- *Warning:* This unit weighs approximately 60kgs. Please lift with care.
- Check you have all the components and tools listed on pages 2 and 3.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.

- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.
- Do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor (use opened out unit carton).



• We do not recommend the use of power drill/drivers *for inserting screws*,


as this could damage the unit. Only use hand screwdrivers.

- Safety note: It is recommended that this unit is secured to a wall using the bracket supplied.
- Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.

Care and maintenance

- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do no use bleach or abrasive cleaners.
- From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit.






Step 1

Prepare the left side

Screw 4 metal dowels B into the left side 1.

Note: Tighten metal dowels up fully against the panel.


Fit 4 hinge plates **J** onto the left side **1**, making sure that the slot is facing towards the finished front edge.

Insert 2 large locking nuts G into the left side 1.


Note: The arrow on the locking nut must point towards the hole in the edge of the panel.

Tap a wooden dowel into the left side 1.

Note: Wooden dowels must not stick out from the edge by more than 10mm or they may damage other panels.


Step 4

Fit the base to the right side

Push the base **4** onto the right side **2**.

Use a screwdriver to tighten the 2 large locking nuts ⓒ fitted to the base 4.

Note: Turn the large locking nuts **O** as far as they will go - more than 1/2 a turn.




Step 5

Prepare the plinth

Insert 2 large locking nuts **C** into the plinth **7**.

Tap 2 wooden dowels (A) into the plinth 7.




Step 6

Fit the plinth

Push the plinth **7** onto the right side **2**.

Use a screwdriver to tighten the large locking nut **G** fitted to the plinth **7**.




Step 7

Prepare the back rail

Insert 2 large locking nuts C into the back rail 6.

Tap 2 wooden dowels (A) into the back rail (6).




Step 8

Fit the back rail to the left side

Push the back rail 6 onto the left side 1.


Use a screwdriver to tighten the large locking nut **C** fitted to the back rail 6.



Step 10

Prepare the top

Screw 4 metal dowels B into the top 3.




Step 11

Fit the top and plastic nails

Push the top 3 onto the assembly.

Use a screwdriver to tighten the 4 large locking nuts **O** fitted to the left side **1** and right side **2**.

Tap 2 plastic nails N into the bottom edge of each of the sides 1 and 2.



Step 12

Fit the back

a: Square up the unit by making sure that measurement **x to x** equals y to y.

b: Place the back **10** onto the unit.

V

Nail **D** around the outside edges of the back **10**.

Note: Nails should be spaced about 150mm apart.

Stand the unit up for the next step.

Step 13


Fit the hanging rails

You can fit the 2 hanging rails **8** using any of the 4 positions shown opposite.

Note: The rail at position 4 is used for shoe storage.

Insert 2 rail holders **1** for each of the 2 rails and then secure with them with screws **6**.

Push the hanging rails **8** down into the rail holders **1**.




Step 14

Fit the shelves

Insert 4 shelf studs **G** at position 1 or 2 for the shelf **5**.

Lower the shelf **5** down onto the shelf studs **G**.



Step 15

Prepare the 2 doors

Push fit 4 hinges (K) into each of the doors 9.

Secure each hinge with 2 screws **F**.

Note: Before securing with the screws, make sure that the hinges are positioned at 90 degrees with the edge of the door.

Step 16

Fit doors and handles

Note: The easiest way to attach each door **9** is to fit the top hinge first, then align and fit the other hinges.


a: Push the hinge **(S)** onto the front part of the hinge plate **(D)**. The recess at the bottom of screw B goes into the slot in the hinge plate.

b: Keep the hinge **K** FLAT against the hinge plate **O** as you slide it across as far as it will go. Tighten screw A.

C: The hinge **(K)** must be flat against the hinge plate **()** prior to any adjustment.

d: The hinge **()** must NOT be AT AN ANGLE to the hinge plate **()** when assembled. This would indicate that the recess at the bottom of screw B had not located in the slot in the hinge plate and the hinge would not be secure. Remove the hinge from the hinge plate and then re-assemble being careful to follow instructions a-c.

e: Attach a handle **(M)** to each door **(9)** using 2 screws **(+)**.



Step 17

Adjust the doors if needed

a: Before adjusting the doors, use a spirit level to check the base (or top) of the unit is level, front-to-back and side-to-side in the 3 positions shown. Use suitable packing pieces (not supplied) to make the unit level BEFORE making any adjustment to the hinges, as shown.

b: Height adjustment.


Loosen screws A on hinge plates and move door up or down as required. Retighten screw A.

C: Forward and Back adjustment.

Loosen screw B on hinge plate and move door in or out as required. Retighten screw B.

d: Sideways adjustment.

To move door 'out' loosen screw C. To move door 'in' tighten screw C.



Step 18

Attach bracket to top

To prevent possible overbalancing, we recommend that this unit is secured to a suitable wall by use of the bracket fitted to the top of the unit.

Fixings are not supplied, as they will need to suit the wall type and the length of screw will depend on the distance from the back of the unit to the wall.

Fix the bracket **D** loosely onto the top of the unit using screw **D** and mark the wall for the wall fixing.


Swivel the bracket away from the wall and drill a hole in the wall using a suitable drill bit and fit your wall fixing.

Swivel the bracket **b** back and fix the bracket to the wall, then tighten Screw **b**.

Note: Take care when drilling the wall that you do not drill into any pipes, wires etc. If in doubt, consult an expert.


