Step 1

Prepare the 2 small drawer fronts

Screw 2 metal dowels **B** into the holes shown on the back of each of the small drawer fronts **8**.

Note: Tighten the metal dowels up fully against the panels.

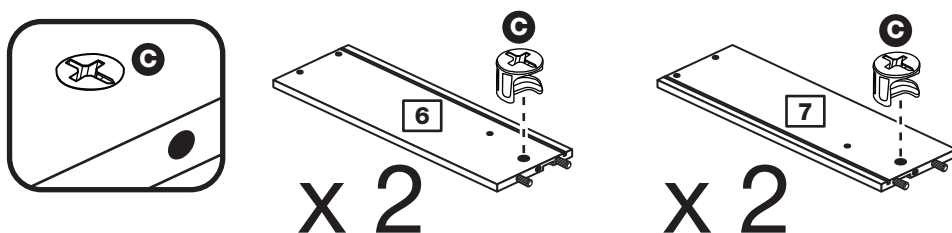


Step 2

Prepare the 2 sets of the drawer sides

Insert a small locking nut **C** into the hole shown on the left drawer side **6** and right drawer side **7**.

Note: The arrow on the locking nut **must** point towards the hole in the edge of the panel.



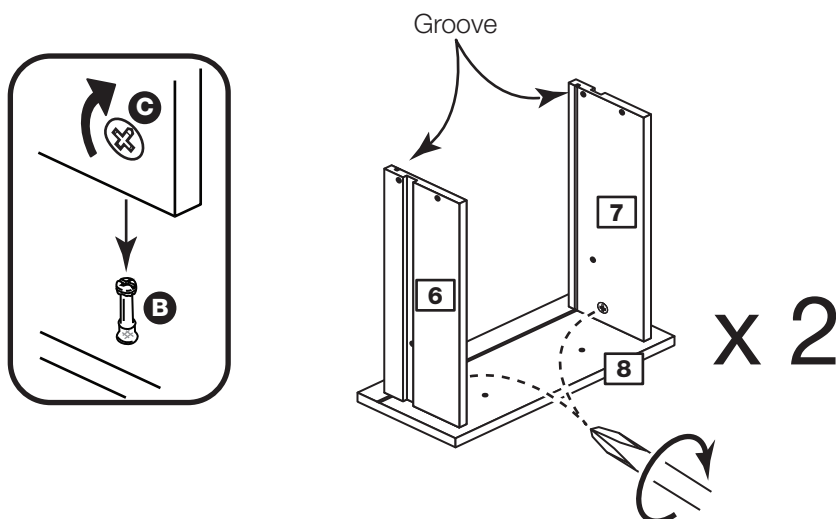
Step 3

Attach the drawer sides to the small drawer front

Push the left drawer side **6** and right drawer side **7** onto the back of the small drawer front **8**.

Turn the small locking nuts **C** on the left drawer side **6** and right drawer side **7**.

Note: Turn the locking nuts **C** clockwise to secure panels - more than 1/2 a turn.

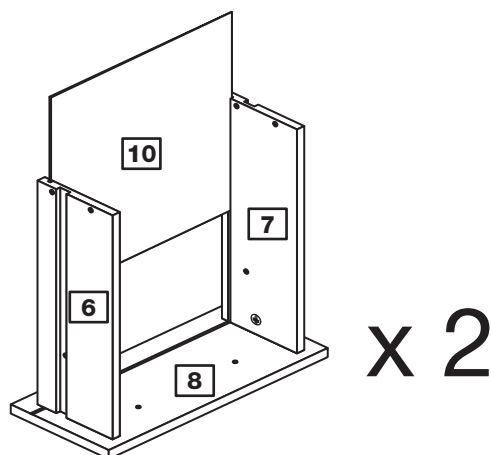

Fit the small drawer base

Slide the small drawer base **10** down the grooves in the drawer sides **6** and **7** and down into the groove in the small drawer front **8**.



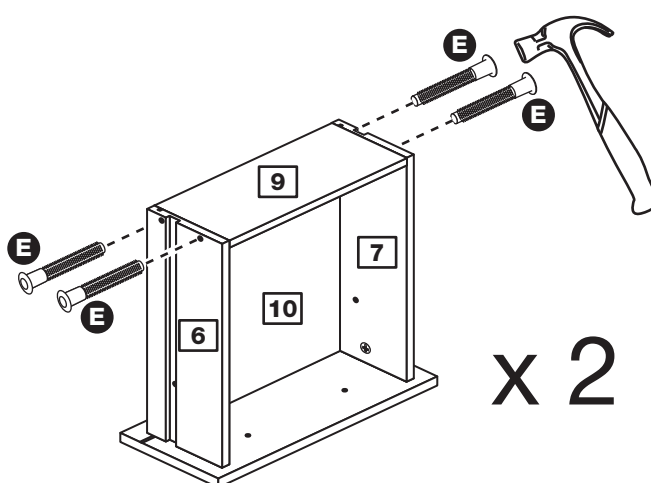

Make sure that the small drawer base **10** fits into the groove in the small drawer back **9**.

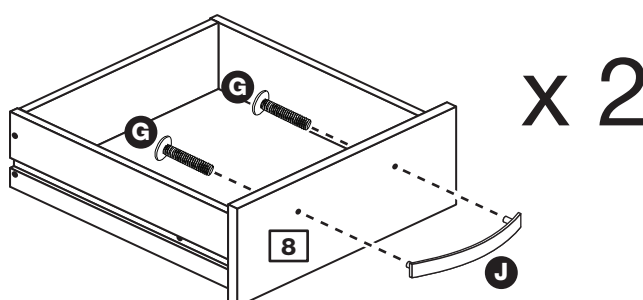

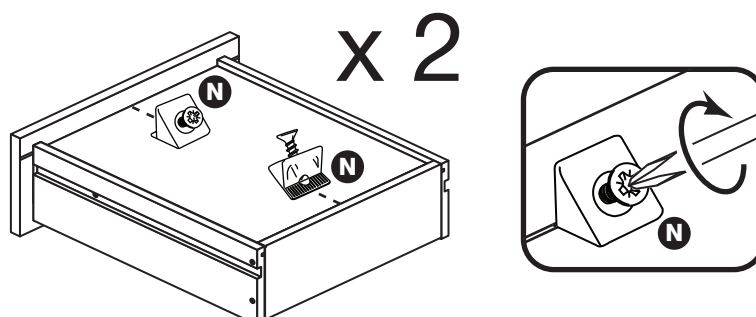

Turn the small drawer assemblies over and slide 2 wedgfixes **N** into the front and back grooves, as shown, and tighten up the screws.

