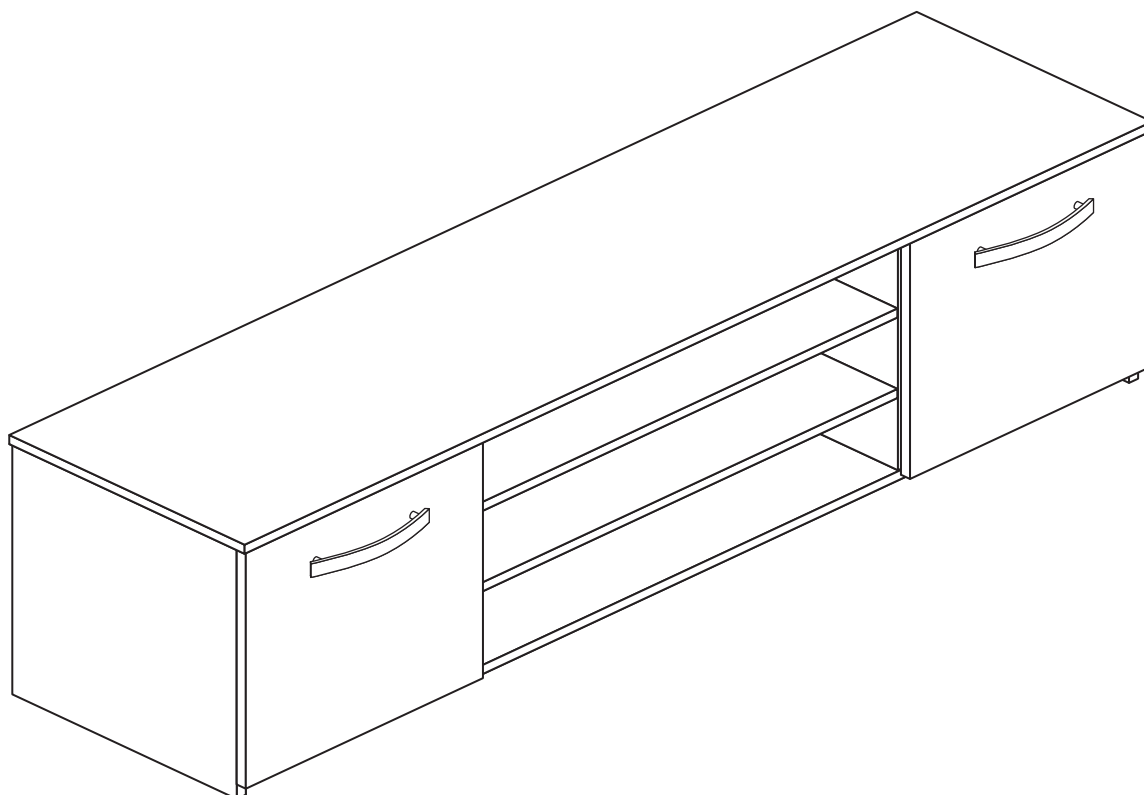

Safety and Care Advice

Important - Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

- **Warning:** This unit weighs approximately 32kgs. Please lift with care.
 - Check you have all the components and tools listed on pages 2 and 3.
 - Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
 - Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
 - Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.
 - Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.
 - Do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.
 - Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
 - Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor (use opened out unit carton).
-
- We do not recommend the use of power drill/drivers **for inserting screws**, as this could damage the unit. Only use hand screwdrivers.
 - **Safety note:** If there is any chance of this unit being pulled over by children etc. it is recommended that the unit is secured to a wall using suitable fixings (not supplied).
 - Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.

Care and maintenance

- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do not use bleach or abrasive cleaners.
- From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit.
- This product should not be discarded with household waste. Take to your local authority waste disposal centre.

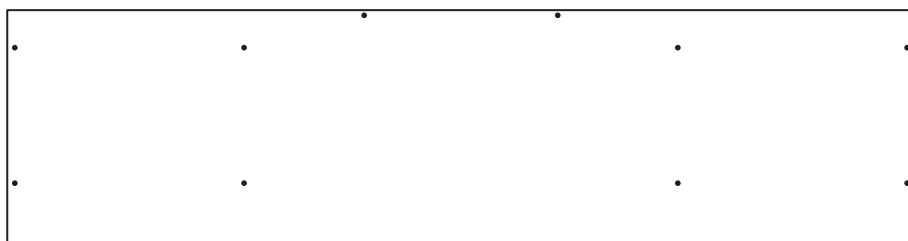
2 Right Side (DF3076)

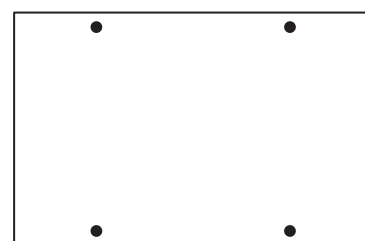

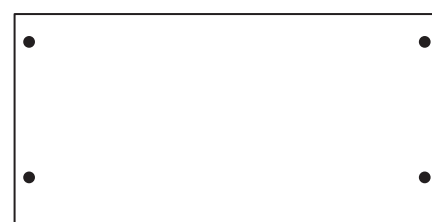

Assembly Instructions

Step 1

Prepare the left divider

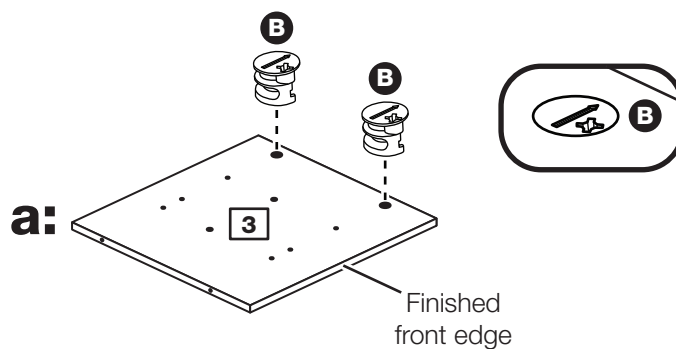
a: Insert 2 large locking nuts **B** into the left divider **3**.

Note: The arrow on the locking nut **must** point towards the hole in the edge of the panel.

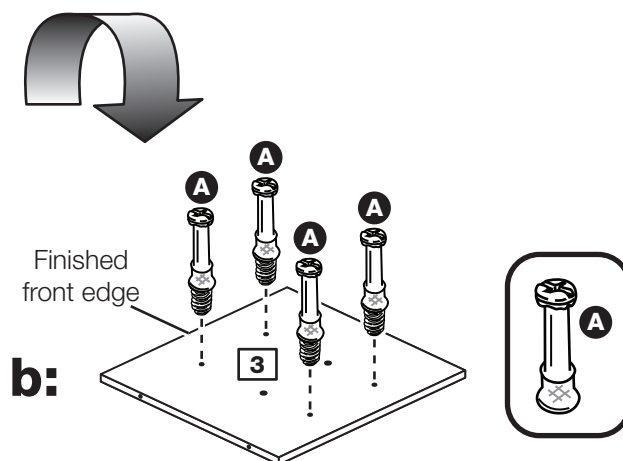
Turn the left divider over

b: Screw 4 metal dowels **A** into the left divider **3**.

