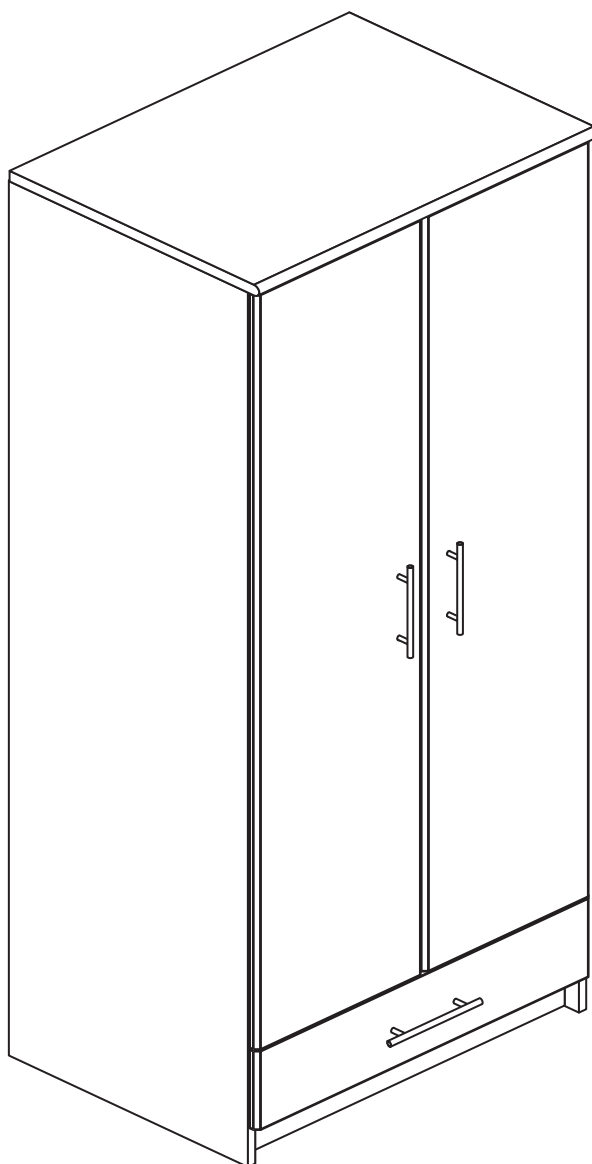

Safety and Care Advice

Important - Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

- **Warning:** This unit weighs approximately 48kgs. Please lift with care.
- Check you have all the components and tools listed on pages 1, 2 and 3.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.

- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.
- Do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor (use opened out unit carton).



• We do not recommend the use of power drill/drivers **for inserting screws**, as this could damage the unit. Only use hand screwdrivers.

• **Safety note:** It is recommended that this unit is secured to a wall using the bracket supplied.

• Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.

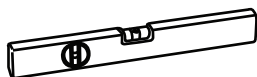
Care and maintenance

Step 1

Prepare the drawer front

Screw 2 metal dowels **B** into the holes shown on the back of the drawer front **7**.

Note: Tighten metal dowels up fully against the panels.



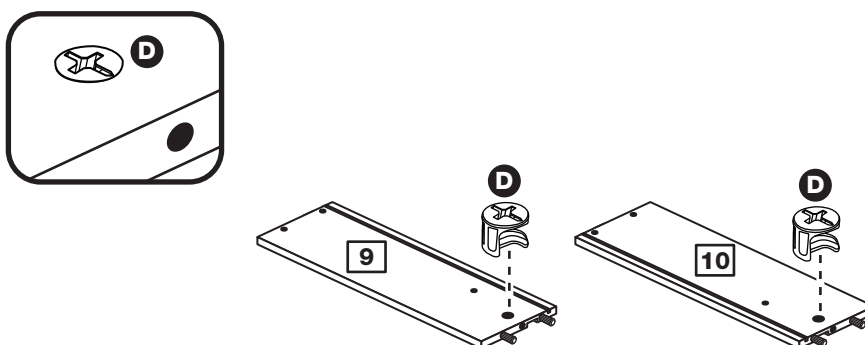
Step 2

Prepare the drawer sides

Insert a small locking nut **D** into the hole shown on the left drawer side **9** and right drawer side **10**.

Note: Arrow on locking nut **must** point towards hole in edge of panel.

Note: Due to the manufacturing process, the holes for the locking nut can be on either surface of the drawer sides.



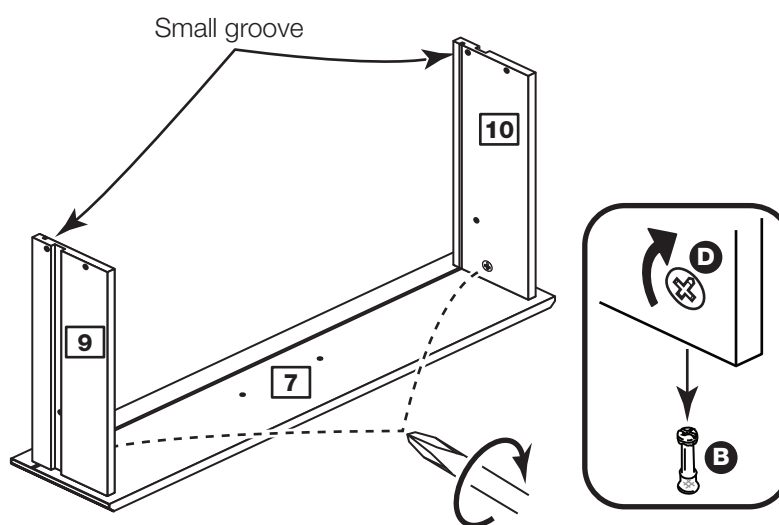
Step 3

Attach the drawer sides to the drawer front

Push the left drawer side **9** and right drawer side **10** onto the back of the drawer front **7**.

Turn the small locking nuts **D** on the left drawer side **9** and right drawer side **10**.

Note: Turn the locking nuts **D** clockwise to secure panels - more than 1/2 a turn.



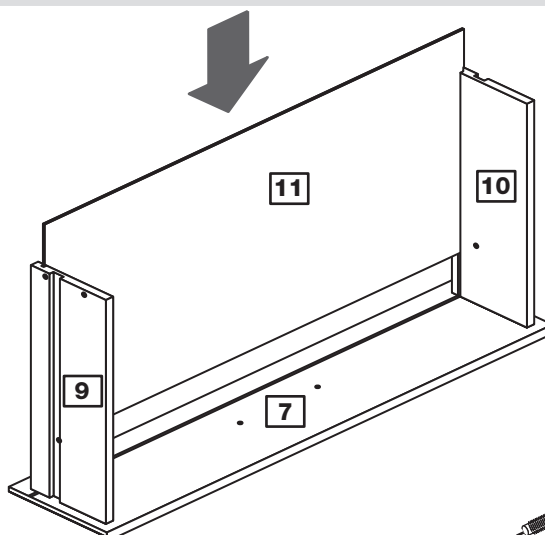
Note: The locking nuts can be on either surface of the drawer sides. Make sure that the small groove is on the inside, as shown.

Step 4

Fit the drawer base

Slide the drawer base **11** down the grooves in the drawer sides **9** and **10** and then down into the groove in the drawer front **7**.