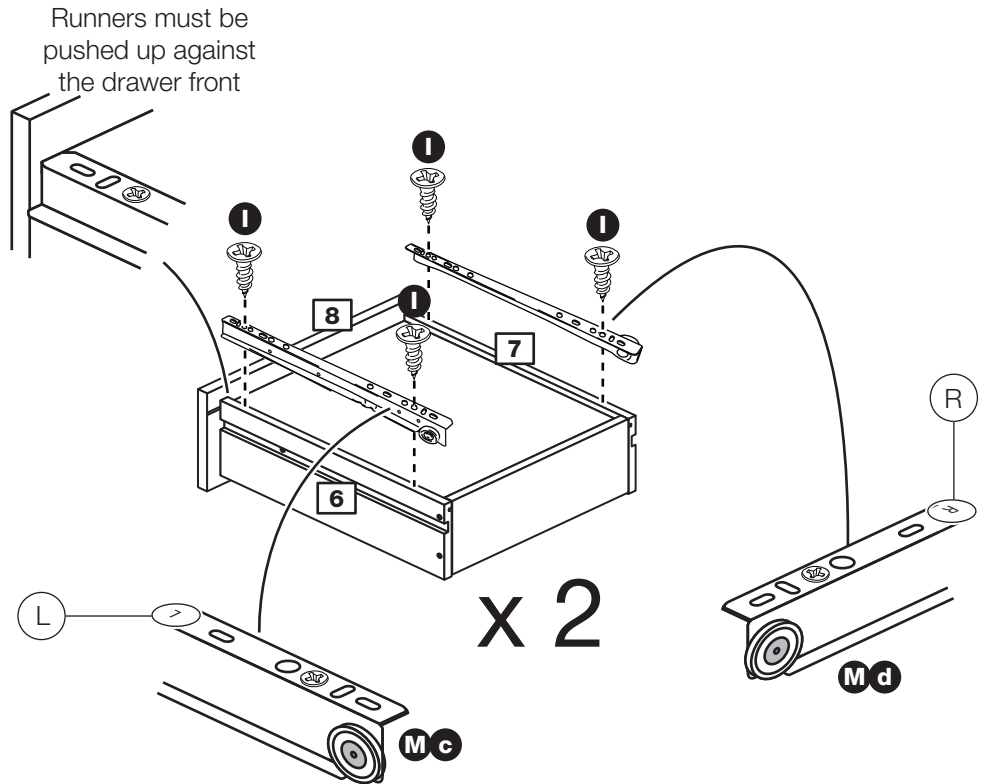
Fit runners to the small drawers

Turn the 2 small drawer assemblies over.

Fit runner **(Md)**, marked with 'R', to the bottom edge of the right drawer side **(7)**, as shown, making sure that it is pushed up against the back of the small drawer front **(8)**.

Use a bradawl to mark the fixing positions, then secure with 2 screws **(I)**.

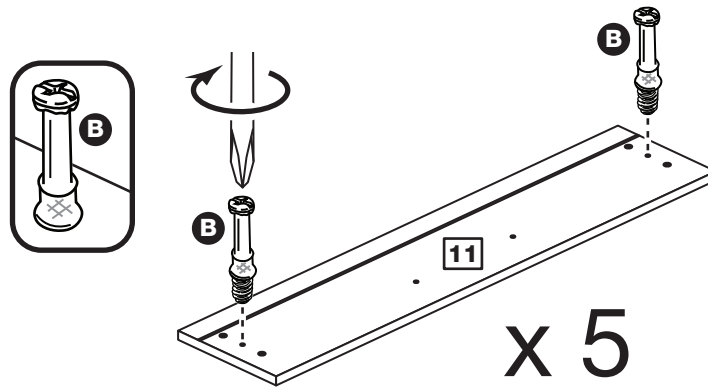
Fit runner **(Mc)**, marked 'L', to the bottom edge of the left drawer side **(6)** using the same method.

Prepare the 5 large drawer fronts

Screw 2 metal dowels **(B)** into the holes shown on the back of each large drawer front **(11)**.

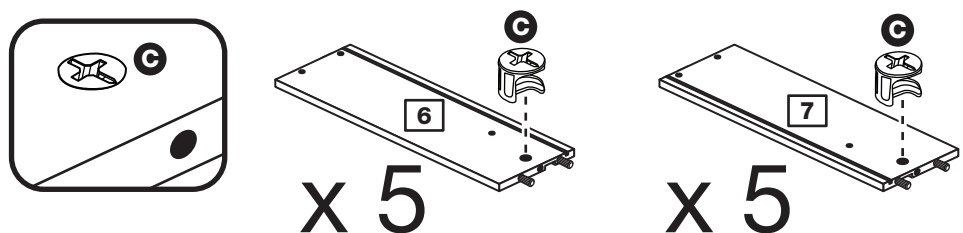

Prepare 5 sets of drawer sides

Insert a small locking nut **(C)** into the hole shown on the left drawer side **(6)** and right drawer side **(7)**.

Note: The arrow on the locking nut **must** point towards the hole in the edge of the panel.

Attach a handle **J** to each of the large drawer fronts **11** using 2 screws **G**.

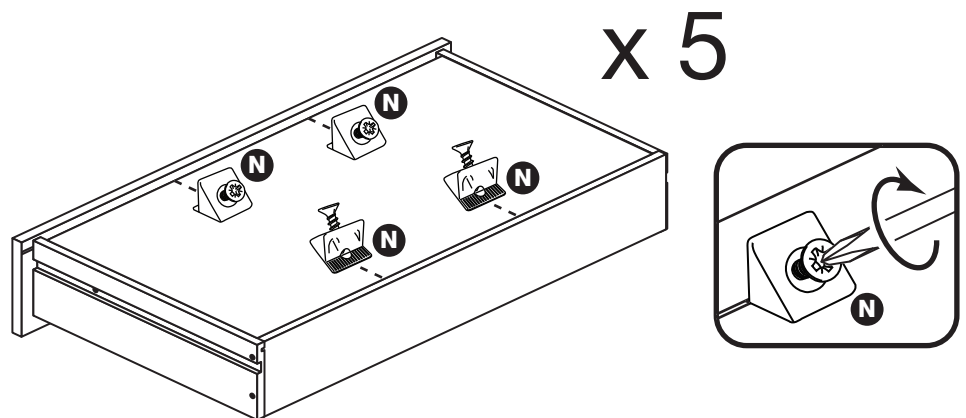

Note: Before adding the wedgefixes, make sure the assembled drawer is square.

Turn the drawer assemblies over and slide 4 wedgefixes **N** into the front and back grooves, as shown, and tighten up the screws.

