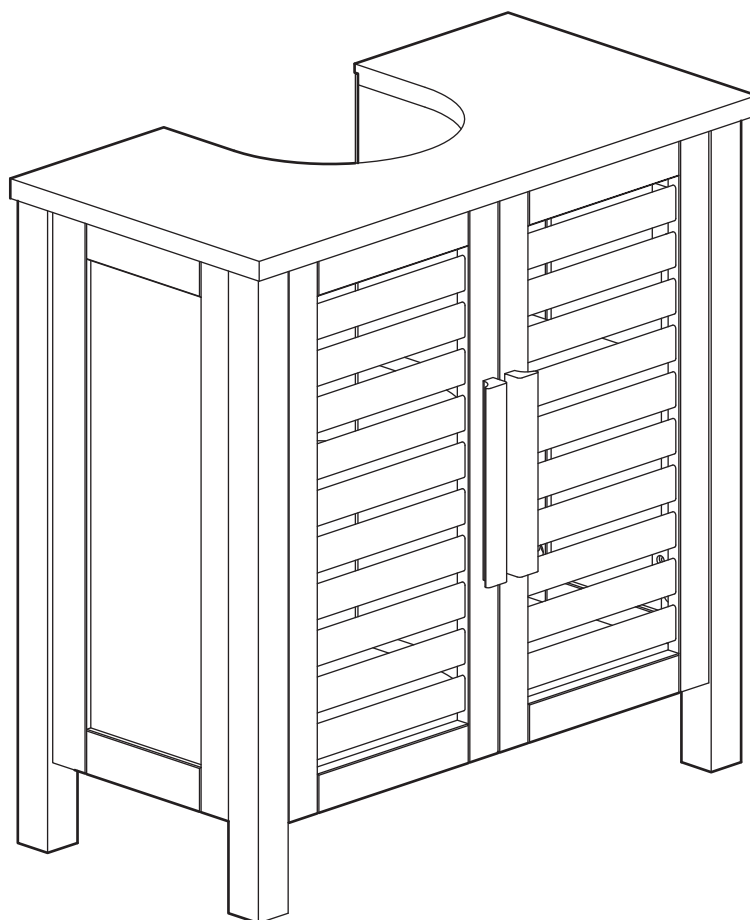

# Safety and care advice

**Important - Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly**

- Check you have all the components and tools listed on pages 2 and 3.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.
- Do not stand or put weight on the panels, this could cause damage.
- Assemble the unit as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.

- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.

• **Note:** Only apply the glue once you are sure of the assembly.

- The wall plugs supplied are suitable for solid walls only. It is important that the correct type of fixing is used for your wall, seek professional advice if in doubt.

- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.

- If using power tools, please follow the safety instructions supplied with the tools.



- We do not recommend the use of power drill/ drivers for inserting screws, as this could damage

the unit. Only use hand screwdrivers.

- **Warning:** Before drilling, check the wall for hidden pipes and cables.

- Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.

**Glue safety - Take care when using glue, please follow the advice below**

**Skin contact:** Remove contamination by washing with soap and water. This procedure should also be followed prior to eating and drinking.

**Eye contact:** Rinse immediately with clean water for 15 minutes and seek medical advice.

**If swallowed:** Seek medical advice immediately. If possible show product information or label to the medical advisor.

## Care and maintenance

- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do not use bleach or abrasive cleaners.

- From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit.

- This product should not be discarded with household waste. Take to your local authority waste disposal centre.

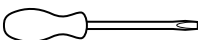
Note: The quantities below are the correct amount to complete the assembly. In some cases more fittings may be supplied than are required.

<b>D</b>  Φ4 x 12mm Screw x 16	<b>E</b>  Φ3 x 12mm Screw x 14	<b>F</b>  Metal Support x 4
<b>G</b>  Φ4 x 25mm Screw x 8	<b>H</b>  Wooden handle x 2	<b>I</b>  Φ4 x 25mm Screw x 4
<b>J</b>  Cam cap x 12	<b>K</b>  Screw cap x 4

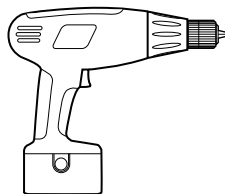

# Assembly Instructions

## Step 1

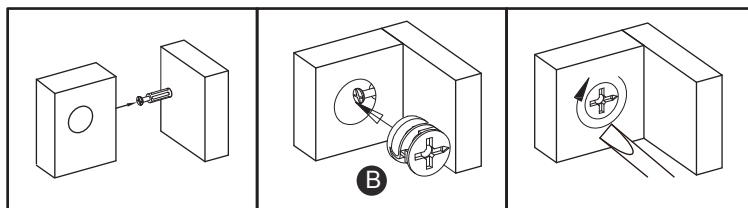
### Assembling left and right unit

Screw locking pin **A** into left front leg **1** and left back leg **2**.

