

Safety and Care Advice

Important - Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

- Check you have all the components and tools listed on pages 2 and 3.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.
- Do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.

- This product has been produced from natural timber; you may notice some variation in the grain and colour of different component parts which is normal for furniture produced using natural wood and is not the result of any manufacturing fault.
- The product has been treated with a wax and oil finish to prevent dirt ingress and preserve moisture.
- On unpacking the furniture you may notice an odour due to this treatment; this will disappear once the furniture is unpacked and assembled after a period of time.
- This process may leave some staining on the packaging material; please take care to ensure this does not transfer to clothing or carpeted surfaces during assembly.



 We do not recommend the use of power drill/drivers for inserting screws,

as this could damage the unit. Only use hand screwdrivers.

- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.
- Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.

Care and maintenance


- Use an appropriate furniture polish for natural wood furniture and a dry cloth to clean the product.
- Avoid placing the furniture in direct sunlight as this will cause the timber to prematurely age.
- From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit.
- This product should not be discarded with household waste. Take to your local authority waste disposal centre.

Tools required



Ruler - Use this ruler to help correctly identify the screws

Step 1

Fixing right front frame to the right side panel (Two people required for an easier assembly).

a: Insert right side panel9 into right front frame18 through joints.

Note:
Before fixing blocks 25 into place it is important to ensure that the slot and groove of parts 9 and 18 are fully pushed together and lined up correctly at the top and bottom.

b: Place blocks 25 between the two marks as shown. First fix to the side panel using screws **D**.

C: Fix front frame through blocks 25 using screws **D**.

Step 2


Fixing left front frame to the left side panel (Two people required for an easier assembly).

a: Insert left side panel 10 into left front frame 19 through joints.

Note:
Before fixing blocks 25 into place it is important to ensure that the slot and groove of parts 10 and 19 are fully pushed together and lined up correctly at the top and bottom.

b: Place blocks 25 between the two marks as shown. First fix to the side panel using screws **D**.

C: Fix front frame through blocks 25 using screws **D**.



Step 3

Fitting Metal dowels.

Screw metal dowels **(H)** into right side panel **(9)**, left side panel **(10)** and top panel **(1)**.




Note: Insert metal dowels as far as shown.

Do not over tighten.

Step 4


Insert dowels **A** into the indicated parts.



Step 5

Fixing drawer runners.

Fit drawer runners 24
to the right side panel 9
and middle right panel
11 then fix them using
screws 3 as shown.




Step 6

Fixing shelf.

With help, fit middle right panel 11 and middle left panel 12 to the shelf 13 then fix it using screws **①**.

Make sure round edge on shelf 13 must face down.



Step 7

Fixing middle panels.

With help, fit middle panels to the base panel 2 then fix them using screws **3**.

Make sure round edge on base panel 2 must face down.


Step 8

Assembling parts.

Put parts 5, 6, 20, 21, 22 and 23 together as shown in the diagram.

Step 9

Insert the assembled frame into the holes on left side panel 10.



Step **10**


Fixing base panel.

With help, fit base panel 2 to the left side panel.

Insert 2 locking nuts
into base panel where shown.

Use a screwdriver to turn locking nuts clockwise to lock.

Do not over tighten.



Step **11**


Fixing right side panel.

With help, place right side panel 9 properly ensuring dowels and front frames are all fit into their holes at the same time.

Insert 2 locking nuts
into base panel where shown.

Use a screwdriver to turn locking nuts ① clockwise to lock.

Do not over tighten.



Step **12**

Fixing top panel.

Important: With help, carefully

stand the product upright.

With help, fit top panel 1 to the cabinet.

into side panels and middle panels where shown.

Use a screwdriver to turn locking nuts clockwise to lock.

Do not over tighten.

Fix metal brackets o in the middle panels and middle frames using screws B as shown.

Step 13


Important: With help, carefully lay down the product.


a: Fix side plinths 14 to the side panels using screws C.

Note: Make sure side plinths are aligned to the bottom and front edges of the side panels.

b: Fix front plinth 4 to the front frames 18 and 19 using screws C.


Note: Make sure front plinth 4 is aligned to the bottom edge of the side panels and in line to the side plinths.





Step **14**

Fix block 25 to the front plinth and bottom front frame using screws **D**.




Step **15**

Fitting hinges to door.

Attach hinges in the pre marked holes on door using screws as shown.

Attach handle **1** to the door using bolt **G** as shown.



Step **16**

Fixing door.

Important:
With help, carefully stand the product upright.

With help centralise the door in the opening of the cabinet then fix the hinges using screws **B** as shown.

Note: Hinges allow some adjustment after doors are fixed. Loosen screws and move doors to suit. Re-tighten screws.

Step 17


Fitting door lock.

a: Screw clip M in place using screws B.
Ensure that the 2 small wheels are flush with the edge of the base as shown in the diagram.

b: Insert plug **\mathbb{0}** into clip **\mathbb{M}**, ensuring they are leveled as shown in the diagram.

C: Push the door against the plug **N**. This will make 2 small marks on the door as shown in the diagram.

d: The door can then be opened and plug **Q** can be screwed into place using the 2 marks made as a guide. This will ensure that the 2 parts of the door clips are lined up correctly.



Step **18**

Drawer assembly.

a: Attach drawer sides 16 to the drawer front

15 using screws **C**.

b: Slide drawer bottom

8 into slots on drawer sides and position drawer back 17 in place.


C: Holding the drawer back 17, press the drawer sides and fix them using screws **O**.

d: Using bolts **attach** drawer handle **to** drawer front.

Repeat step 18 for the other drawer.

Step **19**

Insert drawers into unit. With the back of the drawers past the front frames, use a hammer to tap dowels (A) in flush to drawer sides. This is a safety catch to stop drawer falling out.






Step **20**


Fixing back panel.

Important:
Cabinet MUST be 'square' when back panel are attached.

Attach back panel 3 using nails **P**.