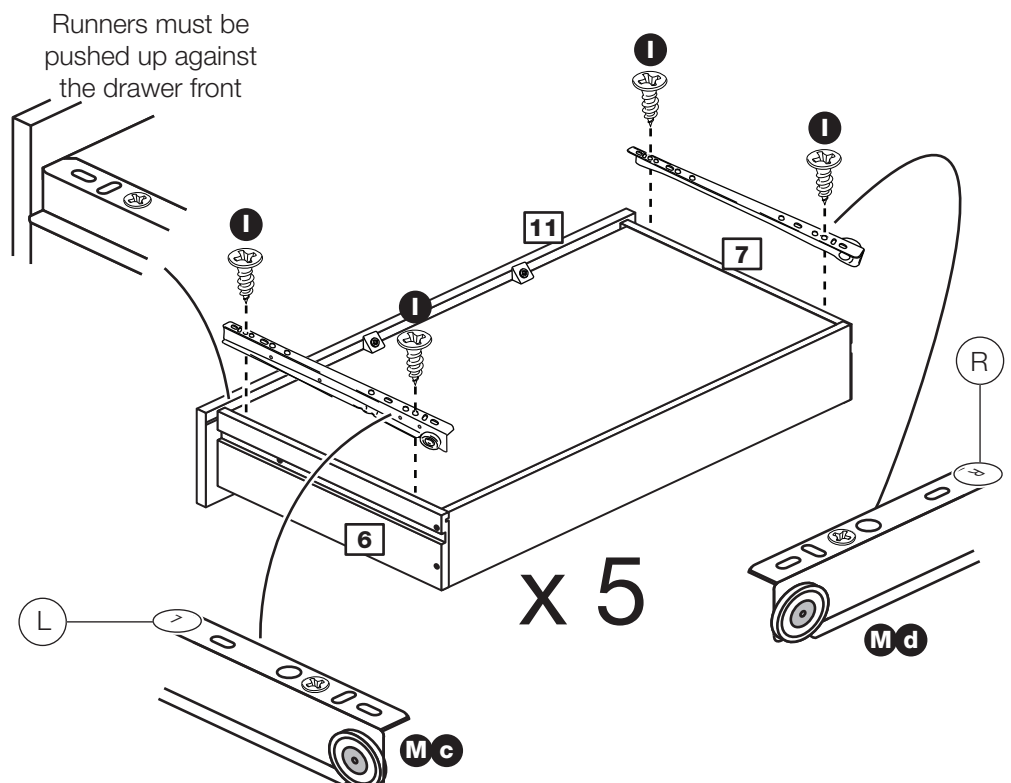
Fit runners to the large drawers

Turn the 5 large drawer assemblies over.

Fit runner **Md**, marked with 'R', to the bottom edge of the right drawer side **7**, as shown, making sure that it is pushed up against the back of the large drawer front **11**.

Use a bradawl to mark the fixing positions, then secure with 2 screws **I**.

Fit runner **Mc**, marked 'L', to the bottom edge of the left drawer side **6** using the same method.

a: Fit 6 runners **Ma** to the left side **1**.

The 1st screw **H** uses the 2nd hole in from the front of the runner.

The 2nd and 3rd screws **H** use the holes that line up with the other panel holes.

b: Fit a screw **I** into the 2nd hole in at the top of the runners **Ma**.

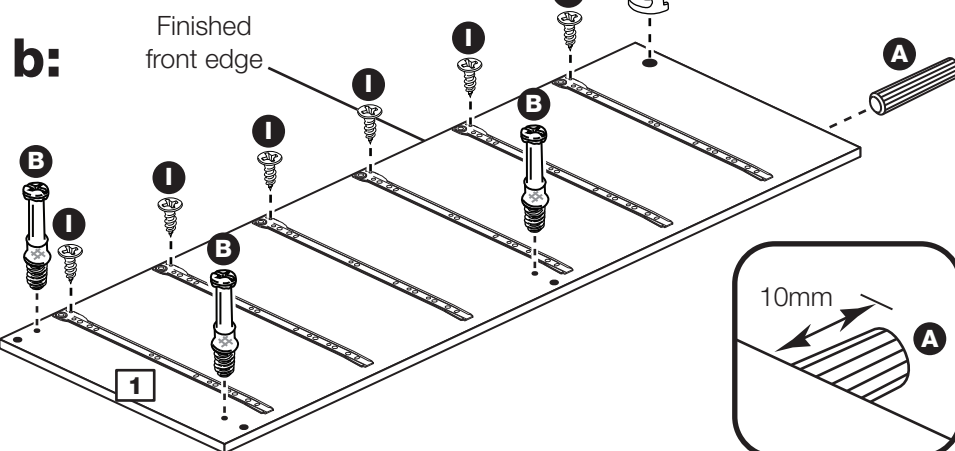
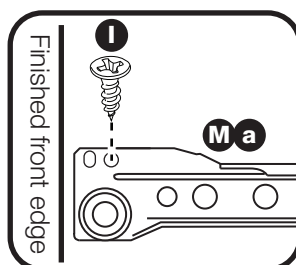
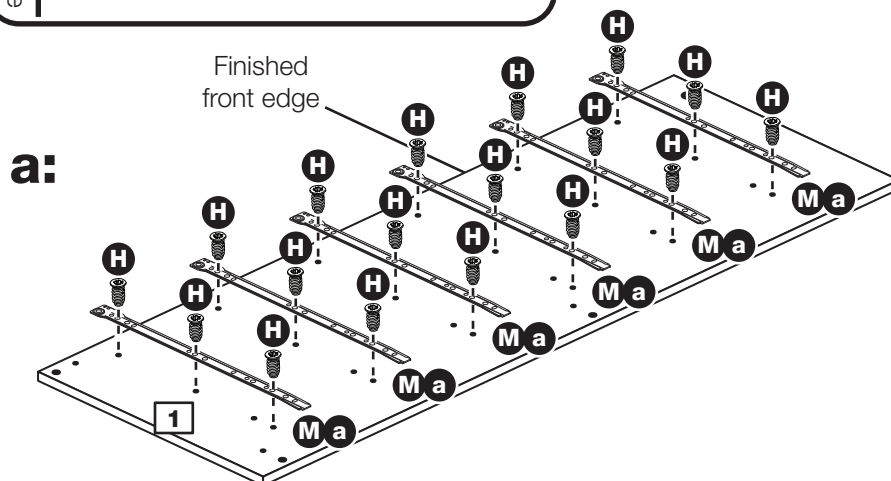
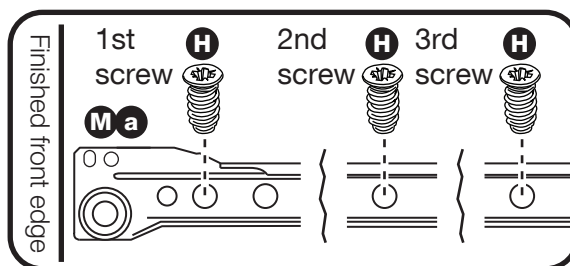
Screw 3 metal dowels **B** into the left side **1**.

Insert a large locking nut **D** into the left side **1**.

