

# Safety and Care Advice

### Important - Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

- Check you have all the components and tools listed on the following pages.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.

- During assembly do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.
- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.



 To reduce the likelihood of damaging your product please ensure that your

power drill is set on a low torque setting.

#### Care and maintenance

- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do no use bleach or abrasive cleaners.
- From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit.
- This product should not be discarded with household waste. Take to your local authority waste disposal centre.


### **Handy Hints**

## Step 1


Place the panels on a flat protected surface.

#### a: Attaching dowels

Insert dowels **©** into holes on top panel **1** and legs **4L**, **4R**, **5L** & **5R** as shown.

#### b: Attaching cam bolts


Insert cam bolts **①** into holes on top panel **1** & wide legs **5L** & **5R** as shown and fix using a crosshead screwdriver.



### Step 2

# Attaching side panels to top panel


- a: Align and insert the dowels **©** and cam bolt **D** on top panel **1** into holes on the side panels **2** & **3** as shown.
- b: Put the cam locks into the holes on the table side panels and a shown.
- **C:** Turn and fix the cam locks **(a)** using a crosshead screwdriver to lock.




## Step 2

### Securing side panels

Fix the side panels 2 & 3 using screws **3** and tighten using a crosshead screwdriver.






## Step 3


### **Assembling legs**


a: Align and insert the dowels **G** and cam bolt **D** on wide legs **5L** &**5R** into holes on the narrow legs **4L** &**4R** as shown.


b: Put the cam locks on narrow legs 4L & 4R as shown.

**C:** Turn and fix the cam locks **(3)** using a crosshead screwdriver to lock.










## Step 4

# Attaching legs to top panel


Position the assembled legs 4L ,4R, 5L & 5R as shown and align / insert the dowels 6 into holes on the top panel 1.




## Step 5

### Securing legs

Fix the legs to side panels 2 & 3 as shown using bolts **A** and tighten using a crosshead screwdriver.






## Step 6

# Securing legs with screws


Fix the legs to side panels 2 & 3 as shown using screws **B** and tighten using a crosshead screwdriver.




## Step 7

#### Securing side panels

Position brackets **6** to side panels **2** & **3** as shown and fix with screws **1**. Then tighten screws using a crosshead screwdriver.






## Step 8


# Attaching adhesive pads

Remove backing from adhesive pads then paste it on the legs L & AR to cover the cam locks .



Carefully turn over the unit.

**Note:** At least two persons are required to lift the unit.
