

Safety and Care Advice

Important - Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

- *Warning:* This unit weighs approximately 30kgs. Please lift with care.
- Check you have all the components and tools listed on pages 2 and 3.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.

- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.
- Do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor (use opened out unit carton).



• We do not recommend the use of power drill/drivers *for inserting screws*,

as this could damage the unit. Only use hand screwdrivers.

- Safety note: It is recommended that this unit is secured to a wall using the bracket supplied.
- Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.

Care and maintenance


- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do no use bleach or abrasive cleaners.







Step 1

Prepare the drawer front

Screw 2 metal dowels **B** into the drawer front **4**.

Note: Tighten the metal dowels up fully against the panels.





Step 2


Prepare the drawer sides

Insert a small locking nut **①** into the hole shown on the left drawer side **⑤** and right drawer side **⑥**.

Note: Arrow on locking nut **must** point towards hole in edge of panel.








Step 3

Attach the drawer sides to the drawer front

Push the left drawer side 5 and right drawer side 6 onto the back of the drawer front 4.

Turn the small locking nuts **①** on the left drawer side **5** and right drawer side **6**.


Note: Turn the locking nuts **O** clockwise to secure panels - more than 1/2 a turn.



Step 4

Fit the drawer base

Slide the drawer base 8 down the grooves in the drawer sides 5 and 6 and down into the groove in the drawer front 4.




Step 5

Fit the drawer back

Fit the drawer back 7 between the drawer sides 5 and 6.

Make sure that the drawer base 8 fits into the groove in the drawer back 7.


Hold the drawer back 7 in position and tap the knock-in pegs (5) through the holes in the drawer sides (5) and (6).



Step 6

Attach the handle


Attach the handle N to the drawer front 4 using 2 screws H.



Step 7

Fit the wedgefixes

Turn the drawer assembly over and slide 2 wedgefixes into the front and back grooves, as shown, and tighten up the screws.





Step 8

Prepare the left side

a: Insert 4 large locking nuts **©** into the left side **9**.


Note: The arrow on the locking nuts **must** point towards the holes in the edge of the panel.

Turn the left side over

onto the left side 9. Slide back the top of runner and use the 2nd hole from the front to fit the 1st screw (3).

back the other way and fit the 2nd screw (into the corresponding hole in the left side).

d: Screw 10 metal dowels **3** into the left side **9**.



Step 9

Prepare the right side

a: Insert 4 large locking nuts (a) into the right side [10].


Note: The arrow on the locking nuts **must** point towards the holes in the edge of the panel.

Turn the right side over

onto the right side 10. Slide back the top of runner and use the 2nd hole from the front to fit the 1st screw (...)

back the other way and fit the 2nd screw (into the corresponding hole in the right side 10.

d: Screw 10 metal dowels **B** into the right side **10**.




Step 10

Prepare the 2 fascias

Screw 4 metal dowels **B** into each of the 2 fascias **11**].

Tap a wooden dowel **A** into each of the 2 fascias **11**.

Note: Wooden dowels must not stick out from the edge by more than 10mm or they may damage other panels.




Step 11

Join the left side to the left side fascia

a: Push the left side 9 down onto the left side fascia panel 11.

b: Use a screwdriver to tighten the 4 large locking nuts **©** fitted to the left side **9**.

Note: Turn the large locking nuts **(C)** as far as they will go - more than 1/2 a turn.




Step 12

Join the right side to the right side fascia

Push the right side 10 down onto the right side fascia panel 11.


Use a screwdriver to tighten the 4 large locking nuts **©** fitted to the right side **10**.



Step 13

Prepare the 4 shelves

Insert 4 large locking nuts **©** into each of the 4 shelves **2**.




Step 14

Fit the shelves

Push the 4 shelves 2 onto the right side 10.

Use a screwdriver to tighten the 2 large locking nuts • fitted to each shelf 2.




Step 15

Prepare the plinths

Tap 2 wooden dowels **A** into each of the plinths **3**.

Insert 2 large locking nuts (2) into each of the plinths [3].




Step 16

Fit the plinths

Push the 2 plinths 3 onto the right side 10.

Use a screwdriver to tighten the large locking nut **©** fitted to each plinth **3**.



Step **17** Fit the left side Push the left side 9 onto the assembly. Use a screwdriver to tighten the 10 large locking nuts **(c)** fitted to the 4 shelves **(2)** and the 2 plinths 3. 2 2 9 Step 18 Fit the top 1 Attach the top 1 to the unit using 4 screws G.

Step **19**

Fit the back


a: Square up the unit by making sure that measurement **x** to **x** equals y to y.

The measurement from top corner X to bottom corner X must be equal to the measurement from top corner Y to bottom corner Y

b: Place the back 12 onto the unit.

Nail **(E)** around the outside edges of the back **12**.


Note: Nails should be spaced about 150mm apart.



Step 20

Fit the 4 plastic nails

Tap 2 plastic nails into the bottom edge of each of the sides 9 and 10.



Stand the unit up for the next step.



Warning: The unit is heavy. Lift with care.

Step 21


Fit the drawer

Slide both of the runners

forward and locate
the drawer sides 5 and
between them, lining
up the holes in the
drawer wrap with the
2nd 'threaded' holes in
the runners M.

Working from the inside of the drawer, insert 2 screws • through the drawer sides and out into the hole in the runner.

Note: Do not overtighten the screws. If they catch on the runner you may need to loosen them slightly.



Step 22


Fit the overbalance protector

To prevent possible overbalancing we recommend that this unit is secured to a suitable wall by use of the overbalance protector kit of fitted to the unit or, an alternative fixing method of your choice.

Wall fixings are not supplied as they will need to suit the wall type.

Note: Take care when drilling the wall that you do not drill into any pipes, wires etc. If in doubt, consult an expert.