Note: The arrow on the locking nut **must** point towards the hole in the edge of the panel.

Tap a wooden dowel **A** into the left side **1**.

Note: Wooden dowels **must not** stick out from the edge by more than 10mm or they may damage other panels.

Prepare the right side

a: Fit 6 runners **Mb** to the right side **2**.

The 1st screw **H** uses the 2nd hole in from the front of the runner.

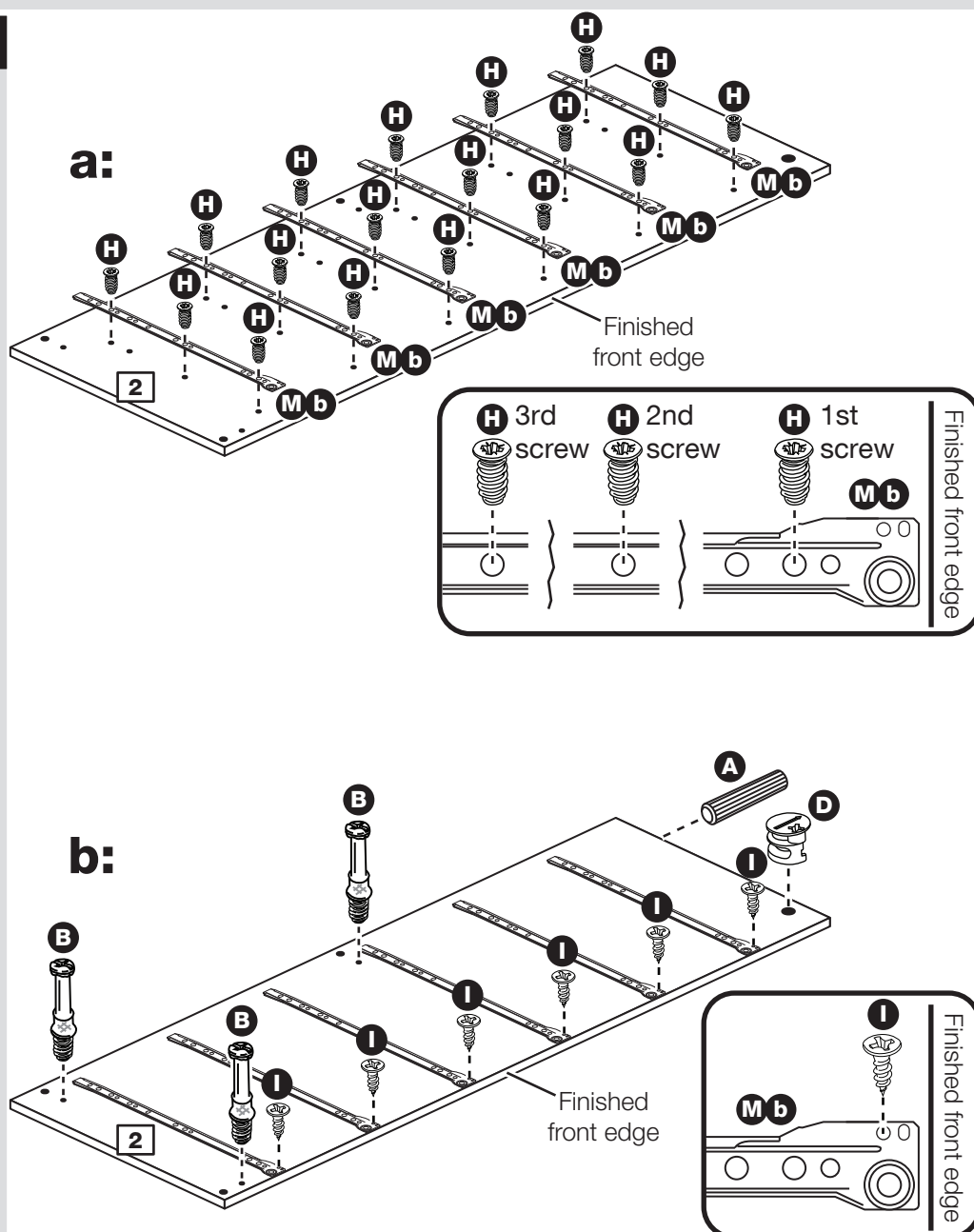
The 2nd and 3rd screws **H** use the holes that line up with the other panel holes.

b: Fit a screw **I** into the 2nd hole in at the top of the runner **Mb**.

Screw 3 metal dowels **B** into the right side **2**.

Insert a large locking nut **D** into the right side **2**.

Tap a wooden dowel **A** into the right side **2**.

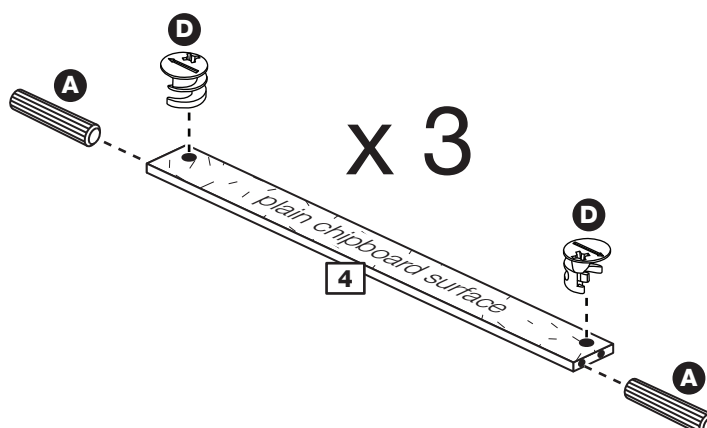

Prepare the 3 rails

Tap 2 wooden dowels **A** into each rail **4**.

Insert 2 large locking nuts **D** into each rail **4**.