Note: Tighten the metal dowels up fully against the panels.

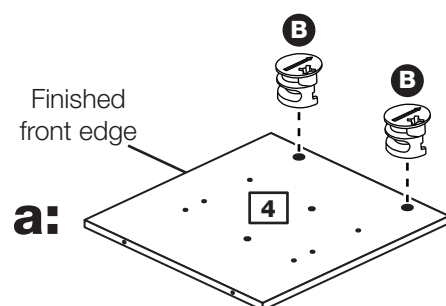
Step 2

Prepare the right divider

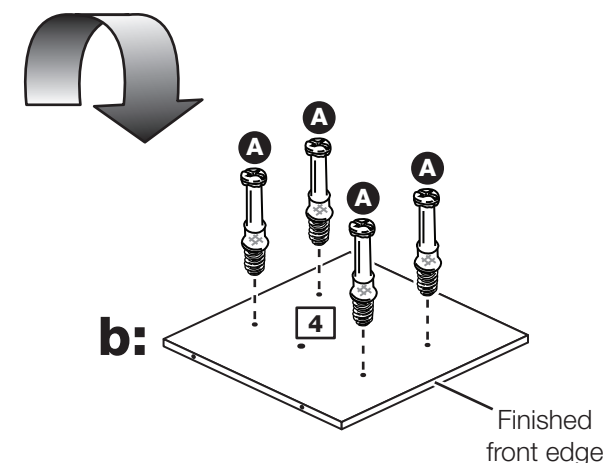
a: Insert 2 large locking nuts **B** into the right divider **4**.

Turn the right divider over

b: Screw 4 metal dowels **A** into the right divider **4**.

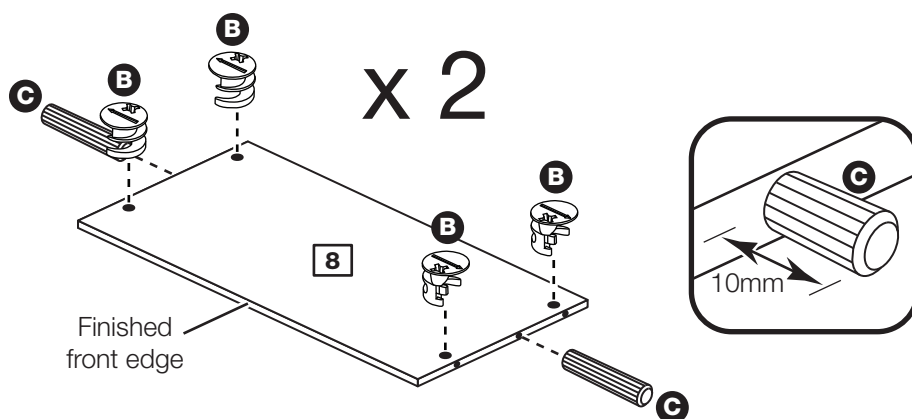
Step 3

Prepare the 2 fixed shelves

Insert 4 large locking nuts **B** into each of the 2 fixed shelves **8**.

Tap 2 wooden dowels **C** into each of the 2 fixed shelves **8**.

Note: Wooden dowels **must not** stick out from the edge by more than 10mm or they may damage other panels.



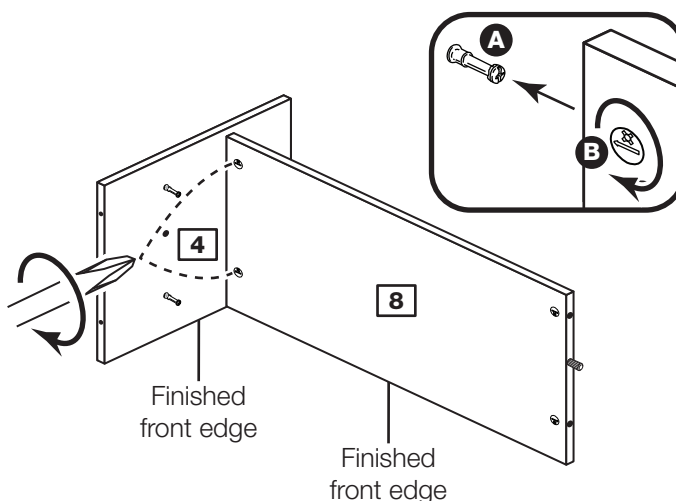
Step 4

Fit a fixed shelf to the right divider

Push a fixed shelf **8** onto the right divider **4**.

Use a screwdriver to tighten the 2 large locking nuts **B** fitted to the fixed shelf **8**.

Note: Turn the large locking nuts **B** as far as they will go - more than 1/2 a turn.

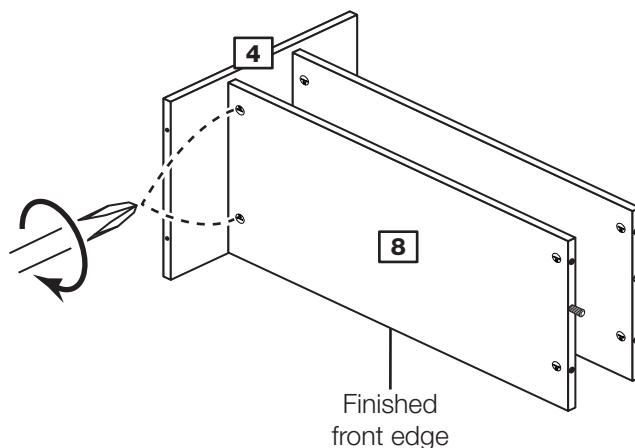


Step 5

Fit the other fixed shelf

Push the fixed shelf **8** onto the right divider **4**.

Use a screwdriver to tighten the 2 large locking nuts **B** fitted to the fixed shelf **8**.