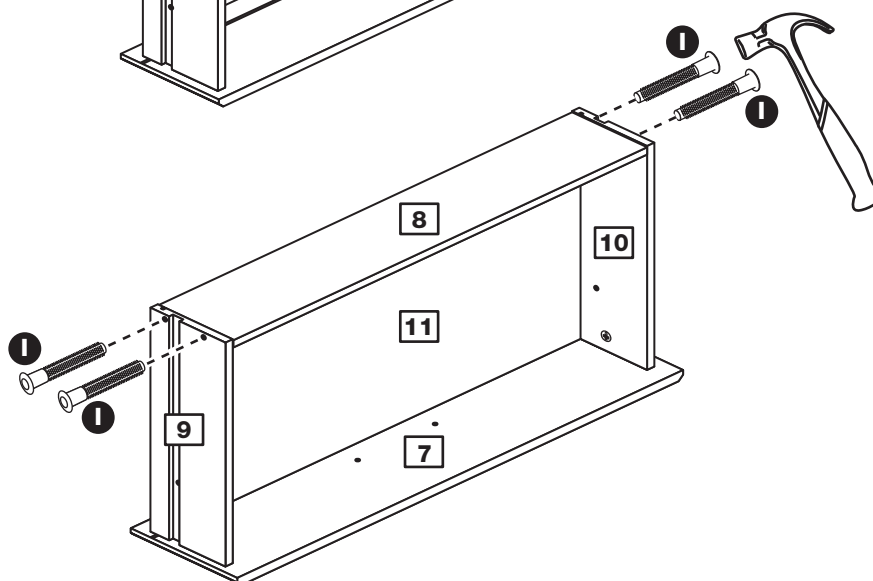
Step 5

Fit the drawer back

Fit the drawer back **8** between the drawer sides **9** and **10**.

Make sure that the drawer base **11** fits into the groove in the drawer back **8**.

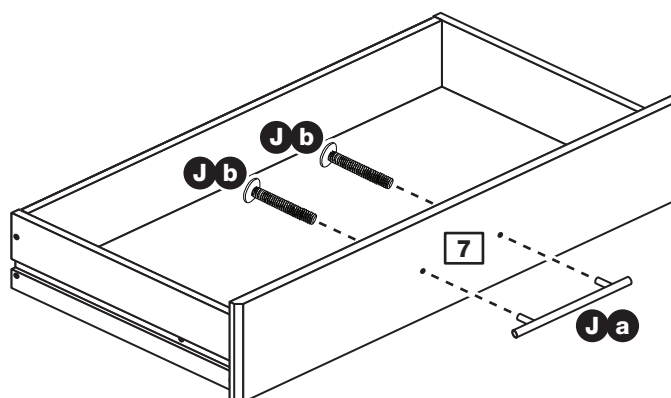
Hold the drawer back **8** in position and tap the knock-in pegs **I** through the holes in the drawer sides **9** and **10**.



Step 6

Attach the handle

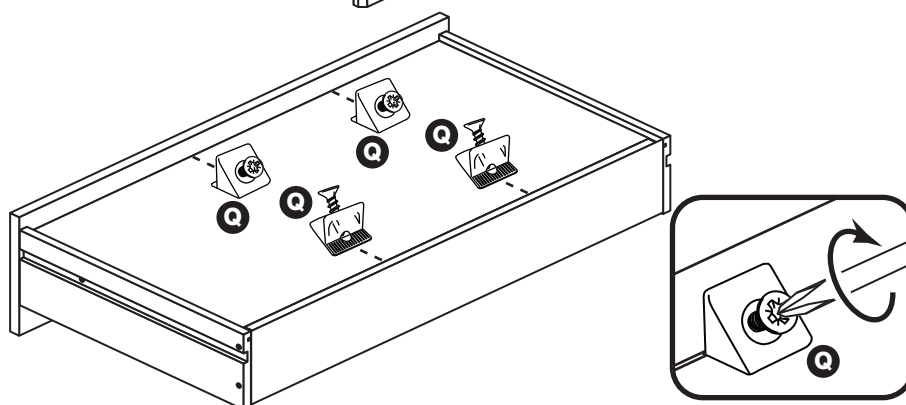
Attach the handle **J a** to the drawer front **7** using 2 screws **J b**.



Step 7

Fit the wedgifixes

Turn the drawer assemblies over and slide 2 wedgifixes **Q** into the front and back grooves, as shown, and tighten up the screws.

Step 8

Prepare the left side

a: Place a runner **O** on the left side **1**. Slide back the top of runner and use the 2nd hole from the front to fit the 1st screw **H**.

b: Slide the runner back the other way and fit the 2nd screw **H** into the corresponding hole in the left side **1**.

Screw 5 metal dowels **B** into the left side **1**.

c: Tap a wooden dowel **A** into the left side **1**.

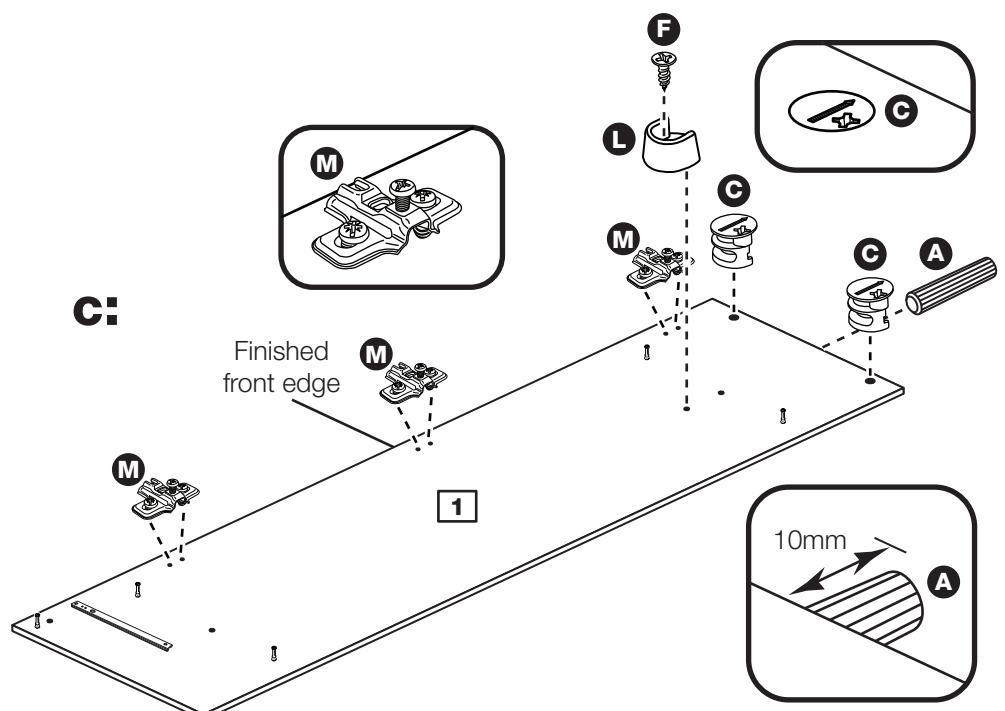
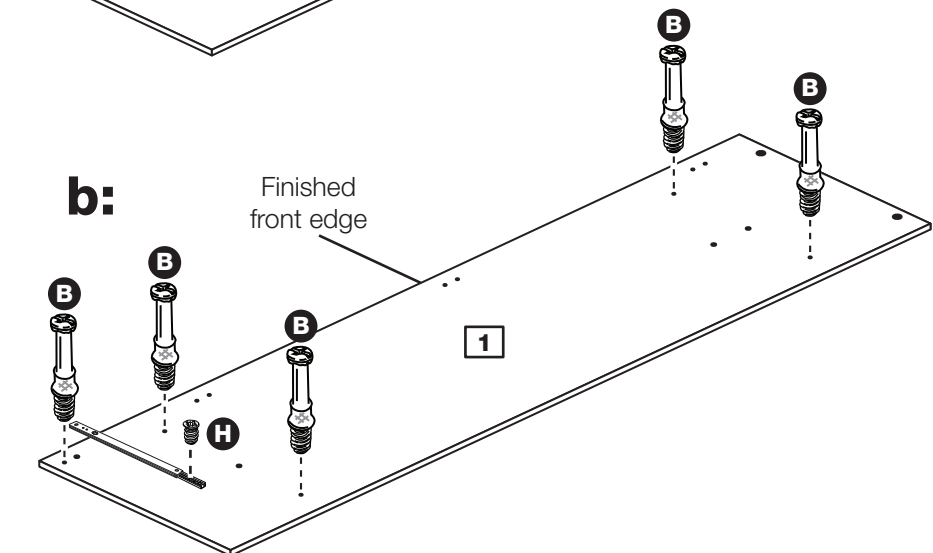
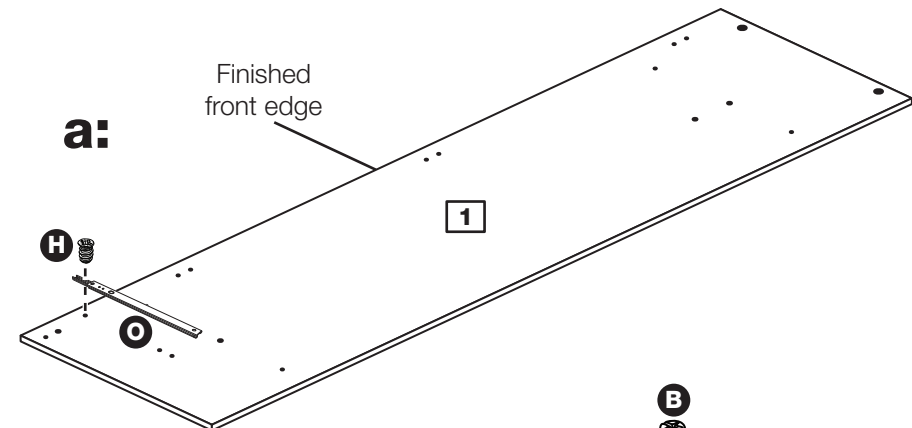
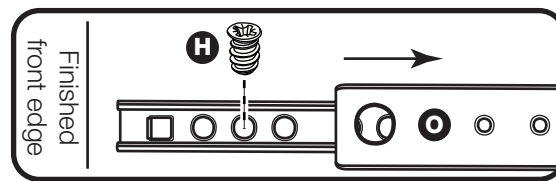
Note: Wooden dowels **must not** stick out from the edge by more than 10mm or they may damage other panels.

