

Safety and Care Advice

Important - Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

- Check you have all the components and tools listed on the following pages.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.

- During assembly do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.
- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.



• To reduce the likelihood of damaging your product please ensure that your

power drill is set on a low torque setting.

Glue safety - Take care when using glue, please follow the advice below

Skin contact: Remove contamination by washing with soap and water. This procedure should also be followed prior to eating and drinking.

Eye contact: Rinse immediately with clean water for 15 minutes and seek medical advice.

If swallowed: Seek medical advice immediately.

Care and maintenance

- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do no use bleach or abrasive cleaners.
- From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit.
- This product should not be discarded with household waste.
 Take to your local authority waste disposal centre.

Handy Hints

- Assemble all parts and bolts loosely during assembly, only once the product is complete should you fully tighten the bolts
- Regularly check and ensure that all bolts and fittings are tightend properly.



1 Top panel (91.6 x 36.8cm)




2 Bottom panel (91.6 x 36.8cm)




Middle right panel (36.7 x 38.6cm)




5 Right side panel (14.7 x 38.6cm)







The screws length is measured from the head to the point (30mm screw shown).

Step 1


Fitting dowels

a: Insert Dowels (A) into the Middle right panel (3) and Middle left panel (4).

b: Insert Dowels (A) into the Right shelf (7) and Left shelf (8).




Attaching left and right shelves

a: Use Screws **3** to fix Middle left panel **4** onto the Left shelf **8**.

b: Use Screws **3** to fix Middle right panel **3** onto the Right shelf **7**.




Attaching middle shelves

a: Use Screws **3** to fix Middle shelves **9** onto the unit.

b: Use Screws 3 to fix Middle right panel 3 onto the unit.




Attaching side panels

a: Position Left side panel 6 onto the unit.


b: Position Right side panel 5 onto the unit.

Attaching bottom panel

Use Screws **B** to fix Feet **C** onto the unit.




Step 6

Inserting back panels

a: Place a small amount of Glue into the grooves of Middle right panel and Middle left panel 4.



b: Carefully slide Back panels 10 into the grooves.

Step 7


Attaching top panel

a: Screw Locking pins **b** into the Top panel **1**.

Note: Insert locking pins as far as shown.

Do not over tighten.



Step 7 - continued

b: Position Top panel 1 onto the unit.

Insert 6 Locking nuts (a) into the unit.

Use a screwdriver to turn Locking nuts **(F)** clockwise to lock.



Step 8


Fixing back panels

Attach Back panels 10 onto the unit using Nails **3**.



Important:

The unit **MUST** be 'square' when back is attached.




Step 9

Finishing the unit

Note: It would be useful to ask someone to help you at the stage.

With help, place the unit in the intended position.

Note: Before use allow the glue to dry for 24 hours and make sure the unit is secure.