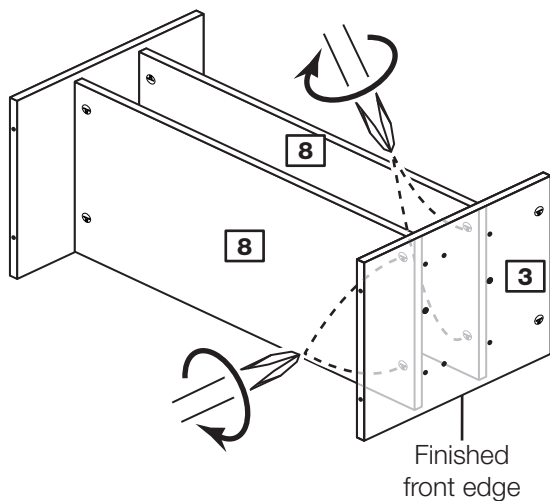

Step 6

Fit the left divider

Push the left divider **3** onto the fixed shelves **8**.

Use a screwdriver to tighten the 2 large locking nuts **B** fitted to each fixed shelf **8**.



Step 7

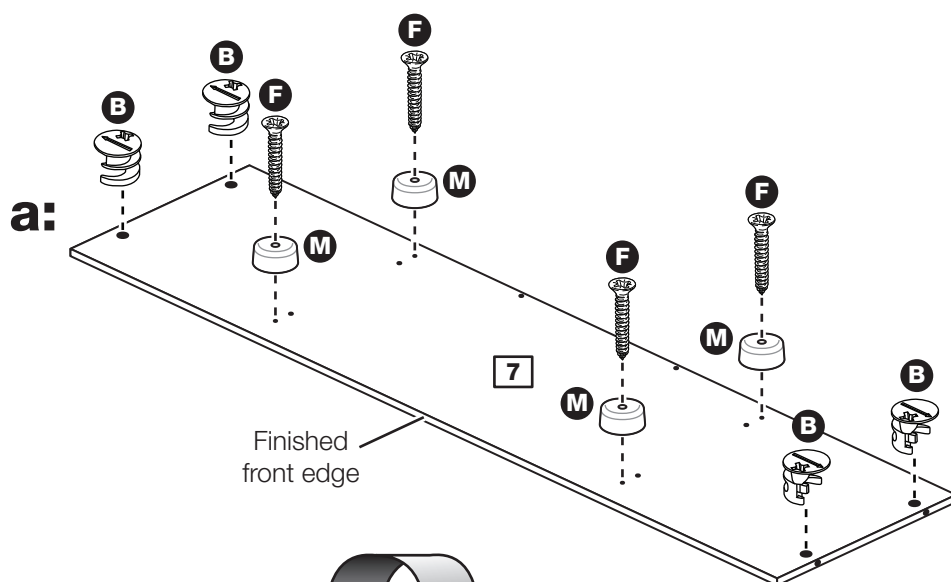
Prepare the base

a: Insert 4 large locking nuts **B** into the base **7**.

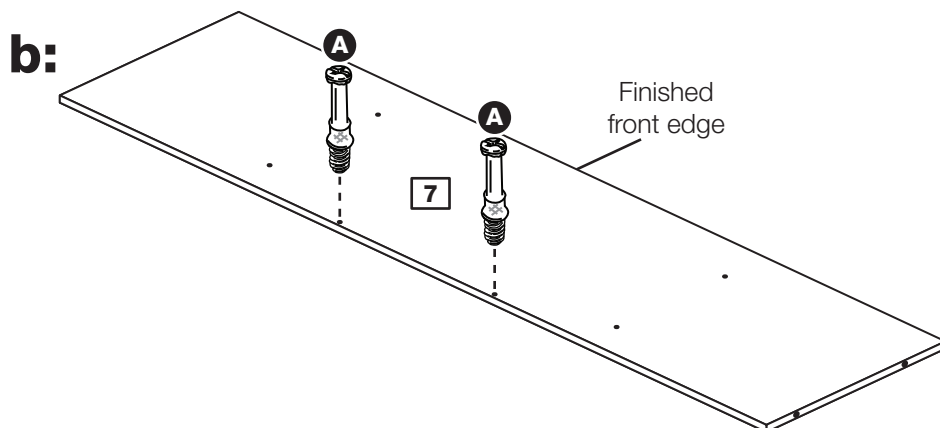
Screw the 4 feet **M** into the mark holes in the base **7** using screws **F**.

b: Screw 2 metal dowels **A** into the base **7**.

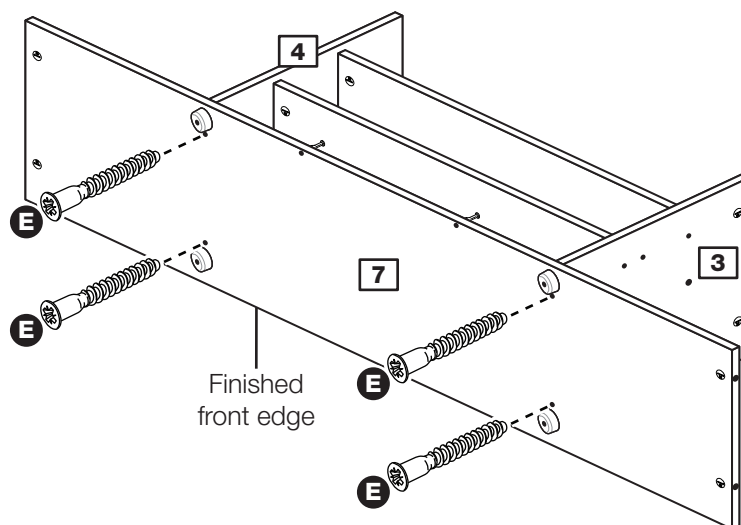

Step 8

Fit the base

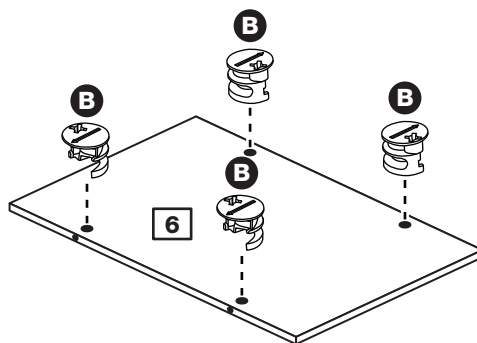
Attach the base **7** to the dividers **3** and **4** using 4 screws **E**.



Step 9

Prepare the back support

Insert 4 large locking nuts **B** into the back support **6**.