Insert 2 large locking nuts **C** into the left side **1**.

Note: The arrow on the locking nut **must** point towards the hole in the edge of the panel.

Push a rail holder **L** into the left side **1**. Make sure that it is fitted straight, in line with the panel edges and then secure with screw **F**.

Fit 3 hinge plates **M** onto the left side **1**, making sure that the slot is facing towards the finished front edge.

Step 9

Prepare the right side

a: Place a runner **O** on the right side **2**. Slide back the top of runner and use the 2nd hole from the front to fit the 1st screw **H**.

b: Slide the runner back the other way and fit the 2nd screw **H** into the corresponding hole in the right side **2**.

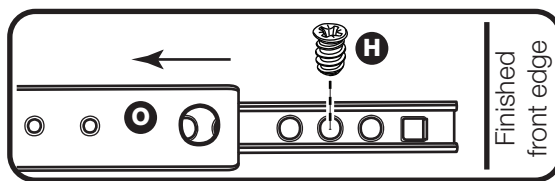
Screw 5 metal dowels **B** into the right side **2**.

c: Tap a wooden dowel **A** into the right side **2**.

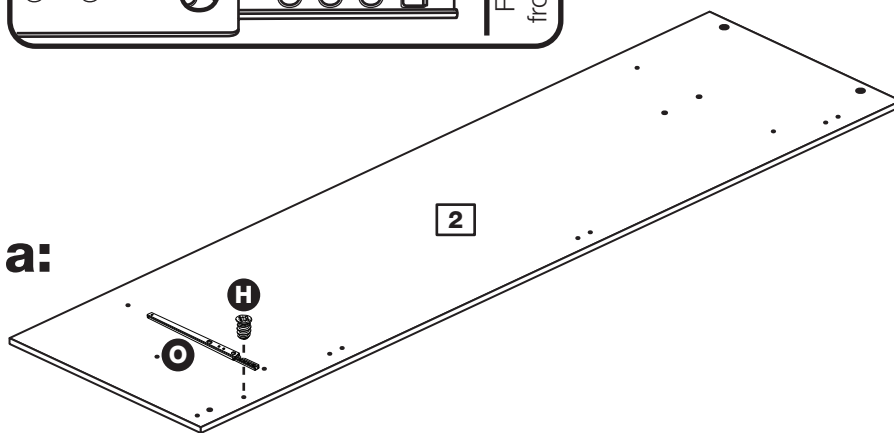
Insert 2 large locking nuts **C** into the right side **2**.

Push a rail holder **L** into the right side **2**. Make sure that it is fitted straight, in line with the panel edges and then secure with screw **F**.

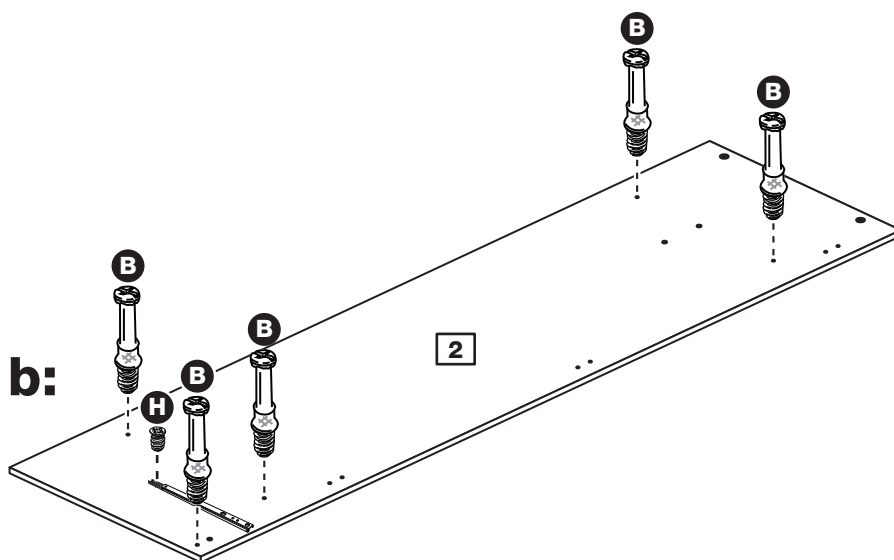
Fit 3 hinge plates **M** onto the right side **2**, making sure that the slot is facing towards the finished front edge.