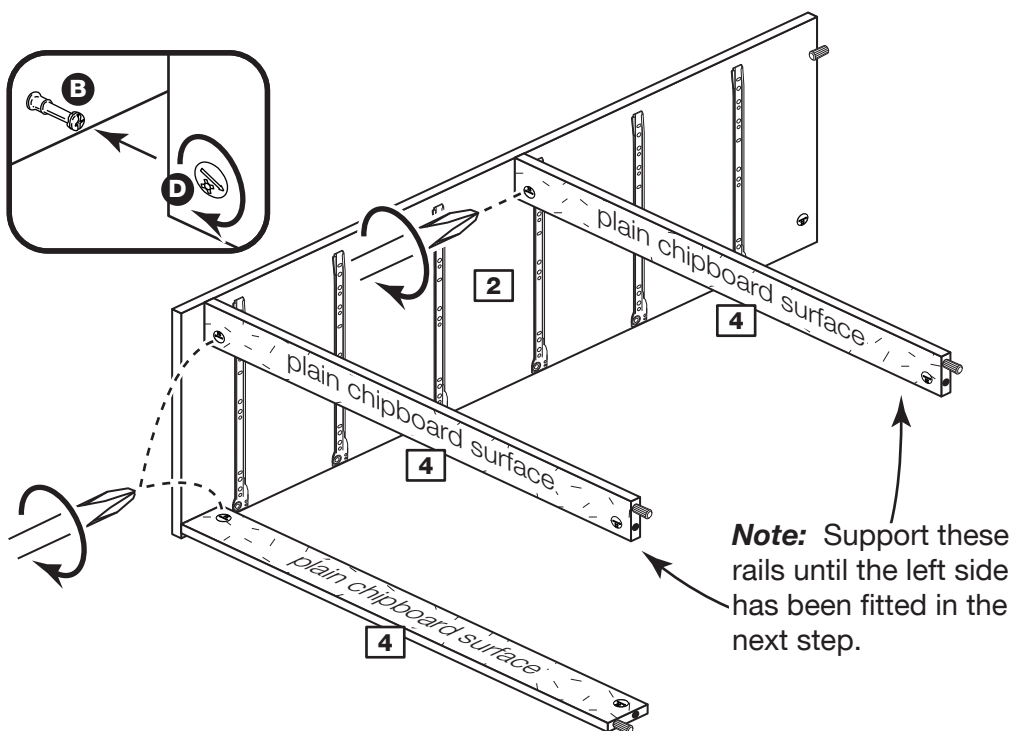

Join the right side and rails

Push the 3 rails **4** onto the right side **2**.

Use a screwdriver to tighten the 3 large locking nuts **D** fitted to the rails **4**.

Note: Turn the large locking nuts **D** as far as they will go - more than 1/2 a turn.

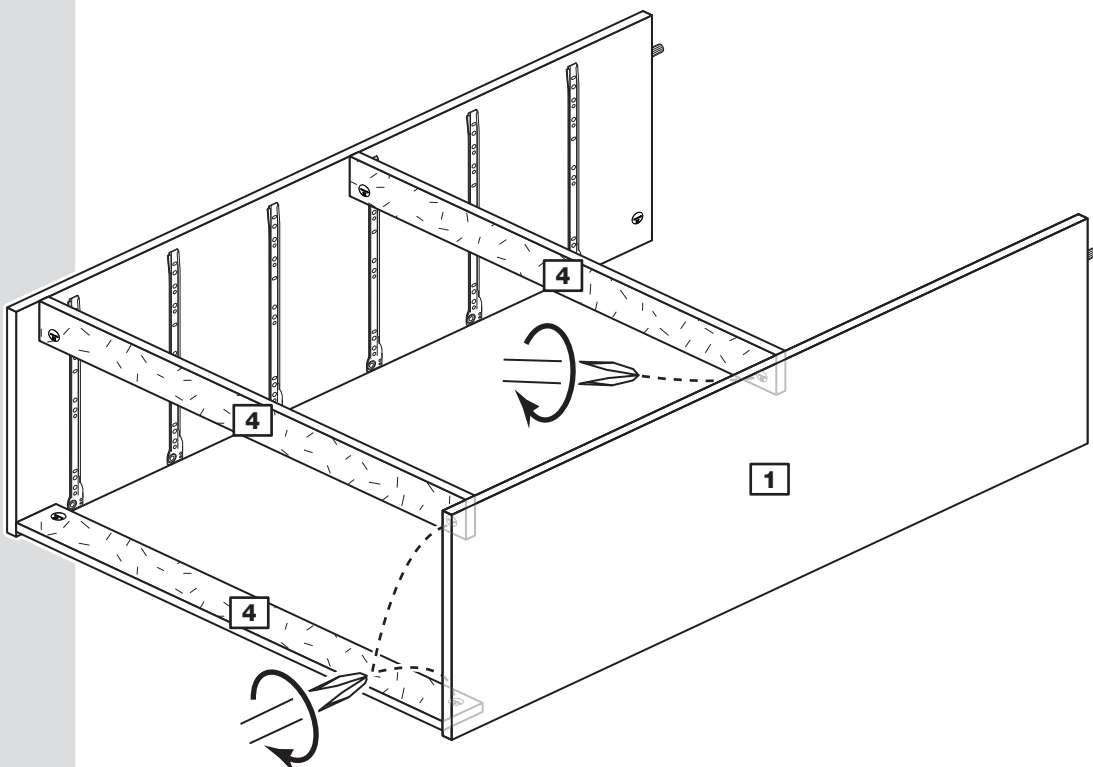

Fit the left side

Push the left side **1** onto the 3 rails **4**.

Use a screwdriver to tighten the 3 large locking nuts **D** fitted to the rails **4**.

Prepare both surfaces of the divider

Note: The colour of the divider may differ from the main unit colour.

a: Fit a runner **Mb** to the divider **5**.

The 1st screw **H** uses the 2nd hole in from the front of the runner.

The 2nd and 3rd screws **H** use the holes that line up with the other panel holes.

b: Fit a screw **I** into the 2nd hole in at the top of the runner **Mb**.

Insert 2 large locking nuts **D** into the divider **5**.

Screw 4 metal dowels **B** into the top **3**.

Fix the bracket **L**, 200mm in from the side of the top **3** and flush to the back edge, using screw **K**.

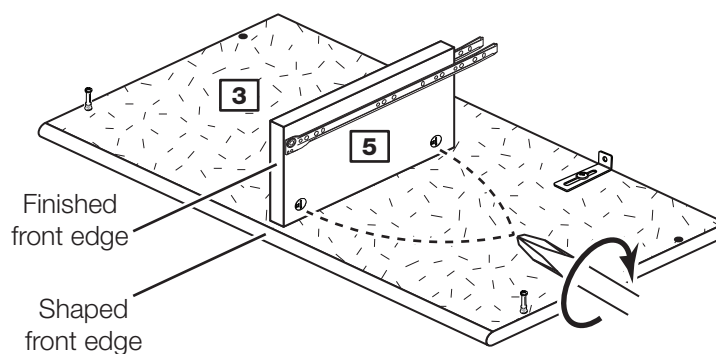

Join the divider and top

Push the divider **5** onto the top **3**.

Use a screwdriver to tighten the 2 large locking nuts **D** fitted to the divider **5**.