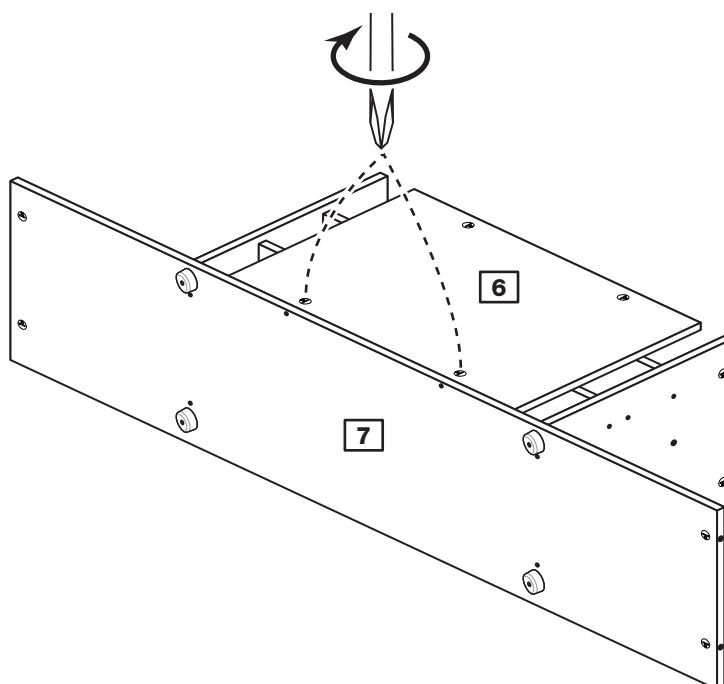


Step 10

Fit the back support

Push the back support **6** onto the base **7**.

Use a screwdriver to tighten the 2 large locking nuts **B** fitted to the back support **6**.

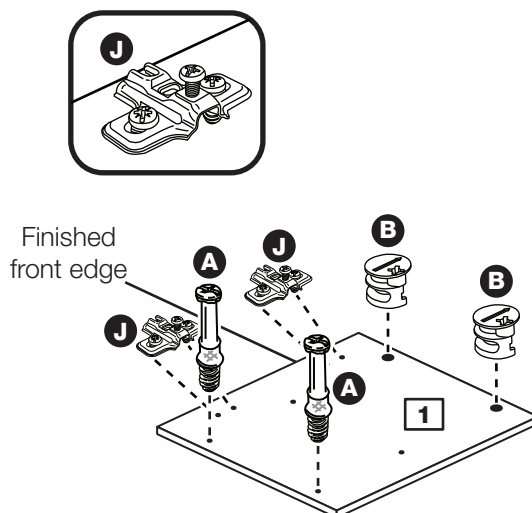
Step 11

Prepare the left side

Screw 2 metal dowels **A** into the left side **1**.

Insert 2 large locking nuts **B** into the left side **1**.

Fit 2 hinge plates **J** onto the left side **1**, making sure that the slot is facing towards the finished front edge.



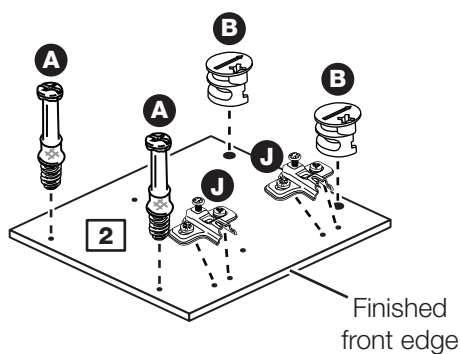
Step 12

Prepare the right side

Screw 2 metal dowels **A** into the right side **2**.

Insert 2 large locking nuts **B** into the right side **2**.

Fit 2 hinge plates **J** onto the right side **2**, making sure that the slot is facing towards the finished front edge.

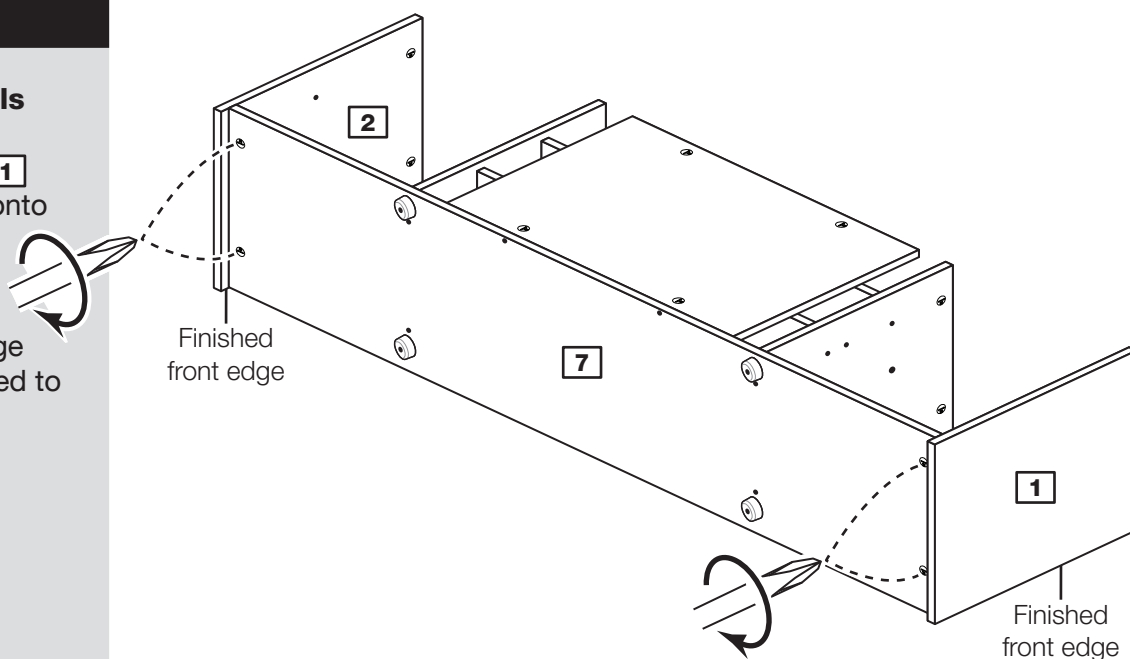


Step 13

Fit the side panels

Push the left side **1** and right side **2** onto the base **7**.

Use a screwdriver to tighten the 4 large locking nuts **B** fitted to the base **7**.

