Basic safety precautions

Please keep instructions for further use and use only as instructed in this guide

This vacuum cleaner is intended for household use only and NOT for commercial or industrial use

- Only use the vacuum cleaner indoors on dry surfaces and keep the area you're cleaning well lit
- Keep fingers, hair and loose clothing away from moving parts and openings whilst using the vacuum cleaner
- This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved. Children shall not play with the appliance. Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children without supervision
- Only Vax recommended tools should be used with this vacuum cleaner.

Taking care of your carpets

The Impact 504 is designed to make vacuuming carpets regularly, as effective and efficient as possible and this user guide will help you get the most out of your machine.

Maintaining your carpets will ensure they keep their appearance for longer. You've chosen carpets for your home for a reason and Vax will help you take good care of them.

Also inside this guide are instructions on maintaining your new machine, so that it's always ready when you are to tackle your carpets.

Don'ts

- X Don't use this vacuum cleaner if it has been dropped. damaged or left outdoors
- X Don't run over the power cord or use vacuum cleaner if the power cord or plug is damaged. Please contact our Customer Care Line on: 0844 4128 455 (Mon-Fri: 8.30am to 6.30pm, Sat: 9.00am to 5.00pm)
- X Don't handle the plug or use the vacuum cleaner with wet hands
- X Don't pull or carry this vacuum cleaner by the power cord. Don't use the power cord as a handle, pull the power cord around corners, sharp edges or close a door over the power cord. Don't unplug vacuum cleaner by pulling on the power cord
- X Don't vacuum up any flammable or combustible materials (lighter fluid, petrol, kerosene etc.) or use the vacuum cleaner in an area with explosive vapours or liquid
- X Don't vacuum up hot coals, cigarette butts, matches or smoking hot burning items or use in an area where there may be harmful fluids (chlorine, bleach, and ammonia drain cleaner)
- X Don't attempt to remove blockages with sharp objects as this may cause damage to your vacuum cleaner
- X Don't vacuum up hard or sharp objects such as glass, nails, screws or coins etc
- X Don't use the vacuum cleaner with incorrect voltage as this may result in damage or injury to the user. The correct voltage is listed on the ratings label.

Do's

- ✓ Turn off all controls on the vacuum cleaner before disconnecting or connecting the power cord
- Always keep the power cord away from the brushes whilst using your vacuum cleaner. After use always wrap the power cord around the cord clips provided
- ✓ Always make sure both the pre-motor/post motor filters are ✓ Use only CE approved 13 amp extension cords, non-approved in place before use
- Always make sure the brushbar is set to hard floor when positioning the vacuum cleaner on the stairs
- Always switch off the vacuum cleaner before disconnecting or connecting the hose and accessories

- - ✓ Keep all openings clear and free from debris as this may affect the airflow/suction
- Always replace the fuse in the plug with a British 13amp fuse. Always protect the power cable from heated surfaces and open flames
- extension cords may overheat. Care should be taken to arrange the extension cord as it could be a trip hazard
- using your vacuum on the stairs and take extra care when 🧹 Store the vacuum cleaner in a cool, dry area. If filters have been cleaned as per user the guide instructions ensure they are thoroughly dry before storing away.


To ensure the Hard Floor Adaptor is correctly fitted, the wheels should be towards the back of the floor tool when attached to




Insert the short end of the hose into the tube at the back onto the machine and push of the machine and connect the hose end to the floorhead



Place the dirt container until it clicks into place




Push handle into the top of the machine until it clicks into place



- Always switch off and unplug the vacuum cleaner before connecting or disconnecting the hose/attachments, or removing and emptying the dirt container
- The vacuum cleaner is equipped with a thermal cut-out. If for any reason the vacuum cleaner does overheat the thermostat will automatically turn the vacuum cleaner off. If this happens, switch the vacuum cleaner off and unplug from electrical socket. Remove and empty the dirt container also check the vacuum cleaner for blockages. Allow the vacuum cleaner to cool for approximately 1 hour (if you have cleaned the filters please wait 24 hours for the filters to fully dry before putting back into the vacuum)
- Filters require cleaning at least every 3 months
- If the vacuum cleaner is blocked, switch off and unplug before removing the blockage
- When using the accessories always make sure the brushbar is switched to the off position
- **IMPORTANT:** When the vacuum cleaner is stood in the upright position or when using on stairs and the hose/tools, the brushbar height adjust dial must be set to hard floor




Cleaning the pre-motor filter






Cleaning the shroud



Turn the dirt container lid anti-clockwise and lift to remove the shroud





Flexi Crevice Tool 1-1-131393-00 A handy long, flexible tool for getting far behind and around furniture.



• The plug may not be fully pushed into the electrical socket

- Check the fuse in the plug if this needs replacing, always replace with a British 13amp fuse
- Why does my vacuum • The motor thermostat may have tripped. If this has happened, unplug the cleaner have no power? vacuum cleaner. Remove and empty the dirt container and check the hose for blockages.
 - Clean the filters and allow the vacuum cleaner to cool for approximately 1 hour (if you have washed the filters you will need to wait 24 hours for the filters to fully dry before putting them back into the vacuum cleaner)

- There may be a blockage in the hose. Please remove the hose from the vacuum cleaner, check and clear any blockages
- Empty the dirt container and clean filters. Why won't the vacuum Go to the 'Taking care of your machine' cleaner pick up?
 - The brushbar may not be turning. Go to my brushbar isn't turning below
 - If the accessory/tool will not pick up, check and clear any blockages
 - The brushbar may be clogged, check the brushbar and clear any hair or debris Go to 'Let's talk technical'
 - The belt may be broken, Go to 'Let's talk technical'
