

Safety and Care Advice

Important – Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

- Check you have all the components and tools listed on the following pages.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.

- During assembly do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.
- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.



• To reduce the likelihood of damaging your product please ensure that your

power drill is set on a low torque setting.

Care and maintenance

- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do no use bleach or abrasive cleaners.
- From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit.
- This product should not be discarded with household waste.
 Take to your local authority waste disposal centre.


Warnings

- (d) When cleaning glass panels use a damp cloth or leather with washing up liquid or soft soap if necessary, do not use washing powders or any other substance containing abrasives since these substances scratch glass.






2 Bottom panel (96.8 x 39.8cm)







Step 1


Attaching the middle shelf panel

a: Insert Dowels (A) into the Middle right panel (4) and Middle left panel (3).

Use Screws **B** to fix the Middle right panel **4** and Middle left panel **3** onto the Middle shelf panel **7**.




b: Insert Dowels (A) into Shelf panel [8].



C: Position Shelf panels

Step 2

Attaching bottom panel

Use Screws **3** to fix
Bottom panel **2** onto the
Middle right panel **4** and
Middle left panel **3**.

Step 3

Attaching right panel and left panel

a: Insert Dowels (A) and Screw Locking pins (G) into the Right panel (6) and Left panel (5).


Note: Insert Locking pins as far as shown. **Do not over tighten.**


b: Position the Right panel 6 and Left panel 5 onto the unit.

Insert 4 Locking nuts (a) into the unit.


Use a screwdriver to turn Locking nuts Colockwise to lock.

Use Screws **D** to fix Foot **G** onto the unit.










Step 4

Attaching small back panels

Slide small back panels 10 into the unit.



Step 5

Attaching top panel

a: Use Screws **(a)** to fix the Door magnet **(b)** onto the Top panel **(1)**.


Insert Hinge plugs
into the Top panel
1.

Screw Locking pins(6 pcs)

Ginto the Top panel 1.

Note: Insert Locking pins as far as shown. **Do not over tighten.**


Step 5 - continued

b: Carefully locate the Top panel 1 onto the unit.

Insert 6 Locking nuts (a) into the unit.

Use a screwdriver to turn Locking nuts clockwise to lock.

Insert Hinge plugs into the Bottom panel 2 .



Step 6


Fixing large back panel

Attach large back panel 9 using nails ①.



Important:

The unit **MUST** be 'square' when back is attached.



Step 7

Fitting the glass doors

a: Tear off the protective backing from the Foam pad (and Small foam pad (b).


b: Carefully stick the Foam pad **(C)** onto the Glass door **(11)** so that it wraps over Glass door. Locate the Door push **(O)** over the top of the Foam pad and Glass door.


Carefully stick the Small foam pads onto the Glass door 11. Then slide the Bottom hinge onto the Glass door 11, and tighten the screws to fix position.


C: Insert the Top hinges **M** into the Hinge plug **1**.

Carefully locate the Bottom hinges (*) into the Hinge plugs (*).

Carefully slide the Glass doors 11 into the Top hinges (1), ensuring they are parallel with they unit. Then tighten the screws to fix in position.








Step 8

Finishing the unit