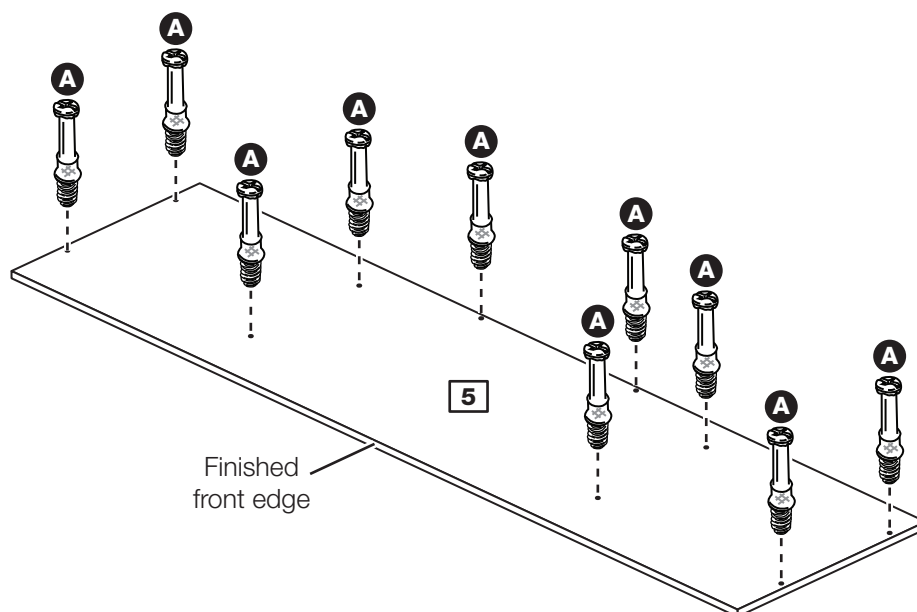

Step 14

Prepare the top

Screw 10 metal dowels **A** into the top **5**.



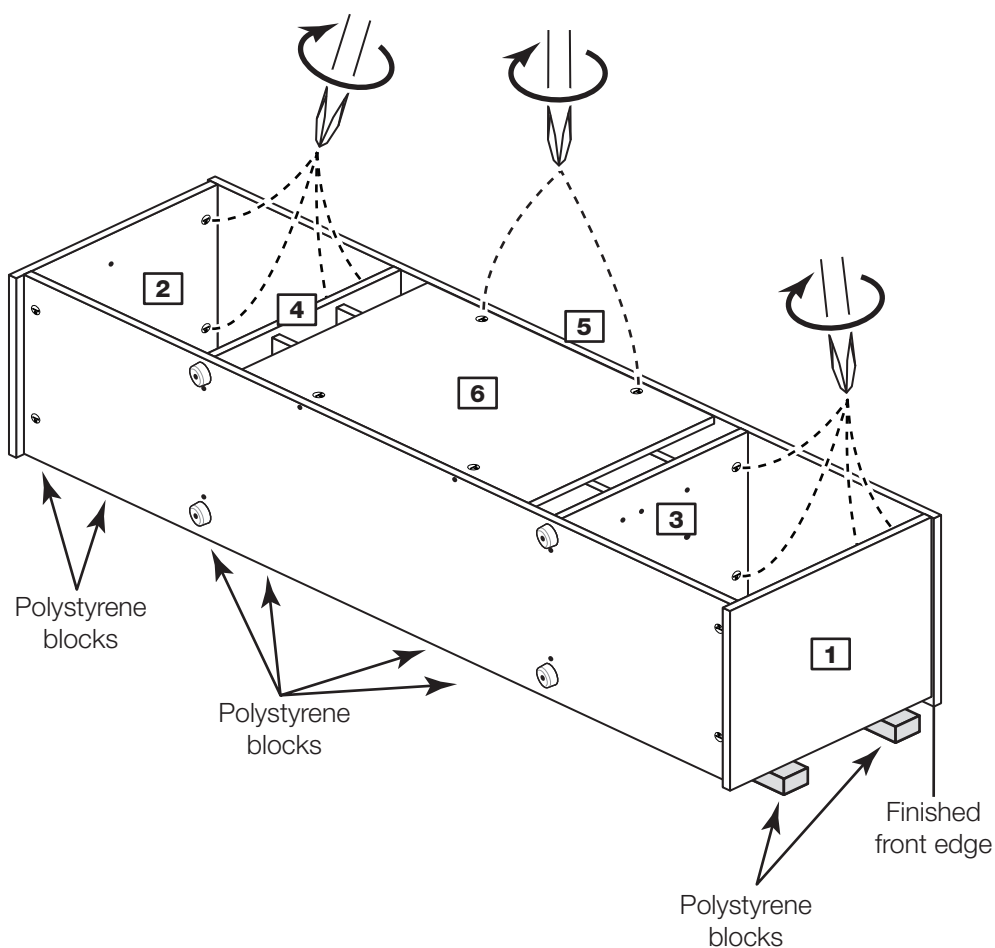
Step 15

Fit the back support

Note: To make it easier to fit the top, place polystyrene blocks from the packaging underneath the side and divider panels to raise the assembly.

Push the top **5** onto the assembly.

Use a screwdriver to tighten the 10 large locking nuts **B** fitted to the left side **1**, right side **2**, left divider **3**, right divider **4** and the back support **6**.



Step 16

Fit the back

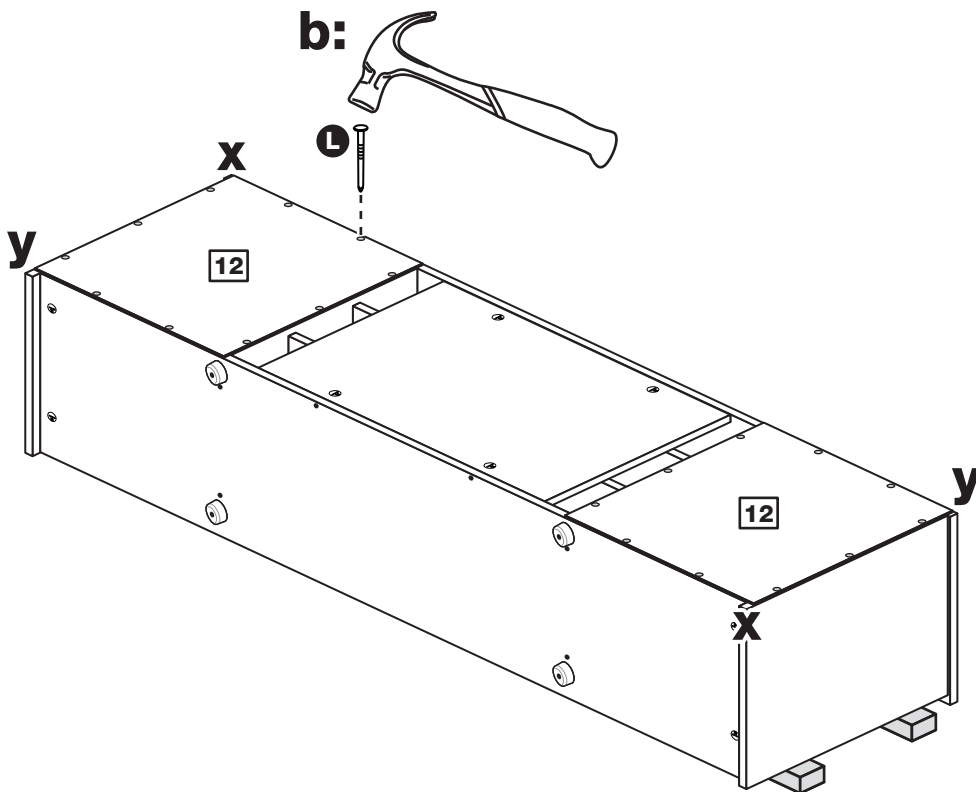
a: Square up the unit by making sure that measurement **x to x** equals **y to y**.

b: Place the 2 backs **12** onto the unit.