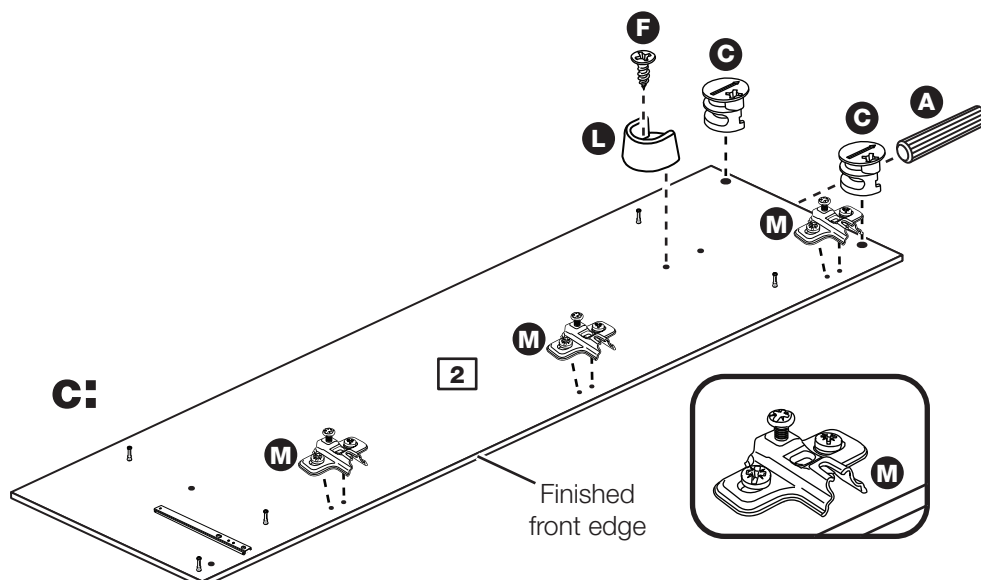

Step 10

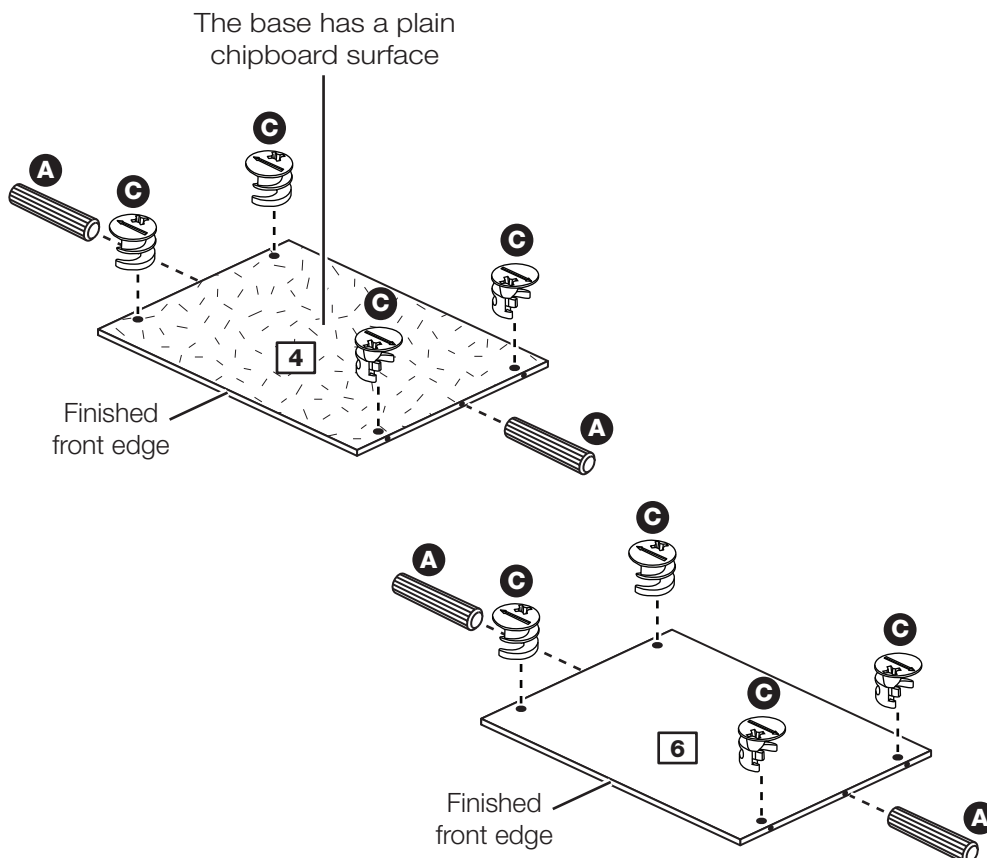
Prepare the base and horizontal

Tap 2 wooden dowels **A** into the base **4**.

Insert 4 large locking nuts **C** into the base **4**.

Tap 2 wooden dowels **A** into the horizontal **6**.

Insert 4 large locking nuts **C** into the horizontal **6**.



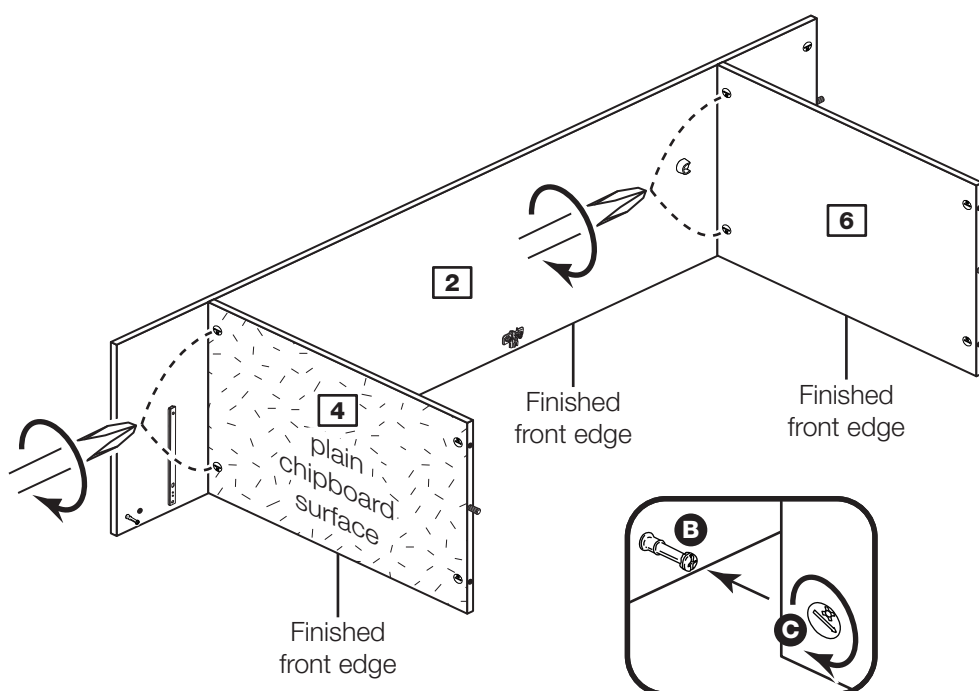
Step 11

Join the horizontal and base to the right side

Push the horizontal **6** and base **4** onto the right side **2** as shown.

Use a screwdriver to tighten the 2 large locking nuts **C** fitted to both the horizontal **6** and base **4**.

Note: Turn the large locking nuts **C** as far as they will go - more than 1/2 a turn.



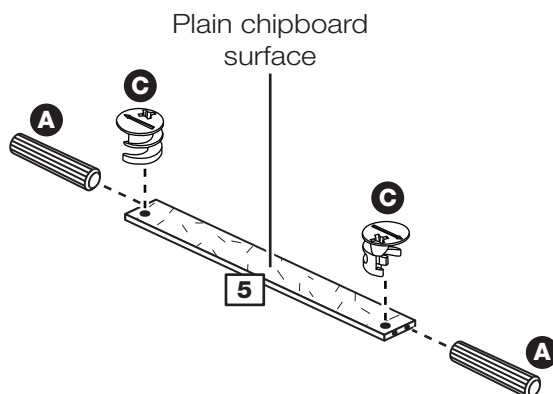

Step 12

Prepare the plinth

Tap 2 wooden dowels **A** into the plinth **5**.

Insert 2 large locking nuts **C** into the plinth **5**.