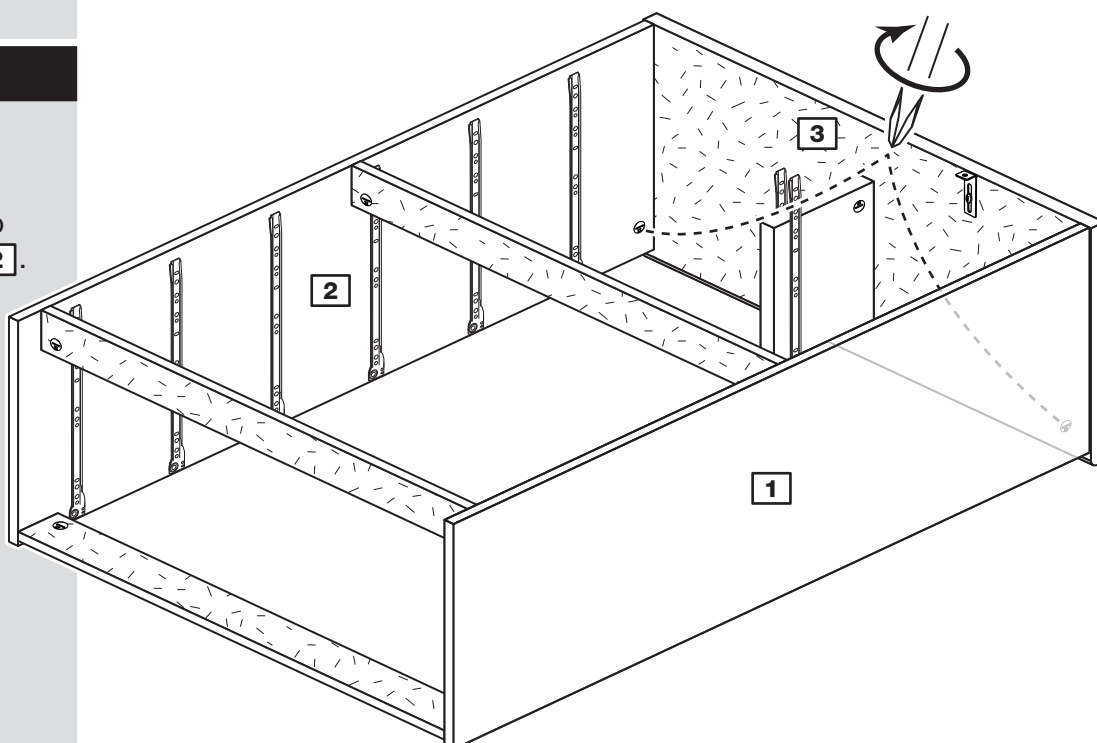


Step 25

Fit the top

Push the top **3** onto the 2 sides **1** and **2**.

Use a screwdriver to tighten the 2 large locking nuts **D** fitted to the sides **1** and **2**.

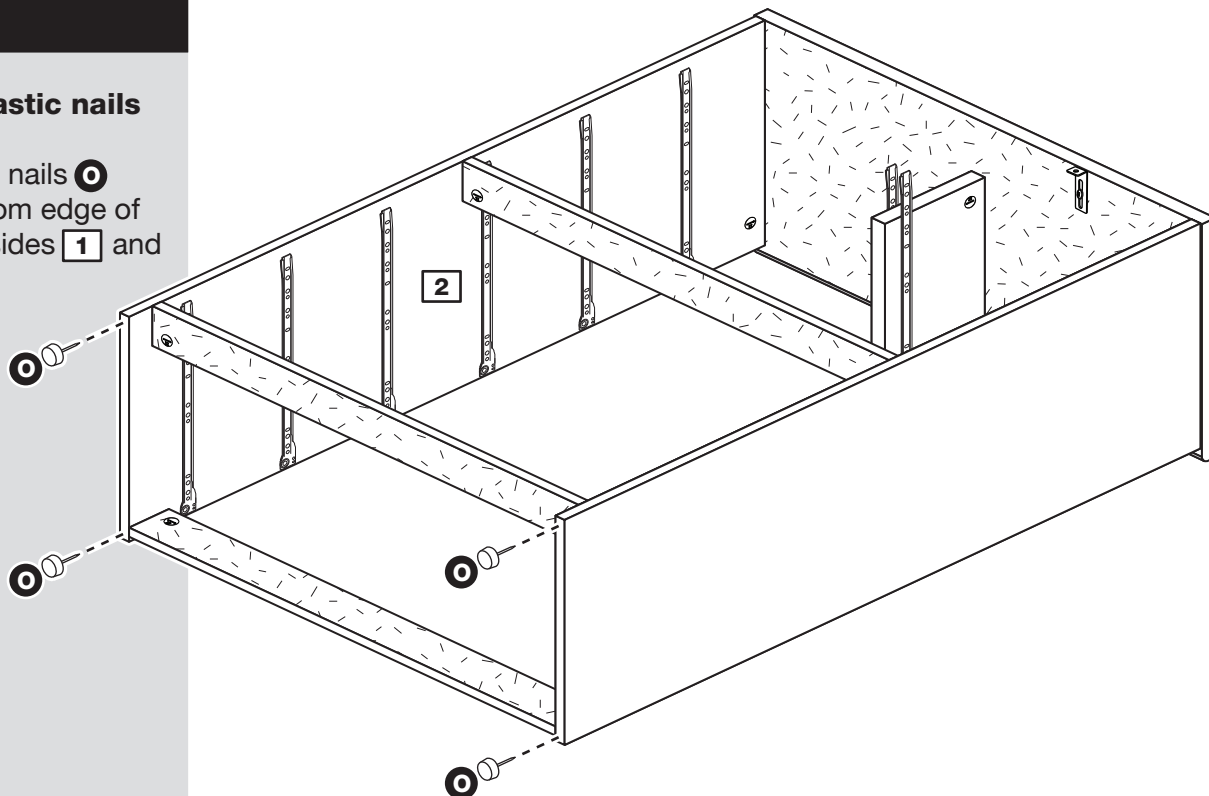

Tap 2 plastic nails **O** into the bottom edge of each of the sides **1** and **2**.

Fit the back

a: Square up the unit by making sure that measurement **x** to **x** equals **y** to **y**.