Nail **L** around the outside edges of the 2 backs **12**.

Note: Nails should be spaced about 150mm apart.

a: The measurement from top corner X to bottom corner X must be equal to the measurement from top corner Y to bottom corner Y



Step 17

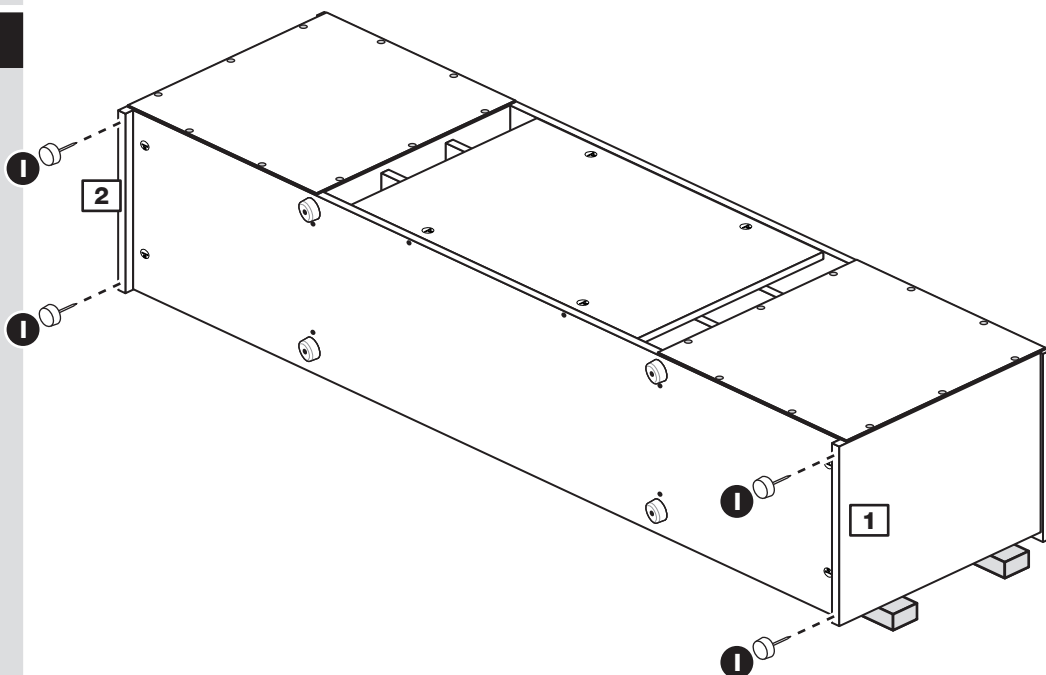
Fit the 4 plastic nails

Tap 2 plastic nails **1** into the bottom edge of each of the sides **1** and **2**.

Stand the unit up for the next step.



Warning: The unit is heavy. Lift with care.

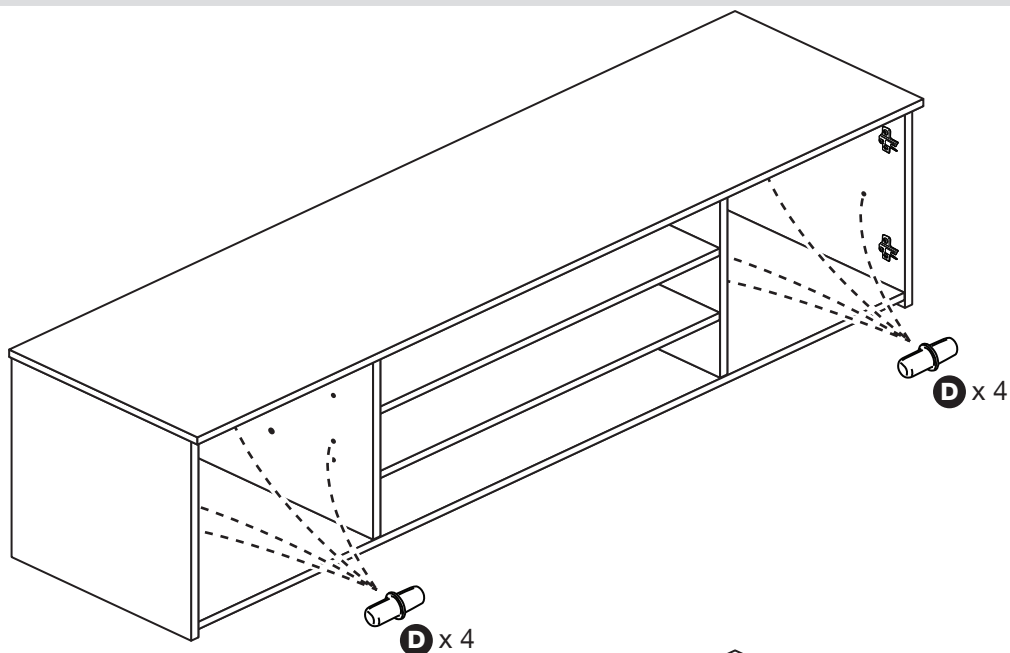

Step 18

Fit the shelf studs

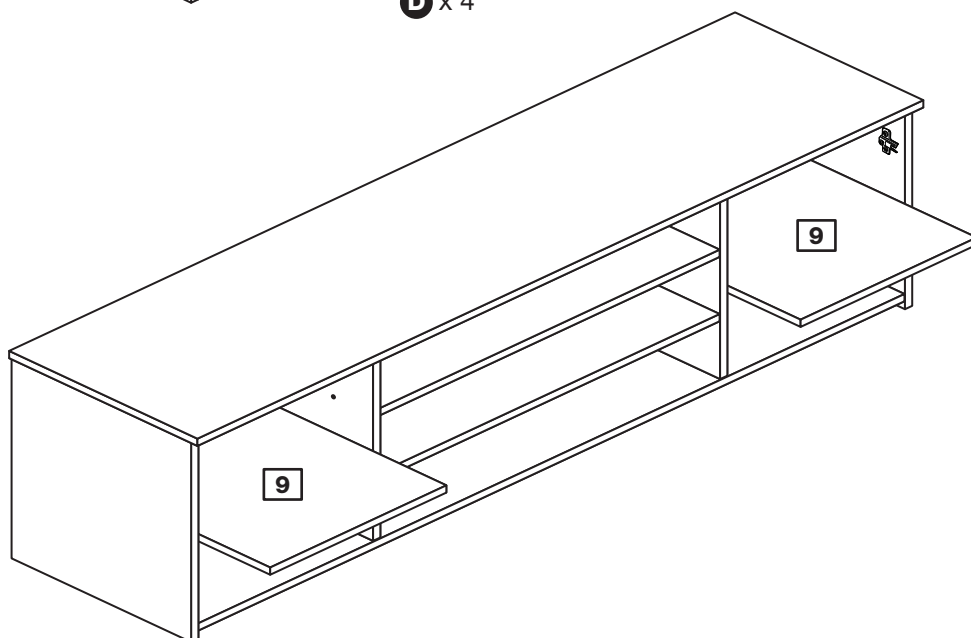
For each of the 2 loose shelves **9**, insert 4 shelf studs **D**.