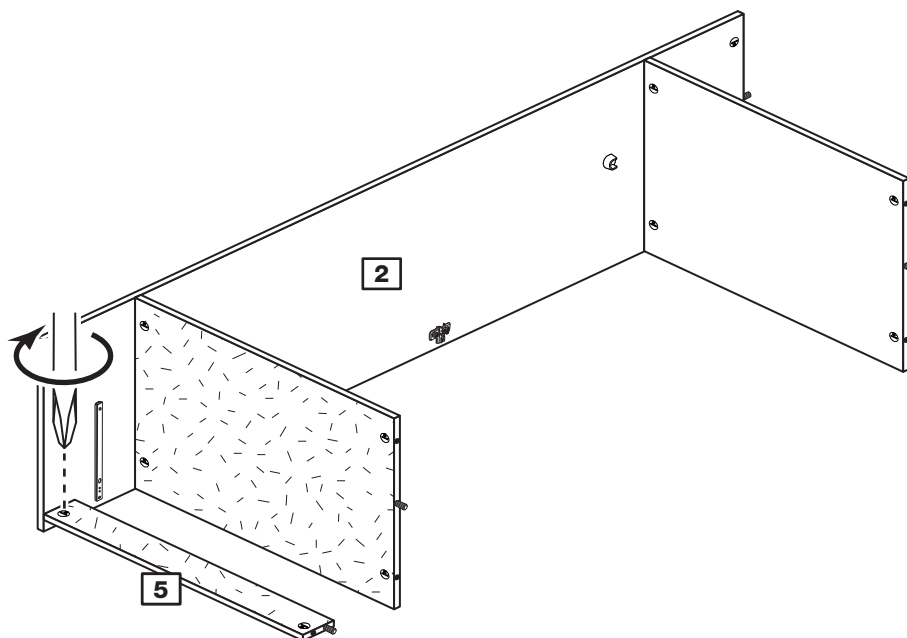


Step 13

Fit the plinth

Push the plinth **5** onto the right side **2**.

Use a screwdriver to tighten the large locking nut **C** fitted to the plinth **5**.

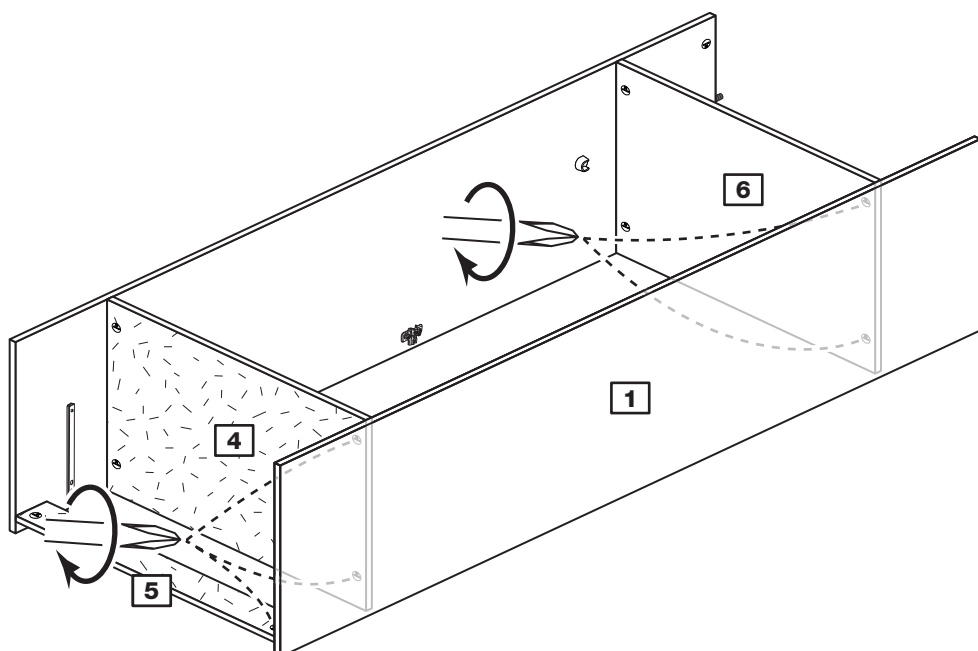


Step 14

Fit the left side

Push the left side **1** onto the assembly.

Use a screwdriver to tighten the 5 large locking nuts **C** fitted to the horizontal **6**, plinth **5** and base **4**.

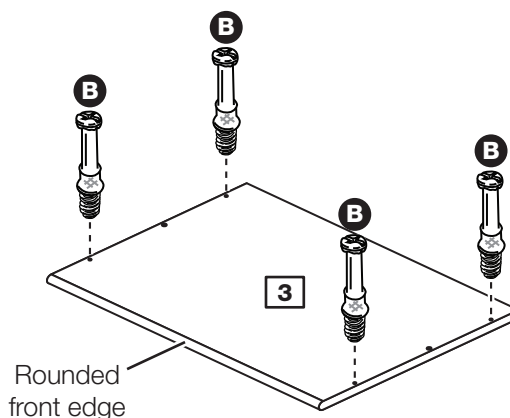

Step 15

Prepare the top

Screw 4 metal dowels **B** into the holes shown on the top **3**.

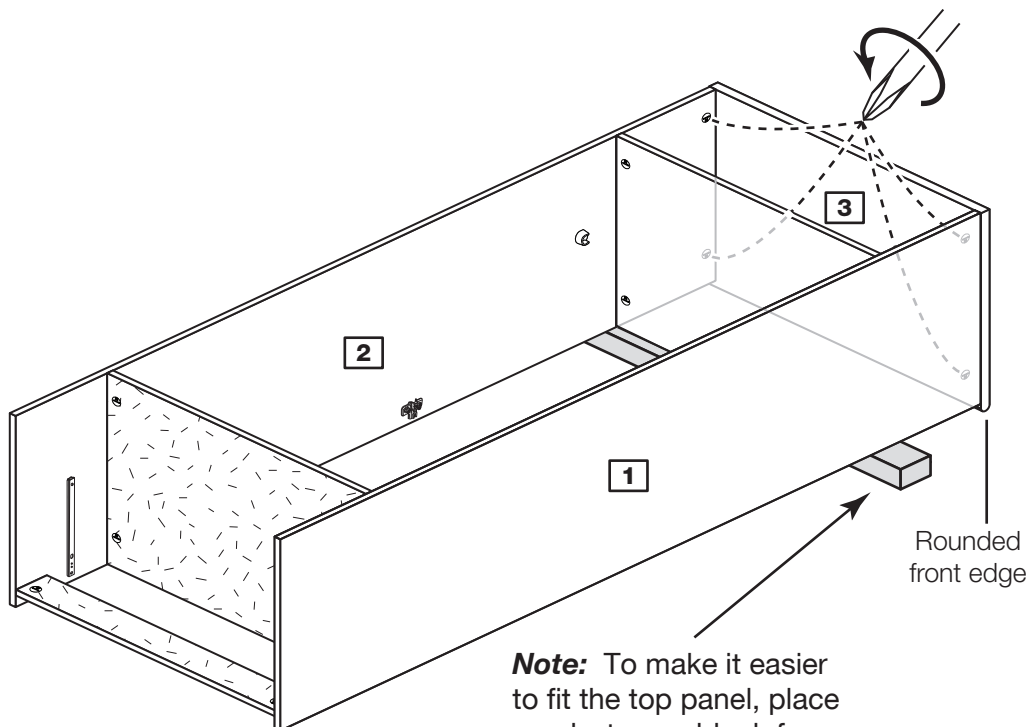


Step 16

Fit the top

Push the top **3** onto the side panels **1** and **2**.

Use a screwdriver to tighten the 4 large locking nuts **C** fitted to the side panels **1** and **2**.