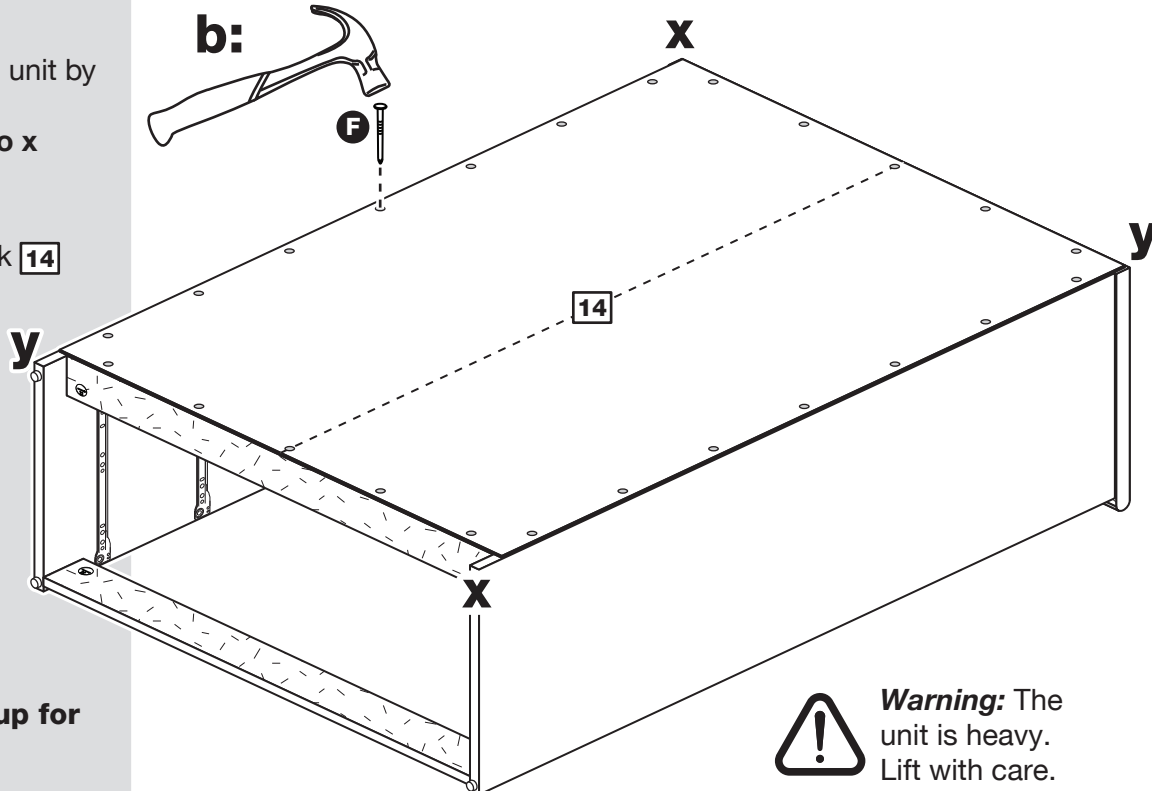
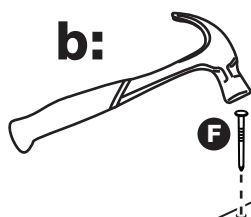
b: Place the back **14** onto the unit.

Nail **F** around the outside edges of the back **14**.

Note: Nails should be spaced about 150mm apart.

Stand the unit up for the next step.

a: The measurement from top corner X to bottom corner X must be equal to the measurement from top corner Y to bottom corner Y

Fit the top

Push the top **3** onto the 2 sides **1** and **2**.

Use a screwdriver to tighten the 2 large locking nuts **D** fitted to the sides **1** and **2**.

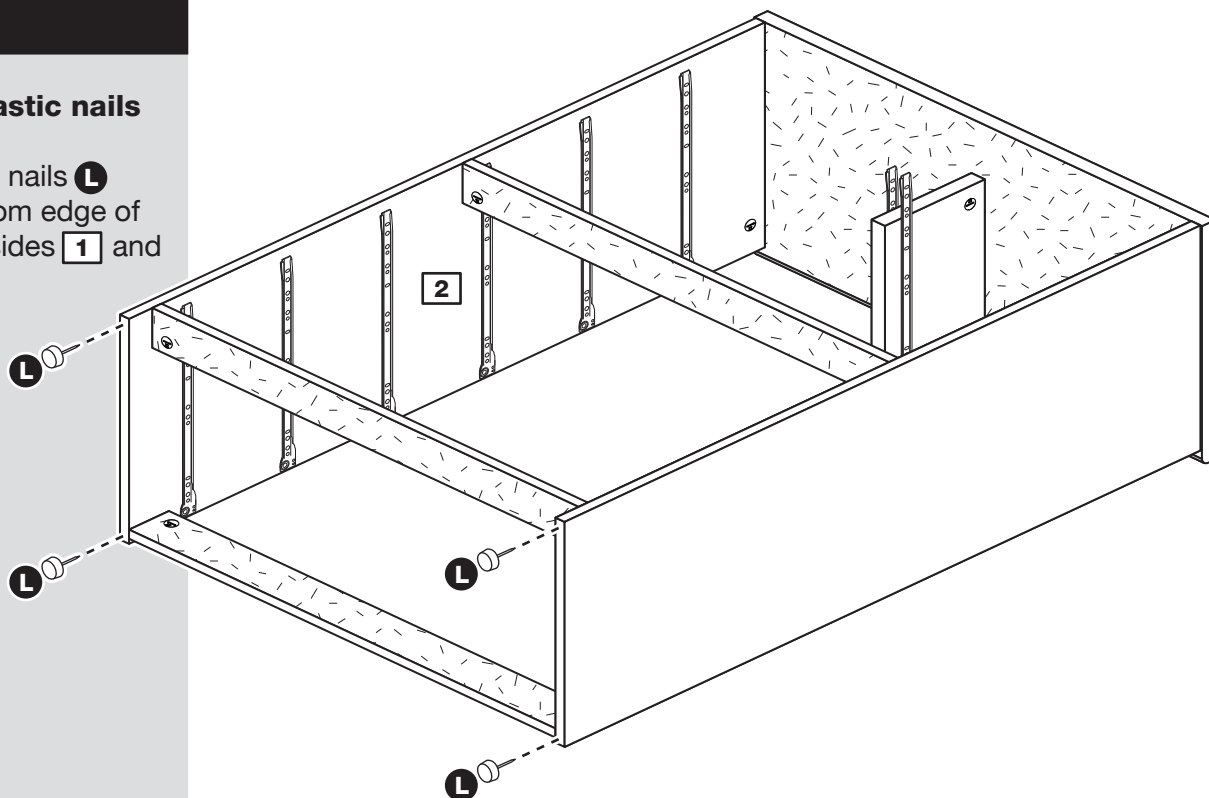


Assembly Instructions

Step 26

Fit the 4 plastic nails

Tap 2 plastic nails **L** into the bottom edge of each of the sides **1** and **2**.



Step 27

Fit the back

a: Square up the unit by making sure that measurement **x to x** equals **y to y**.