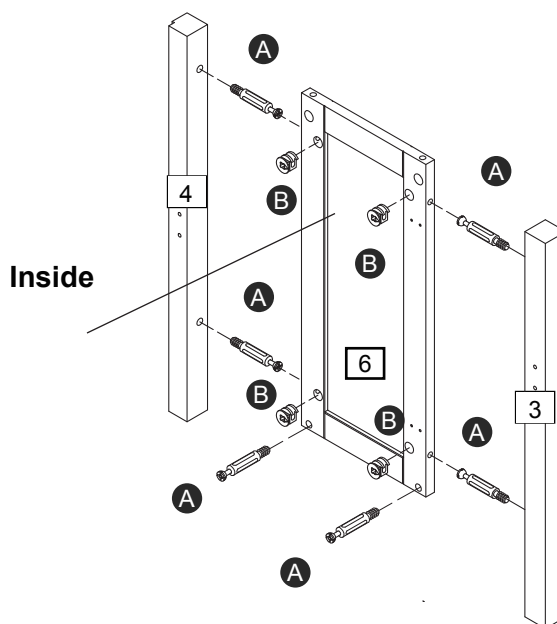
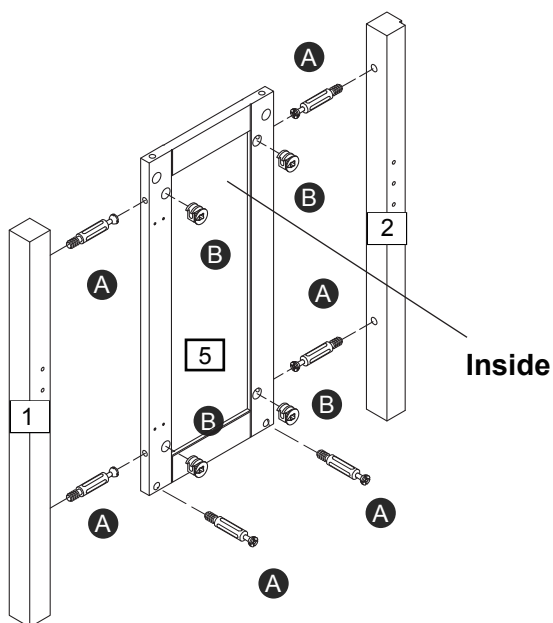
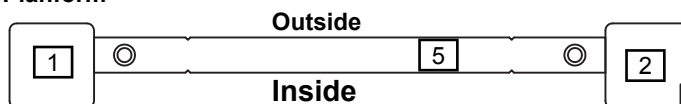
Screw locking pin **A** into left side panel **5**.

Attach left front leg and left back leg onto left side panel, Insert locking nut **B** into left side panel, and tighten the locking nut to secure the unit.

Repeat the above step to assembly other side unit as shown.