Step 19

Fit the 2 loose shelves

Lower the 2 loose shelves **9** down onto the shelf studs **D**.



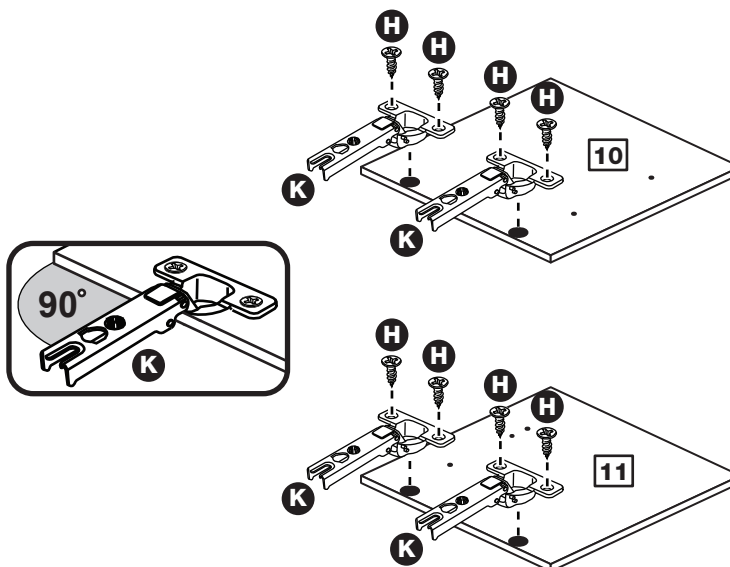
Step 20

Prepare the 2 doors

Push fit 2 hinges **K** into each of the doors **10** and **11**.

Secure each hinge with 2 screws **H**.

Note: Before securing with the screws, make sure that the hinges are positioned at 90 degrees with the edge of the door.

Step 21

Fit doors and handles

Note: The easiest way to attach each door **10** and **11** is to fit the top hinge first, then align and fit the other hinges.

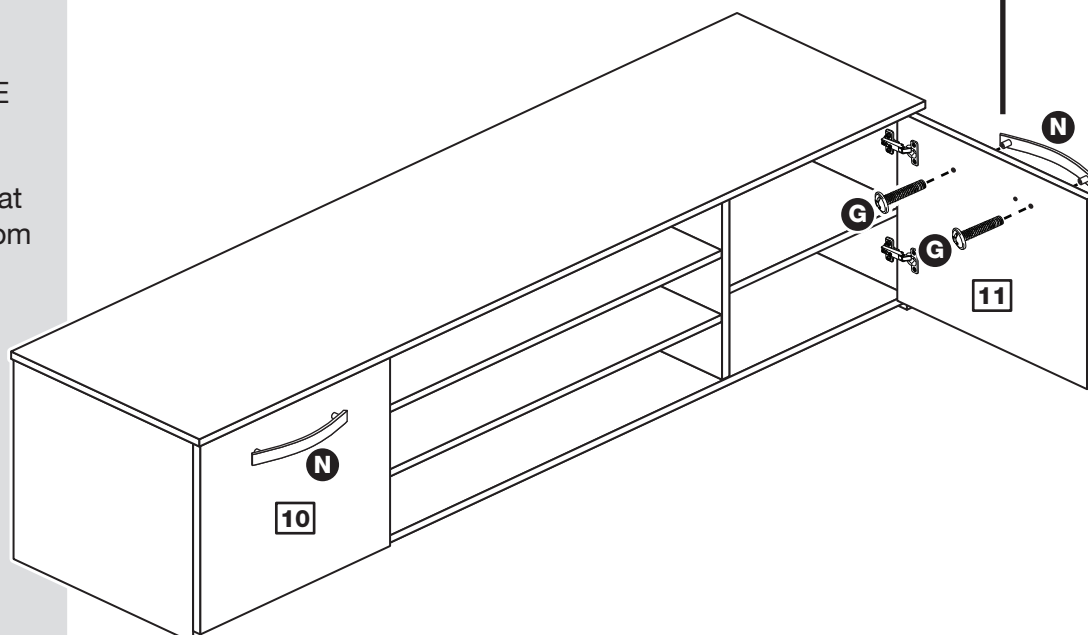
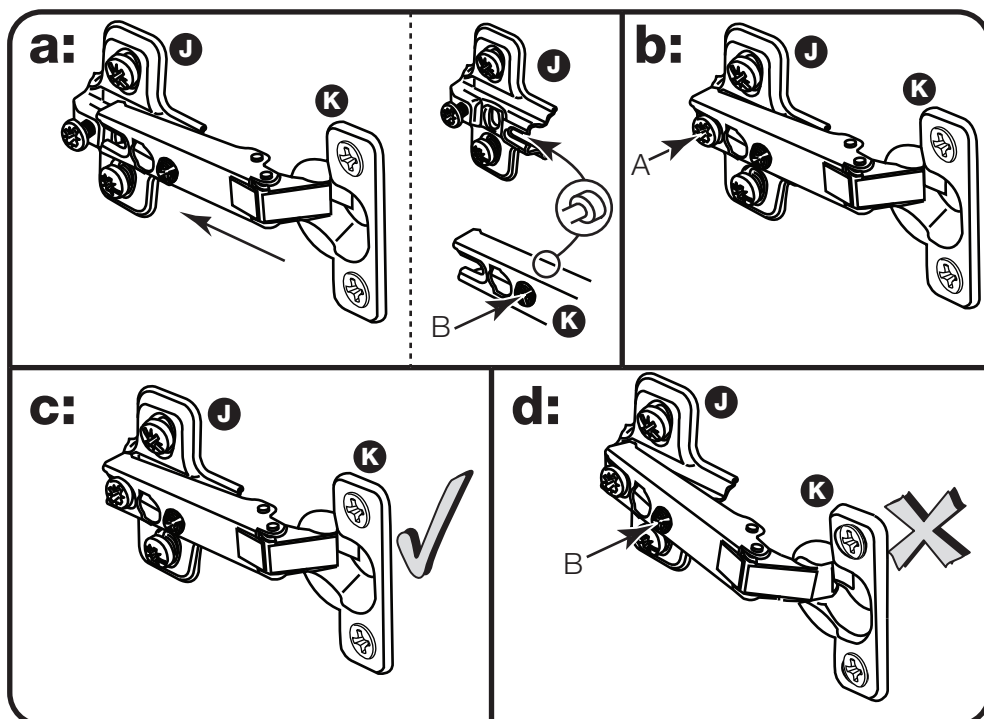
a: Push the hinge **K** onto the front part of the hinge plate **J**.
The recess at the bottom of screw B goes into the slot in the hinge plate.