Note: To make it easier to fit the top panel, place a polystyrene block from the packaging underneath the side panels to raise the assembly.

Step 17

Fit the back

a: Square up the unit by making sure that measurement **x** to **x** equals **y** to **y**.

b: Place the back **14** onto the unit.

Nail **P** around the outside edges of the back **14**.

Note: Nails should be spaced about 150mm apart.

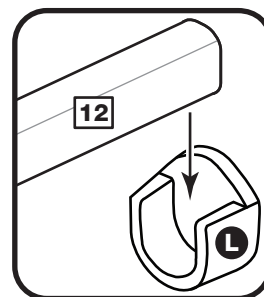
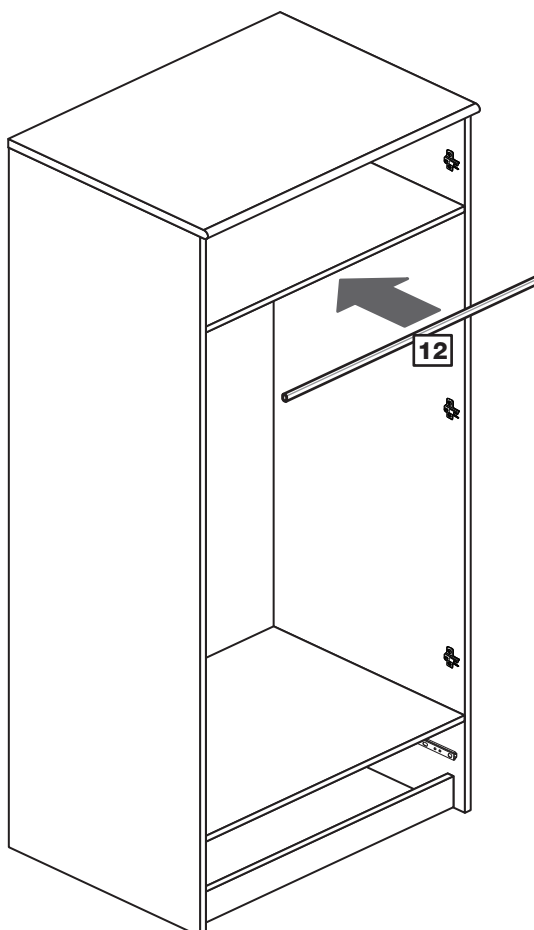
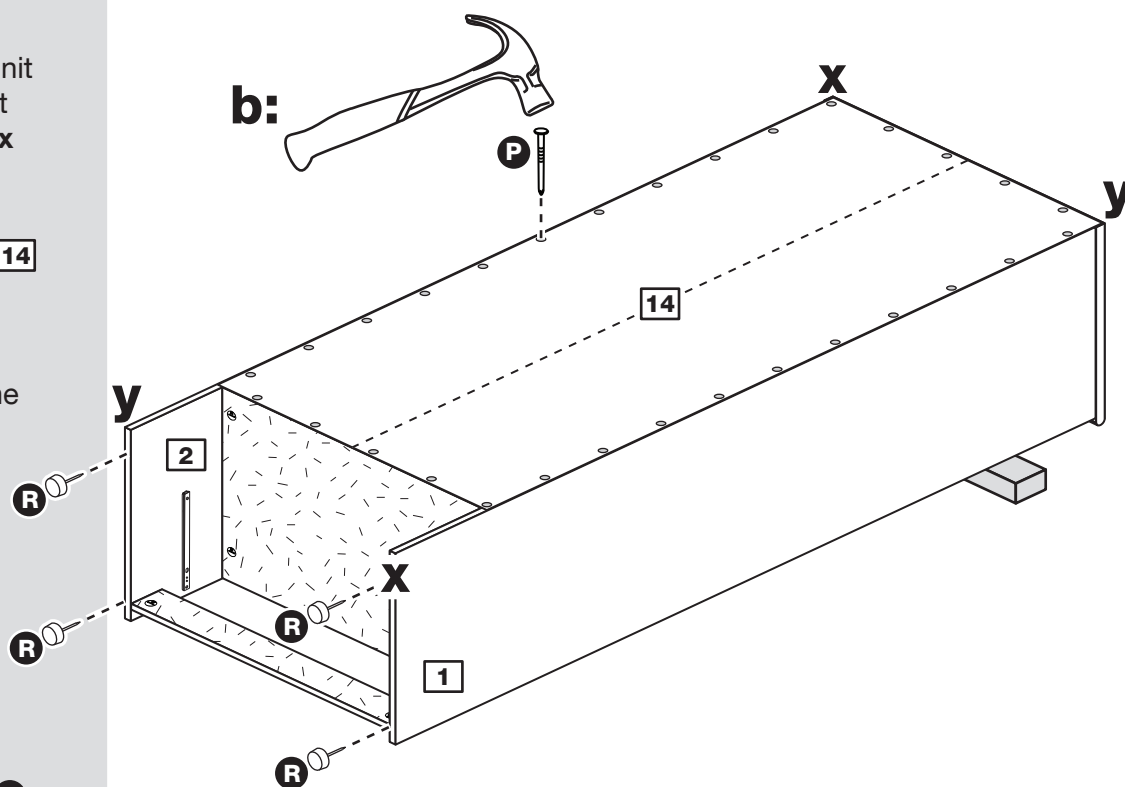
Tap 2 plastic nails **R** into the bottom edge of each of the sides **1** and **2**.

Stand the unit up for the next step.



Warning: The unit is heavy. Lift with care.

a: The measurement from top corner X to bottom corner X must be equal to the measurement from top corner Y to bottom corner Y



Step 18

Fit the hanging rail

Push the hanging rail **12** into the rail holders **L** fitted to the side panels.

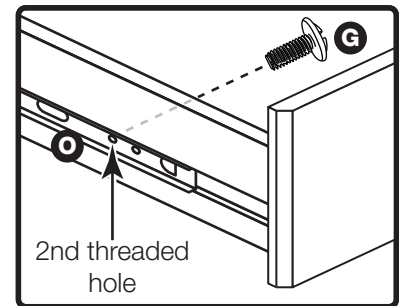
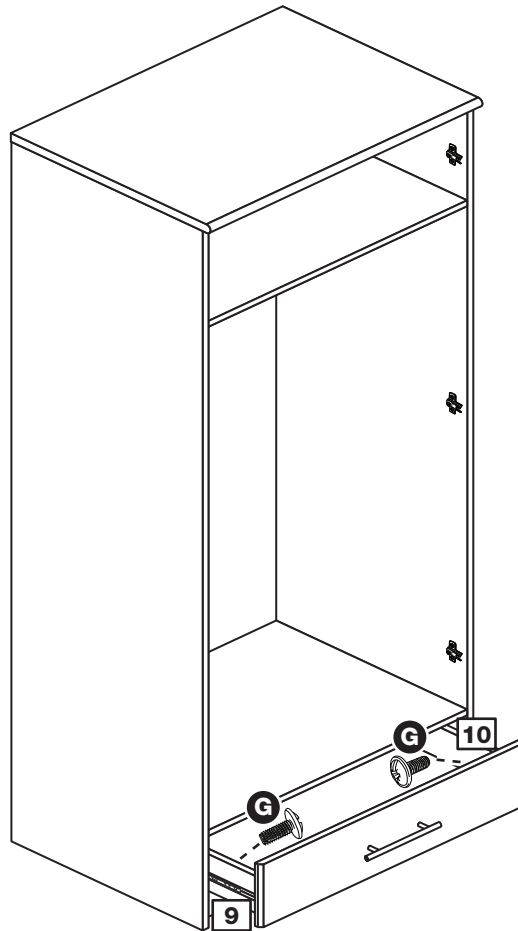
Step 19

Fit the drawer

Slide both the runners **O** forward and locate the drawer sides **9** and **10** between them, lining up the holes in the drawer wrap with the 2nd 'threaded' holes in the runners **O**.