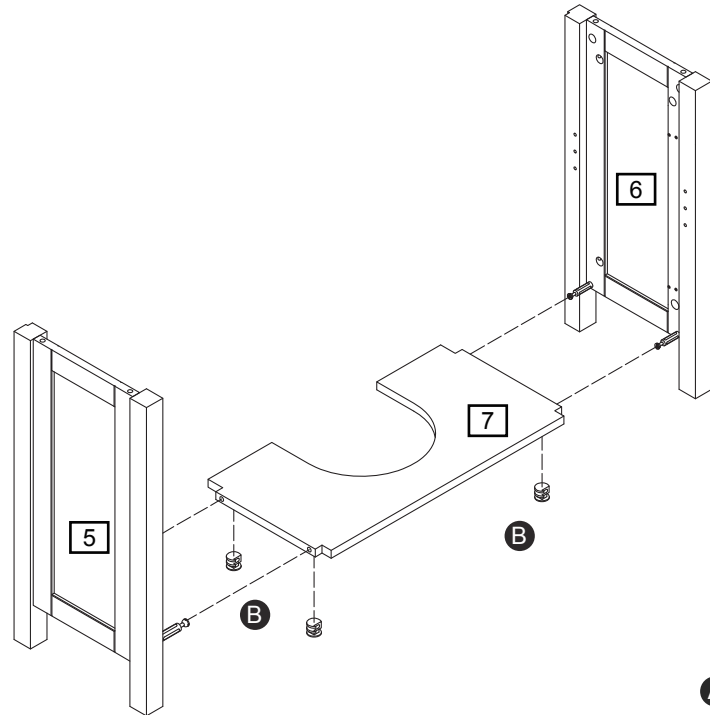
## Step 2

### Assembling bottom panel

NOTE: It would be useful to ask someone to help you at this stage.

Attach left side panel **5** and right side panel **6** to bottom panel **7**.

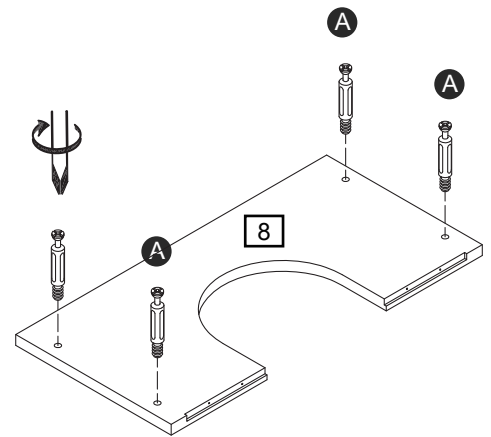
Insert locking nut **B** into bottom panel **7** and tighten it to secure the unit.



## Step 3

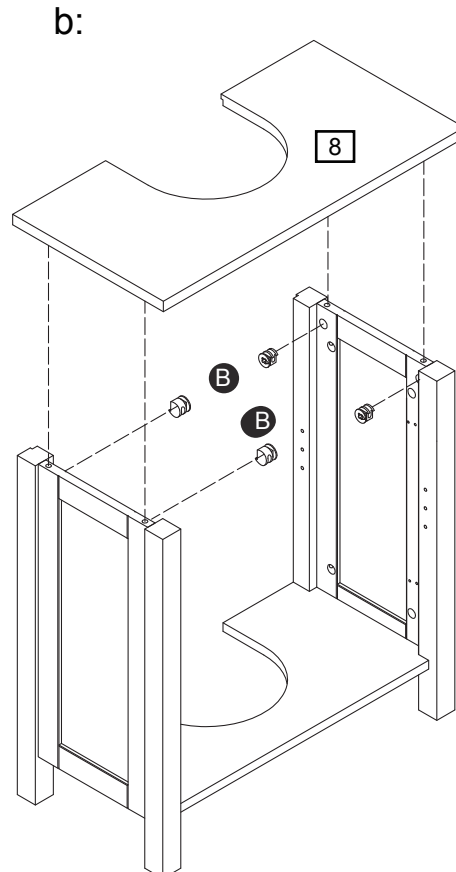
### Assembling top panel

a:  
Screw locking pin **A** into top panel **8**.



b:  
Carefully place the top panel **8** onto the unit. Insert locking nut **B** into left side panel and right side panel.

Tighten the locking nut **B** to secure the unit.



