

# Safety and Care Advice

### Important - Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

- *Warning:* This unit weighs approximately 14kgs. Please lift with care.
- Check you have all the components and tools listed on pages 2 and 3.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.

- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.
- Do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor (use opened out unit carton).



 We do not recommend the use of power drill/drivers for inserting screws,

as this could damage the unit. Only use hand screwdrivers.

- Safety note: If there is any chance of this unit being pulled over by children etc. it is recommended that the unit is secured to a wall using suitable fixings (not supplied).
- Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.

#### Care and maintenance


- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do no use bleach or abrasive cleaners.





Right Side (D2490A) (576 x 328mm)




**3** Top (D2488A) (627 x 327mm)



### Step 1

# Prepare the drawer fronts

Screw 2 metal dowels **B** into each of the drawer fronts **5**.

**Note:** Tighten the metal dowels up fully against the panel.




### Step 2

# Prepare the drawer wraps

Insert 2 small locking nuts **©** into each of the drawer wraps **6**.


**Note:** The arrow on the locking nut **must** point towards the hole in the edge of the panel.



## Step 3

#### Fit the drawer base

Place the drawer base 7 into the narrow slot on the drawer wrap 6. Fold the wrap around the drawer base.




## Step 4

#### Fit the drawer front

Turn drawer wrap 6 assembly over and push it onto the back of the drawer front 5.

**Note:** Turn the locking nuts **©** clockwise to secure the panels - more than 1/2 a turn.




## Step 5

# Attach the drawer stops

Carefully break off 2 drawer stops (F599) from a set of drawer runners (1).

Push the drawer stops fully through the drawer wrap 6 from the inside.




### Step 6

#### **Attach the handles**

Attach 2 handles **(c)** to each of the 3 drawer fronts **(5)** using 2 screws **(E)**.

Note: Do not overtighten the screws.



## Step 7


### Prepare the left side

Separate the runners **H**.

Push fit the 3 left runners

• marked 'L' into the left side 1.

**Note:** Runners must be be fitted flat against the panel. If necessary gently tap into final position.




### Step 8

#### Prepare the right side

Push fit the 3 right runners marked 'R' into the right side 2.

**Note:** Runners must be be fitted flat against the panel. If necessary gently tap into final position.




### Step 9

### **Prepare the top**

Tap 2 wooden dowels **A** into the top **3**.


**Note:** Wooden dowels must not stick out from the edge by more than 10mm or they may damage other panels.



## Step 10

# Join the top to the right side


Push the top 3 onto the right side 2 and secure with 2 screws **D**.



## Step 11

#### **Prepare the plinth**


Tap 2 wooden dowels (A) into the plinth (4).



## Step 12

# Join the plinth to the right side


Push the plinth 4 onto the right side 2 and secure with screw **D**.



## Step 13

#### Fit the left side

Push the left side 1 onto the assembly and secure with 3 screws **1**.



## Step 14

#### Fit the back

**a:** Square up the unit by making sure that measurement **x** to **x** equals **y** to **y**.


**b:** Place the back 8 onto the unit.

Nail **f** around the 3 edges of the back **8** as shown.

**Note:** Nails should be spaced about 150mm apart.

Stand the unit up for the next step.

The measurement from top corner X to bottom corner X must be equal to the measurement from top corner Y to bottom corner Y




## Step 15

#### **Insert the drawers**

Lift the front of the drawers whilst inserting to overcome the 'stop' system.

**Note:** To ensure that your drawers run smoothly, spray a small amount of furniture polish into the grooves.