Working from the inside of the drawer, insert 2 screws **G** through the drawer sides and out into the 2nd threaded hole in the runner.

Note: Do not overtighten the screws **G**. If they catch on the runner you may need to loosen them slightly.



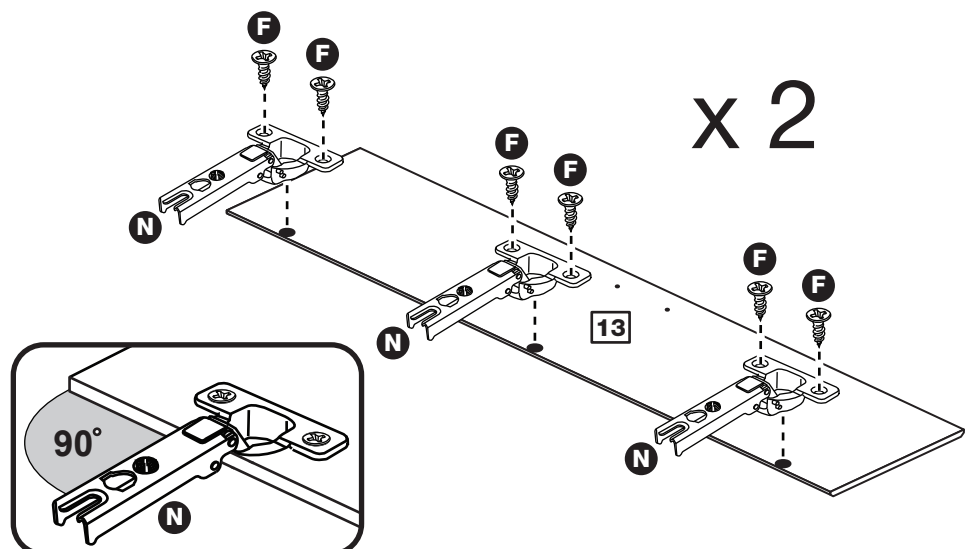
Step 20

Prepare the 2 doors

Push fit 3 hinges **N** into each of the doors **13**.

Secure each hinge with 2 screws **F**.

Note: Before securing with the screws, make sure that the hinges are positioned at 90 degrees with the edge of the door.



Assembly Instructions

Step 21

Fit doors and handles

Note: The easiest way to attach each door **13** is to fit the top hinge first, then align and fit the other hinges.

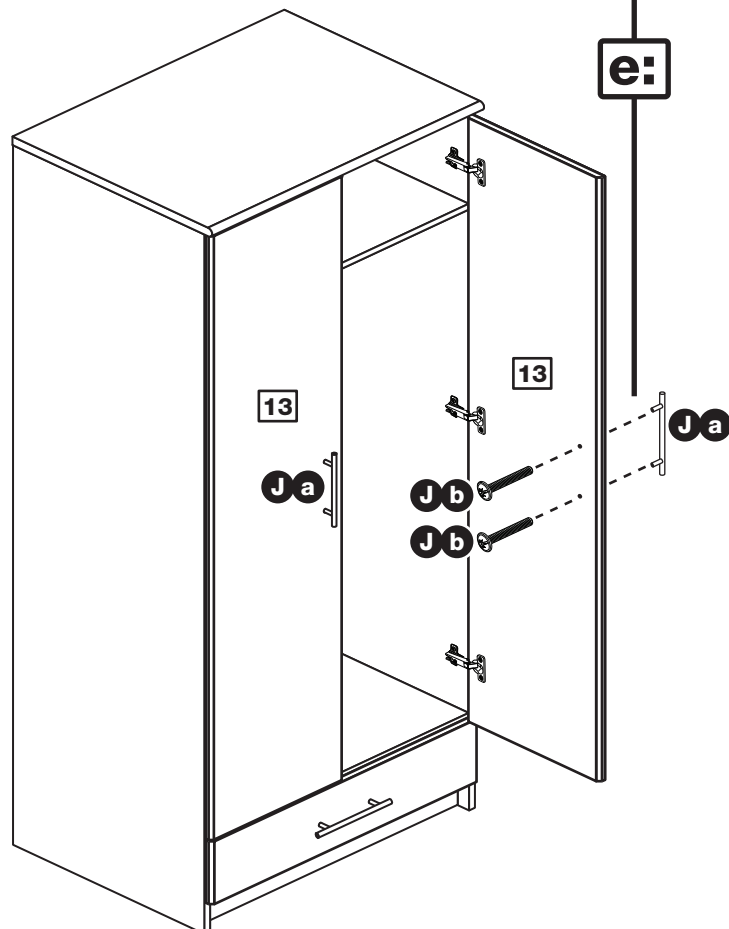
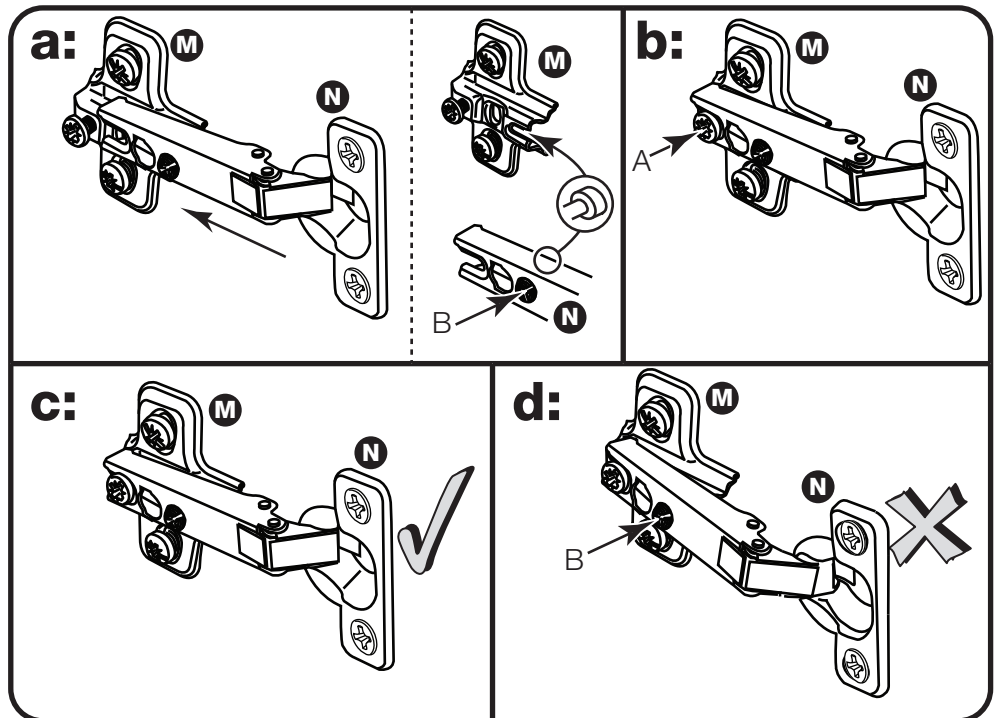
a: Push the hinge **N** onto the front part of the hinge plate **M**. The recess at the bottom of screw B goes into the slot in the hinge plate.

b: Keep the hinge **N** FLAT against the hinge plate **M** as you slide it across as far as it will go. Tighten screw A.

c: The hinge **N** must be flat against the hinge plate **M** prior to any adjustment.

d: The hinge **N** must NOT BE AT AN ANGLE to the hinge plate **M** when assembled. This would indicate that the recess at the bottom of screw B had not located in the slot in the hinge plate and the hinge would not be secure. Remove the hinge from the hinge plate and then re-assemble being careful to follow instructions a-c.

e: Attach a handle **Ja** to each door **13** using 2 screws **Jb**.