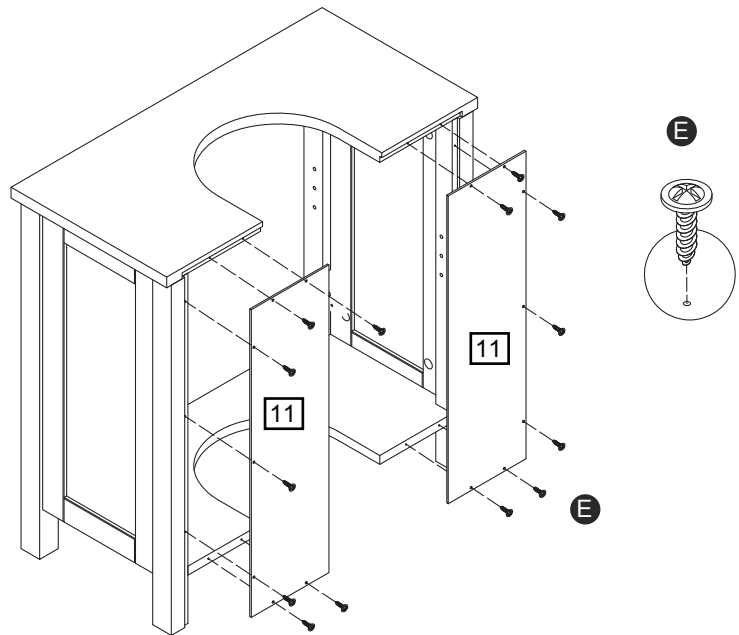

## Step 4

### Assembling back panel

NOTE: It would be useful to ask someone to help you at this stage.

Use 12mm screws **E** to attach back panels **11** onto the unit as shown.



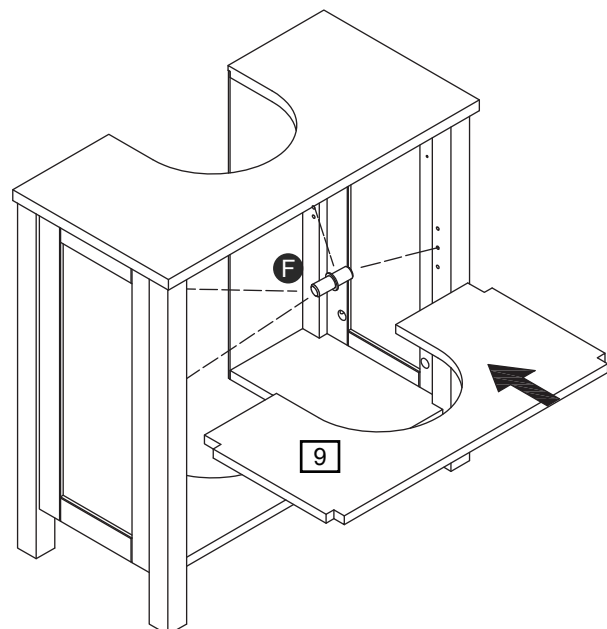
## Step 5

### Assembling adjustable shelf panel

NOTE: It would be useful to ask someone to help you at this stage.

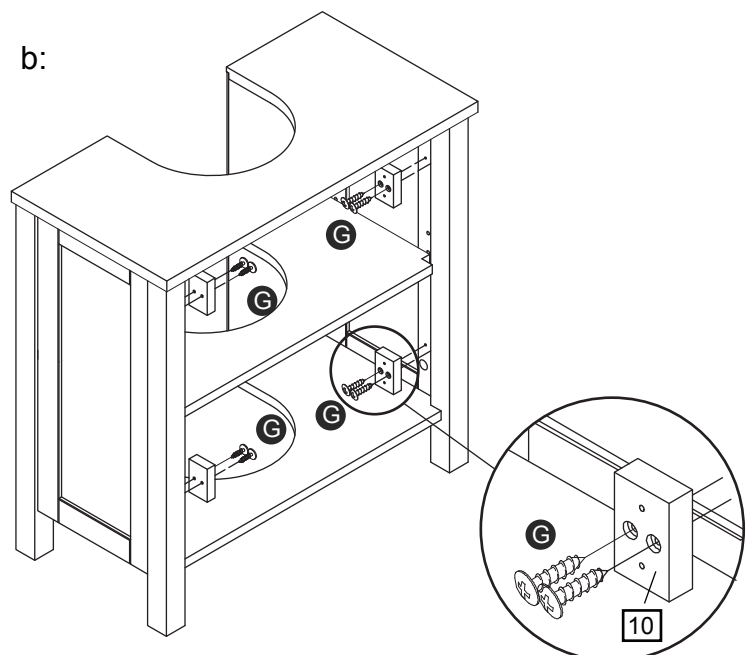
**a:**  
Insert metal support **F** into left & right side panels. Carefully put the adjustable shelf panel **9** on it.

Use 25mm screw **G** to fix small wood block **10** onto the left & right unit as shown.

# Assembly Instructions

## Step 6

### Assembling door panel

NOTE: It would be useful to ask someone to help you at this stage.