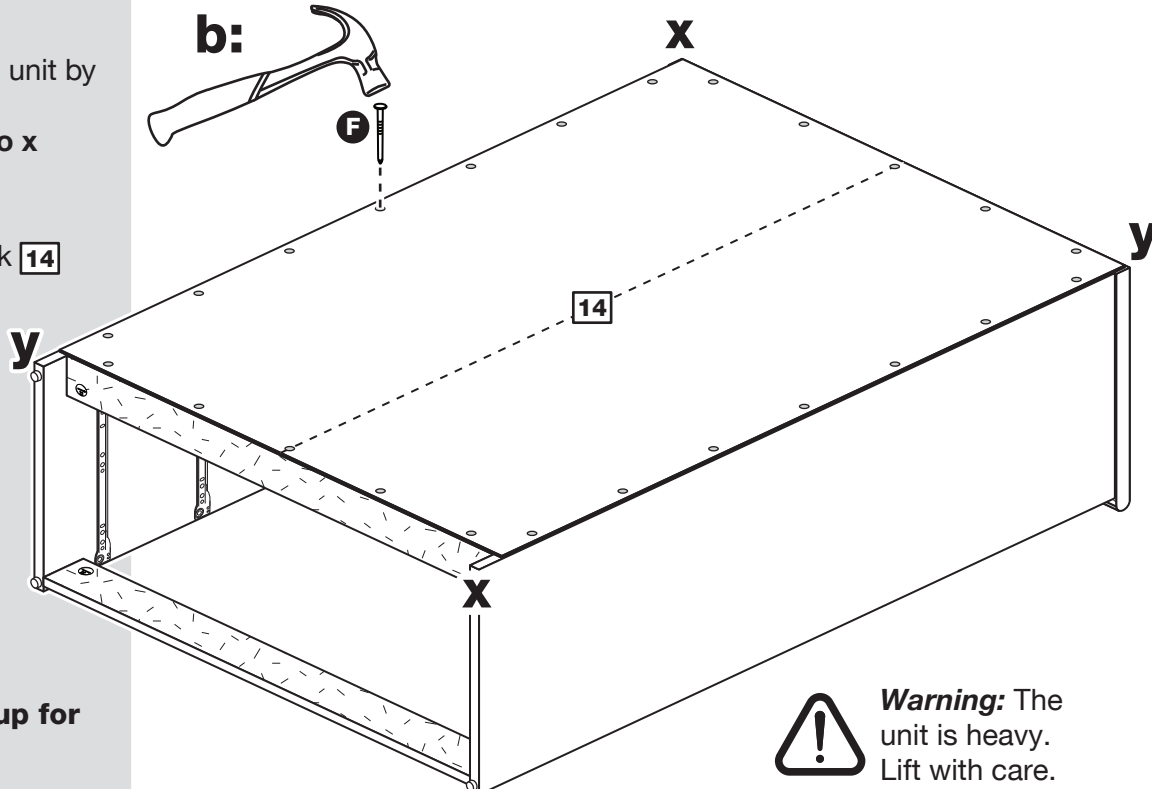
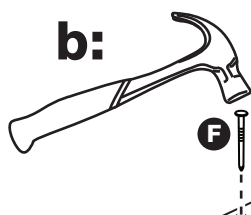
b: Place the back **14** onto the unit.

Nail **F** around the outside edges of the back **14**.

Note: Nails should be spaced about 150mm apart.

Stand the unit up for the next step.

a: The measurement from top corner X to bottom corner X must be equal to the measurement from top corner Y to bottom corner Y



Warning: The unit is heavy. Lift with care.

Step 28

Fit the overbalance protector kit and the drawers

To prevent possible overbalancing we recommend that this unit is secured to a suitable wall by fitting of the overbalance protector kit **N** to the unit, or an alternative fixing method of your choice.

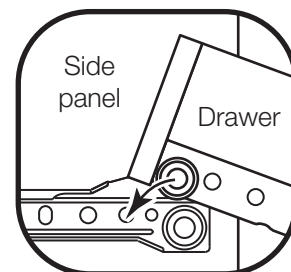
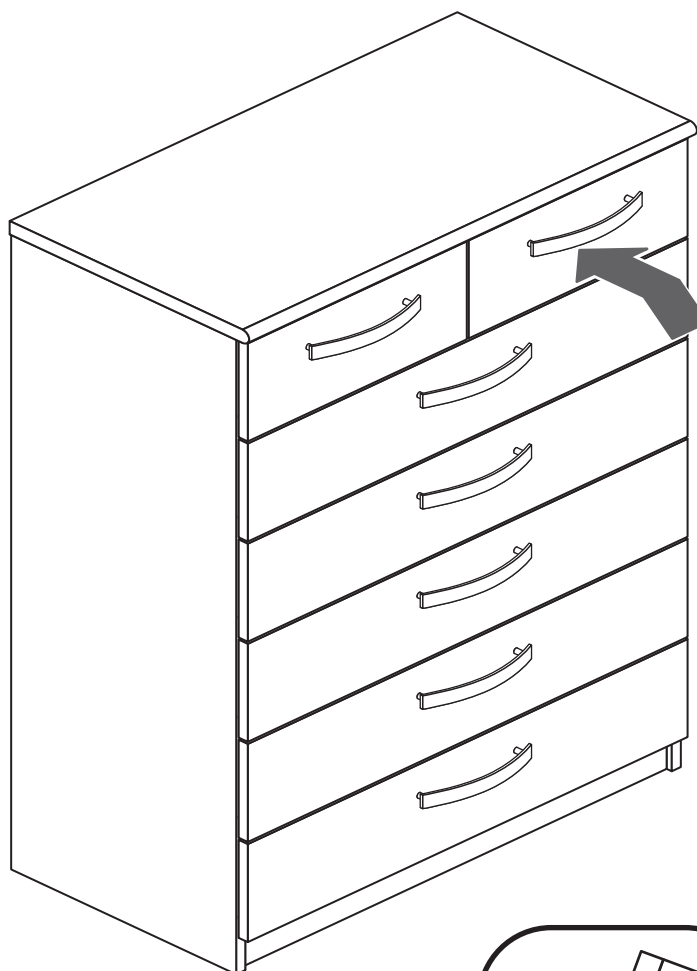
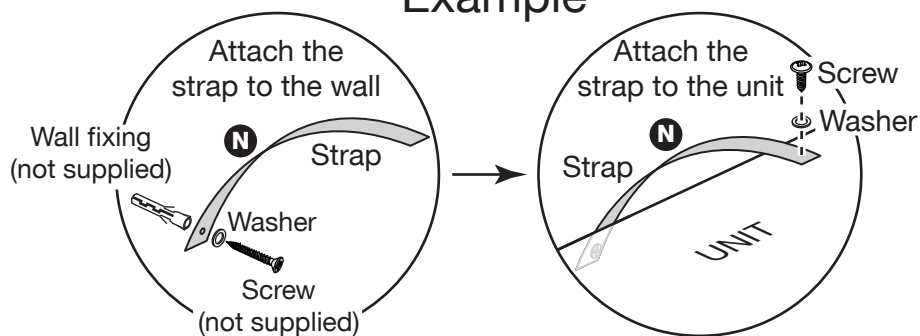
Wall fixings are not supplied as they will need to suit the wall type.

Note: Take care when drilling the wall that you do not drill into any pipes, wires etc. If in doubt, consult an expert.

Slide the wheels of the runners fitted to the drawers, over the wheels of the runners fitted to the unit and push the drawers into position.