Assembly Instructions

Step 22

Adjust the doors if needed

a: Before adjusting the doors, use a spirit level to check the base (or top) of the unit is level, front-to-back and side-to-side in the 3 positions shown. Use suitable packing pieces (not supplied) to make the unit level BEFORE making any adjustment to the hinges, as shown.

b: Height adjustment.

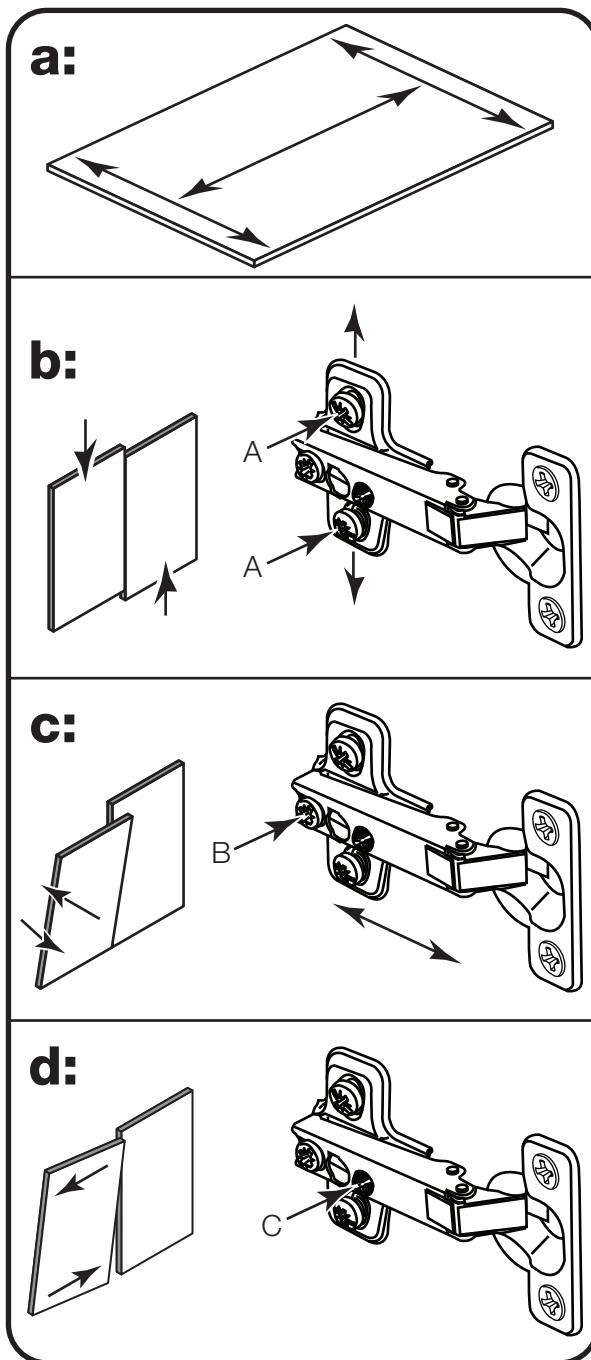
Loosen screws A on hinge plates and move door up or down as required. Retighten screw A.

c: Forward and Back adjustment.

Loosen screw B on hinge plate and move door in or out as required. Retighten screw B.

d: Sideways adjustment.

To move door 'out' loosen screw C. To move door 'in' tighten screw C.



Assembly Instructions

Step 23

Fit the bracket

To prevent possible overbalancing, we recommend that this unit is secured to a suitable wall by use of the bracket **K** fitted to the top of the unit.

Fixings are not supplied, as they will need to suit the wall type and the length of screw will depend on the distance from the back of the unit to the wall.

Fix the bracket **K** loosely onto the top of the unit using screw **E** and mark the wall for the wall fixing.

Swivel the bracket **K** away from the wall and drill a hole in the wall using a suitable drill bit and fit your wall fixing.

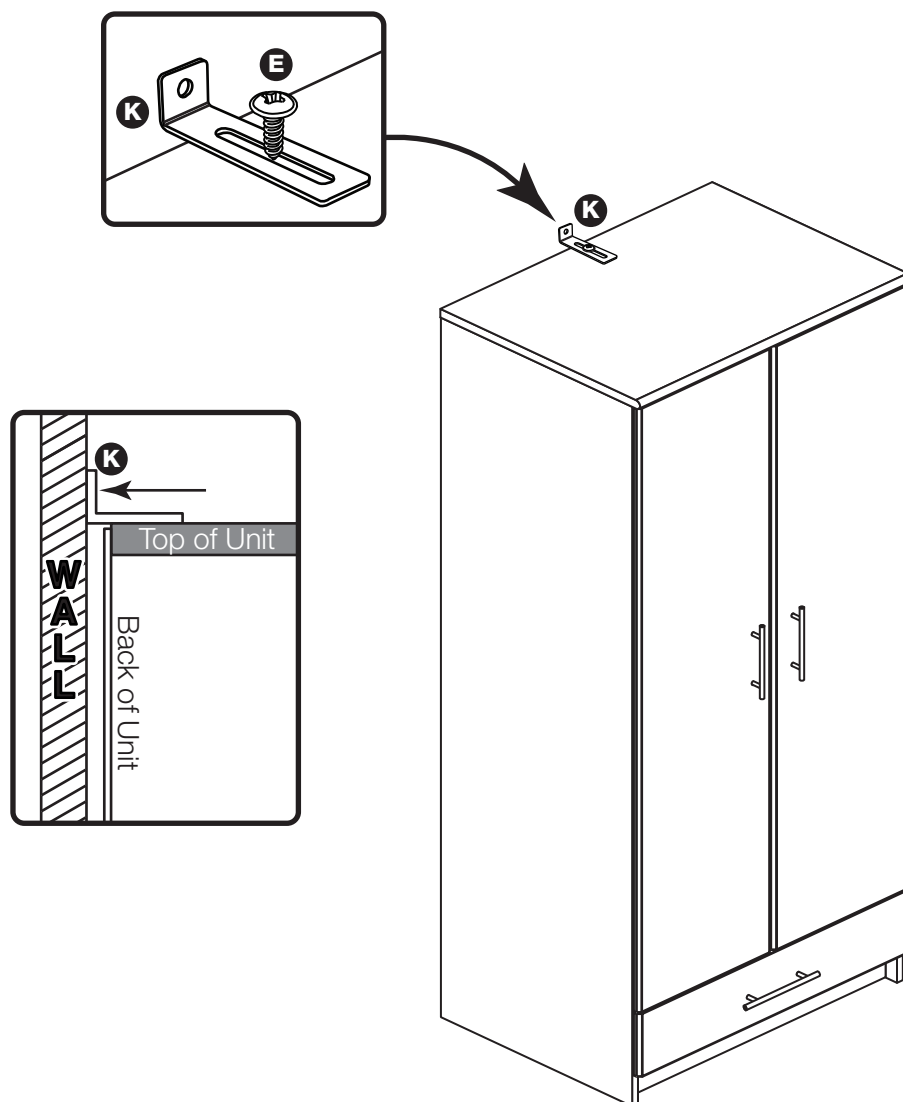
Swivel the bracket **K** back and fix the bracket to the wall, then tighten Screw **E**.

Note: Take care when drilling the wall that you do not drill into any pipes, wires etc. If in doubt, consult an expert.