b: Keep the hinge **K** FLAT against the hinge plate **J** as you slide it across as far as it will go. Tighten screw A.

c: The hinge **K** must be flat against the hinge plate **J** prior to any adjustment.

d: The hinge **K** must NOT be AT AN ANGLE to the hinge plate **J** when assembled. This would indicate that the recess at the bottom of screw B had not located in the slot in the hinge plate and the hinge would not be secure. Remove the hinge from the hinge plate and then re-assemble being careful to follow instructions a-c.

e: Attach a handle **N** to each door **10** and **11** using screws **G**.



Assembly Instructions

Step 22

Adjust the doors if needed

a: Before adjusting the doors, use a spirit level to check the base (or top) of the unit is level, front-to-back and side-to-side in the 3 positions shown. Use suitable packing pieces (not supplied) to make the unit level BEFORE making any adjustment to the hinges, as shown.

b: Height adjustment.

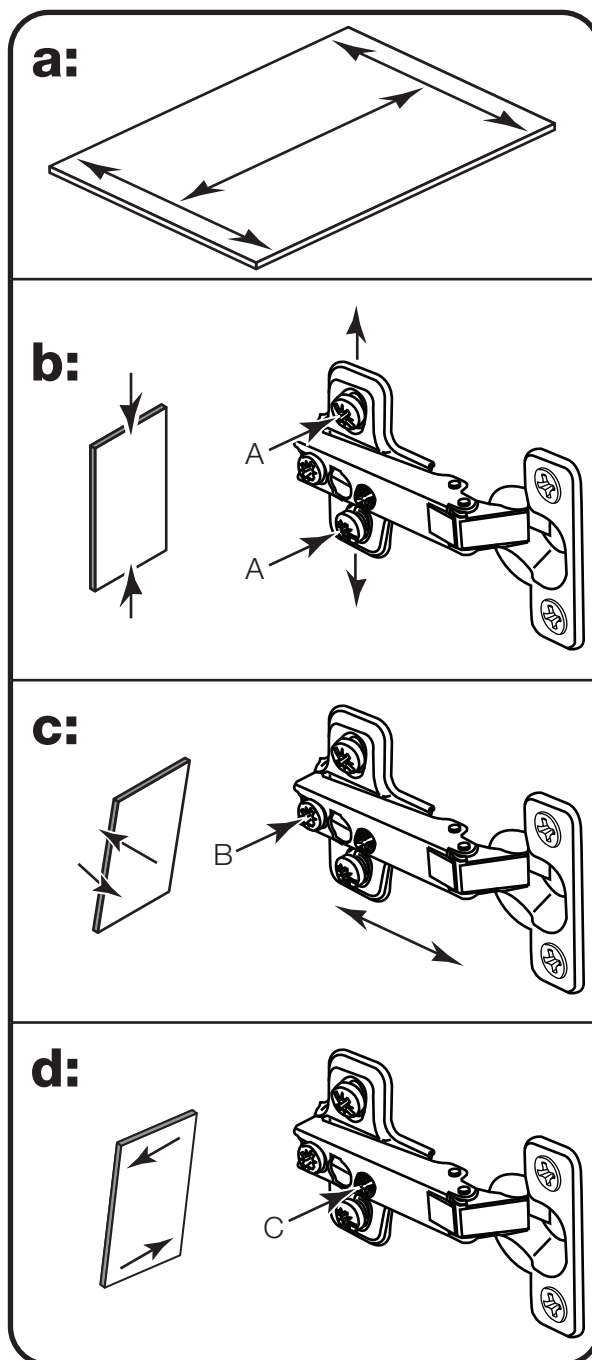
Loosen screws A on hinge plates and move door up or down as required. Retighten screw A.

c: Forward and Back adjustment.

Loosen screw B on hinge plate and move door in or out as required. Retighten screw B.

d: Sideways adjustment.

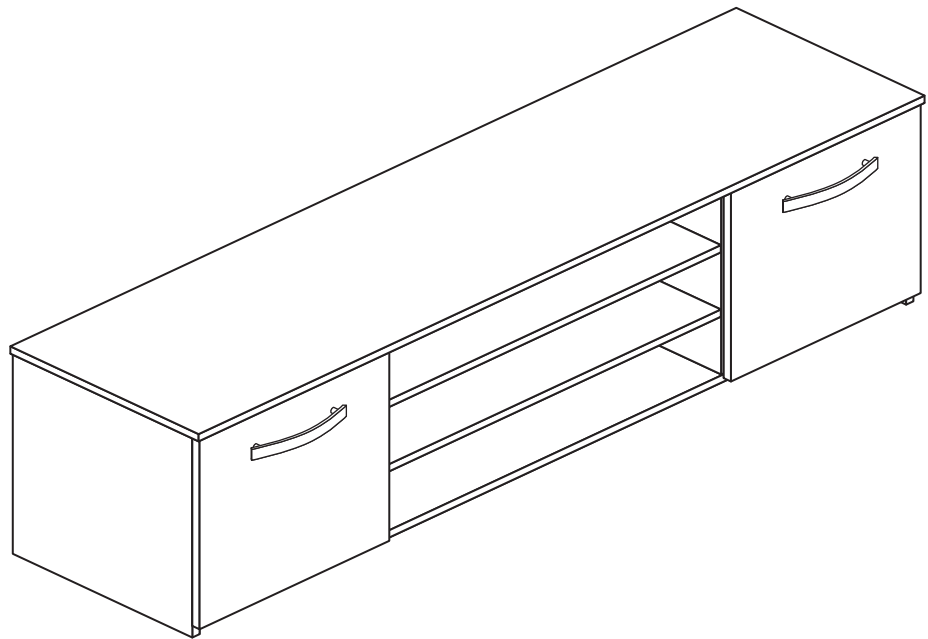
To move door 'out' loosen screw C. To move door 'in' tighten screw C.