#### a:

Use 12mm screws **D** to fix curved hinge **C** onto door panels **12**.

Use 25mm screws **I** to fix handles **H** onto doors.

#### b:

Carefully attach door panels **12** to the unit by fixing curved hinge onto the side panels with 12mm screws **D**.

Adjust the door up or down, left or right, in or out if needed as shown:

1. Loosen two screws **D** and adjust the door up or down, then fix screws **D** again.

2. Loosen screw **C1** and adjust the door left or right, then fix screw **C1** again.

3. Loosen screw **C2** and adjust the door in or out, then fix screw **C2** again.

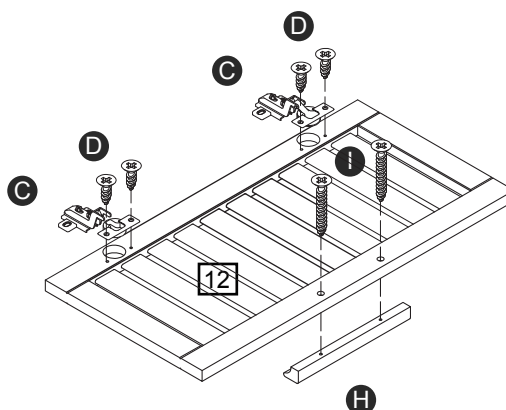

Use cam caps **J** to cover the visible cams

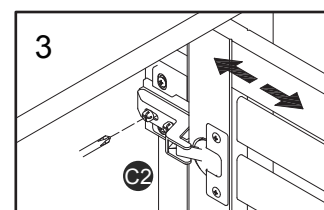
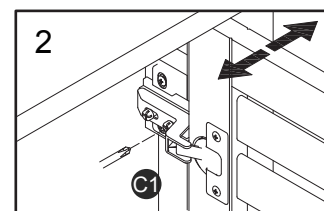
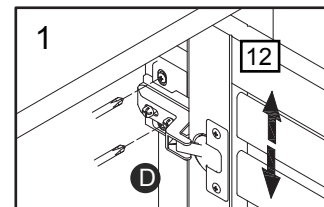
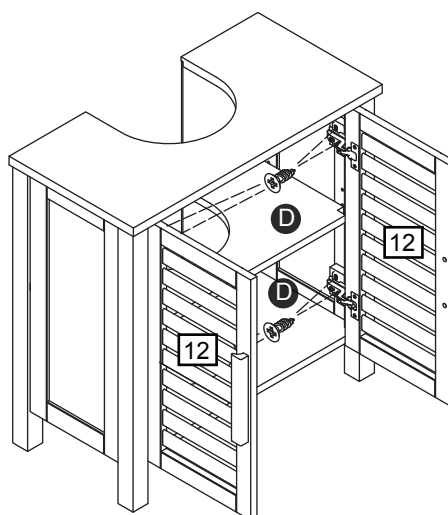
Use screw caps **K** to cover the visible screws

After above assembly, please double check and make sure all screws are firmly fixed before use.

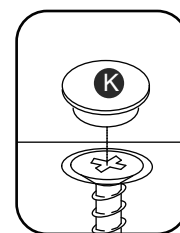
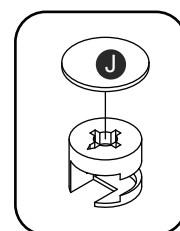
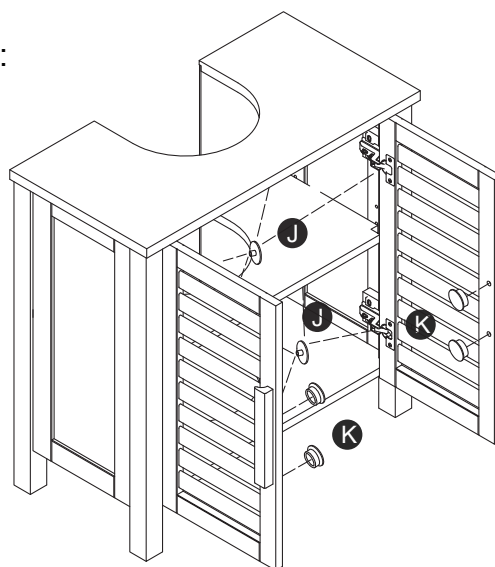
