


- Assemble all parts and bolts loosely during assembly, only once the product is complete should you fully tighten the bolts





Left Side Frame x 1 (52 x 74cm)




Right Side Frame x 1 (52 x 74cm)




3 Top Rest x 1 (19.5 x 51cm)






### Step 1

Fitting the Side Frame

Crossover the Left Side Frame 1 into Right Side Frame 2




## Step 2

Fitting the Top Rest

Note: It would be useful to ask someone to help you at this stage.

- a: Use Bolt @ ,Spring Washer **①**,Flat Washer (a) with the Allen Key (b) to fix the Top Rest 3
- **b:** Insert Wood Button **G** into the holes.




### Step 3

Fitting the Seat Cushion

Use Bolt , Spring Washer , Flat Washer with the allen key to fix the seat cushion onto the unit.

Fully tighten all screws now.




## Step 4

Fitting the Crossover Side Frame

Use Screw , with the Allen Key to fix Cushion Seat onto the unit.

Fully tighten all screws now.



### Step 5


Fitting the Corner Block

**Note:** It would be useful to ask someone to help you at this stage.

a: Use Screw to fix the Corner Block 5 onto the unit.

**b:** Use Screw **(1)** to fix the Corner Block **(6)** onto the unit.

Fully tighten all screws now.



### Step 6

#### Finishing the unit

**Note:** Before use always make sure the unit is secure.


