatings on parts after production.

 See fig. 2.
- NOTE: The oven may smoke during this process. This is normal for a new Oven and will not last more than 15 minutes
- warning: Foils used to cover items during cooking should not be allowed to come into direct contact with the elements

ABOUT CONTROL SETTINGS

Time Setting

Timer Range 0-60 Minutes: The Timer can be set up to 60 minutes. The oven will not turn "on" without the timer being set. When the Timer Knob ① is in the "off" position, the oven will not operate. To set the time, turn the knob to the desired time. Indicator Light ② is lit only when Time has been set.

When the Timer reaches the off position, a bell will sound and the oven will switch off automatically.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

Stay On Time - If you have not finished cooking you can set the Time Knob ① to "Stay On" and the oven will stay on. It will Not Turn Off automatically. To turn off you need to manually turn the Timer Knob ① to the off position until you hear the bell ring. See fig. 3.

WARNING: Close supervision is necessary for the stay on setting.

Adjusting Time


 The Timer can be changed during cooking. Adjust the timer to the desired time and continue cooking.

Temperature Setting

 Turn the Temperature Knob (A) to the desired temperature setting.
 The temperature can be set from 70°C to 230°C.




Indicator Light

 The Indicator Light © will light up when the oven is operating. When the Timer Knob D is in the "OFF" position, the Indicator Light O will not be lit.

HOW TO USE THE OVEN

CAUTION: The oven surfaces will be hot during and after use.

General Instructions

- Place the Grill Rack Gin position that will accommodate the height of the food to be cooked.
 See fig. 5.
- Place the food on the Rack. Make sure that you always use an ovenproof container in the oven.

NOTE: Never use plastic or cardboard containers in the Oven.

NOTE: Never use glass or ceramic pans or lids, Which are not designed for oven.

NOTE: DO NOT let juices run to the bottom of the oven. Use the oven tray \bigoplus when cooking. See fig 6.

- 3. Set the temperature as suggested by the recipe or as desired.
- Securely shut the door and set the cooking time to begin operating the oven.





Toasting [


- Set the function knob to" ".
 Rotate the temperature knob to desired temperature.

 See fig. 7.
- 2. Open the Oven Door (and place sliced bread on the Grill Rack (a). Place one slice of bread in the center of Grill Rack (b), or 4 slices side by side.

 See fig. 8.
- 3. **Time Setting** Select the length of time to toast your chosen food. It is advisable to test the toasting function by starting at a short time, increasing it to suit your toasting preferences.
- **NOTE:** To set the timer for 5 minutes or less, turn the timer to over 5 minutes, then back to your chosen time. This ensures that the timer is accurately set.



- 4. When toasting is finished the bell will ring and the electrical power is automatically turned off. To stop the cycle at any time, turn the Timer Knob (D) anti-clockwise to "off" position and the bell will ring. See fig. 9.
 - **NOTE:** The bread may catch fire if the toasting time is too long. Close supervision is necessary during toasting.
 - **NOTE:** Do not set the timer for long periods of time.
 - 5. When set to Toast, both the heating elements will work.

Broiling / Grilling "

- Slide grill rack (a) into the oven.
 Always put the food on the grill
 tray (a). When the broiling food like
 chicken wings or drumsticks
 which contain fat/oil, put the food
 on the grill tray and put it on the
 on the grill rack. See fig. 10.
- 2. Put the grill tray (f) on the grill rack (G).
- 3. When set to Broil, only top heating element will work.

NOTE: We always suggest preheating oven about 3-5 minutes before cooking the food.

4. Set the function knob to" ".
Rotate the temperature knob to desired temperature.

See fig. 11.

 Depending on the food you are cooking, set an appropriate time with the Timer Knob ①. If you need to cook food longer than 60 minutes, set the Timer to the Stay On setting.




NOTE: When using the Stay On setting, you must manually stop the timer.

WARNING: Do not use this function unattended.

NOTE: Always check the food when using this setting to prevent overcooking. If required, turn the food over for even cooking.

NOTE: Food and tray will become very hot. Use suitable oven gloves to prevent burning to hands.





Baking (CC)

- Place food on the Food Tray (H).
 See fig. 12.
- 2. Slide the grill rack Ginto the oven, then put the grill tray H on the rack.
- 3. When setting in Bake, both top and bottom heating elements will work.

NOTE: We always suggest preheating oven 5 minutes at this setting before cooking the food.

- Set the function knob to
 \(\bigcirc \) ".
 Rotate the temperature knob to desired temperature.
 - See fig. 13.
- 5. Depending on the food you are cooking, set an appropriate time with the Timer Knob ①. If you need to cook food longer than 60 minutes, set the Timer to the Stay On setting.

 See fig. 13.

NOTE: When using the Stay On setting, you must manually stop the timer. The food may catch fire if the baking time is too long

NOTE: Always check the food when using this setting to prevent overcooking. If required, turn the food over for even cooking.

NOTE: Food and tray will become very hot. Use suitable oven gloves to prevent burning to hands.




 See fig. 14.



CARE AND CLEANING



NOTE:

Always Unplug and allow to cool before cleaning

CARE AND CLEANING

- 1. Before cleaning unplug the toaster oven and allow it to cool completely.
- 2. Wash all the attachments with mild, soapy water including the rack and the baking tray.
- 3. Do not use abrasive cleaners, scrubbing brushes and chemical cleaner as this will cause damage to the non-stick coating of baking tray.
- 4. Use a wet cloth to wipe the inner surfaces of the oven.
- 5. Clean the door by using a wet cloth and detergent or soap.
- 6. Never immerse the unit in water or other liquid.

TO STORE

-Unplug unit, allow to cool and clean before storing. Never wrap cord tightly around the appliance, use the Cord Storage area on the back of the oven. Do not pull on the cord where it enters the unit, as this could damage the cord.

CLEANING REMOVABLE

CRUMB TRAY

- Open the oven door,take out the crumb tray to clean with a wet cloth.
- Put it back after cleaning.






The wire which is Coloured Yellow & Green must be connected to the terminal which is marked E or coloured Yellow or Green. The wire which is coloured blue must be connected to the terminal which is marked with N or coloured blue. The wire which is coloured brown must be connected to the terminal which is marked L or coloured brown. Always ensure that the plug cord grip is fastened correctly. If a 13A (BS1363) fused plug is used it must be fitted with a 13A fuse conforming to BS1362 and be ASTA approved. If in doubt contact a qualified electrician.
