

• During assembly do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.

- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.
- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.



• To reduce the likelihood of damaging your product please ensure that your

power drill is set on a low torque setting.

• Assembly should be carried out by a competent adult only.

• This product should not be discarded with household waste. Take to your local authority waste disposal centre.


Handy Hints






Step - 3

Insert large locking nuts **B** into Plinth 5.

Make sure the 'arrow' on locking nuts B points towards the hole in the edge of $\fbox{5}$.

Repeat this step on second plinth 5.




Step - 4

Attaching panels

Position both side 6 onto plinth 5 on both sides.


Use a screwdriver to turn locking nuts clockwise to lock.



Step - 5

Put drop of glue **(b)** into the 6 holes of top 2.

Put dowels **(**) into the holes of top **(**2).




Step - 6

Attaching top

Put drop of glue **(b)** into the 6 holes of side **(6)**.

Position the 6 dowels **(**) of top 2 onto the 6 holes of side 6.



Step - 7

Screw expando dowel **b** into drawer back **3**.

Note: Insert expando dowel **D** as far as shown. **Do not over tighten.**

Step - 8

Screw expando dowel D into left drawer side 8. *Note:* Insert expando dowel D as far as shown. Do not over tighten.

Insert large locking nuts B into left drawer side \fbox{B} . Make sure the 'arrow' on locking nuts B points towards the hole in the edge of \fbox{B} .

Put drop of glue **1** into the 2 holes of 8. Put dowels **6** into the holes of 8.

Step - 9

Screw expando dowel **D** into right drawer side **7**. *Note:* Insert expando dowel **D** as far as shown. **Do not over tighten.**

Insert large locking nuts \blacksquare into right drawer side $\boxed{7}$. Make sure the 'arrow' on locking nuts \blacksquare points towards the hole in the edge of $\boxed{7}$.


Put drop of glue 1 into the 2 holes of 8. Put dowels 6 into the holes of $\fbox{2}$.

Step - 10

Screw expando dowel **D** into drawer front 1. Screw 24mm locking screw **A** into front 1.

Note: Insert 24mm locking screw A and expando dowel D as far as shown. Do not over tighten.

Put drop of glue 1 into the 4 holes of $\boxed{1}$. Put dowels 6 into the holes of $\boxed{1}$.




Step - 11

Attaching drawer panels

Put drop of glue \bigcirc into the 8 holes of drawer back \bigcirc .

Position the 4 dowels of drawer side 7 and 8 onto the holes of drawer back 3.




Attaching drawer panels

Put drop of glue **H** into the 4 holes of drawer side 7 and 8.

Position the 4 dowels **(F)** of drawer side **(7)** and **(8)** onto the holes of drawer back **(3)**.

Use a screwdriver to turn locking nuts clockwise to lock.






Step - 15

Attaching drawer base

slide drawer base $\boxed{4}$ into the drawer from the top until till the 8 expando dowels **D** are totally in the expando housing **B** of drawer base $\boxed{4}$.



Step - 16

Use a screwdriver to turn expando housig clockwise to lock.


Step - 17

Inserting Drawer Slide the drawer into the base.

Before adjusting the storage box, use a spirit level to check if the box is level front-to-back and side-to-side in the three positions shown.

Use pegs **(G** to square the box. Knock peg **(G**) in, as far as you require, under the ends of the box and then snap off flush with the panel.

Assembly is complete.
