

Safety and Care Advice

Important – Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

• Check you have all the components and tools listed on the following pages.

• Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.

• Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.

• Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.

• During assembly do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.

• Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.

• Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.

• Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.



• To reduce the likelihood of damaging your product please ensure that your

power drill is set on a low torque setting.

Glue safety - Take care when using glue, please follow the advice below

Skin contact: Remove contamination by washing with soap and water. This procedure should also be followed prior to eating and drinking. **Eye contact:** Rinse immediately with clean water for 15 minutes and seek medical advice.

• This product should not be discarded with household waste. Take to your local authority waste disposal centre.


Handy Hints

Step 1

Prepare the locking screws

a:


Screw 2 metal dowels B into the holes shown on the back of each drawer front $\fbox{4}$.

Note: Tighten metal dowels up fully against the panels.

b: Prepare the drawer sides Insert a small locking nut into the hole on left drawer side 7 and right drawerside 8. Make sure the 'arrow' on G is pointing towards the hole in the edge of 7 and 8.

Put drop of glue **1** in the 6 holes of drawersides 7 and 8 before sliding them onto the dowels of drawerback 6. Slide drawerbase 10 in the grooves of the drawer-unit.


c: Turn the drawer wrap assembly over and push onto the drawer front 4. Use a phillips or flatblade screwdriver, that is a good fit, to turn 24mm locking nut **G** as far as it will go - more than 1/2 turn.

finishing the drawers

d: Turn over drawer and slide Drawerbase supports in corner as shown and fix them, using the attached screws.






Attaching runners


a: Slide top of runners
foreward and fix on left side
1 as shown using 10mm
fixing screw drawer
Insert 2 Large locking nuts
into left side
where shown.



runner **1** and pre-drilled hole of left side **1** using 10mm fixing screw drawer **D**.

Repeat a and b on right sidepanel 2









Step 3

Insert fittings on top

Screw 24mm locking screws \mathbb{B} into top 3.


Note: Insert 24mm locking screw **B** as far as shown. **Do not over tighten.**





Step 4


Insert fittings on plinth Put drop of glue ① in the 4 holes of plinth 5. Then put dowels ① into the holes of plinth 5.



Step 5

Assemble the chest

a: Put drop of glue **1** into side-holes **1** and **2** Slide the sides onto the plinth **5**.



Step 5 continued

b: Attaching top Position top 3 onto left 1 and right 2 side .

Use a screwdriver to turn locking nuts A clockwise to lock.

C: Fitting back panel Attach foldy back 9 to backof the chest using nails **()** and hammer.

Use nailholder **(1)** to hold nails **(5)** vertical and at the correct distance as you secure the foldy back **(9)**.


Nails **(F)** should be spaced about 150mm apart.

Place the Furniture glides Strategically underneath the sides 2 and 2 with a small hammer.





Important: Chest MUST be 'square' when back is attached.
