

## Safety and Care Advice

### Important - Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

- Warning: This unit weighs approximately 25kgs.
   Please lift with care.
- Check you have all the components and tools listed on pages 2 and 3.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.

- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.
- Do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor (use opened out unit carton).



 We do not recommend the use of power drill/drivers for inserting screws,

as this could damage the unit. Only use hand screwdrivers.

- Safety note: If there is any chance of this unit being pulled over by children etc. it is recommended that the unit is secured to a wall using suitable fixings (not supplied).
- Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.

#### Care and maintenance


- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do no use bleach or abrasive cleaners.

### Step 1

#### **Prepare the drawer** front

Screw 2 metal dowels A into the drawer front 9.

**Note:** Tighten the metal dowels up fully against the panels.





#### Step 2


#### **Prepare the drawer** sides

Insert a small locking nut **B** into the hole shown on the left drawer side 10 and the right drawer side 11.

Note: The arrow on the locking nut must point towards the hole in the edge of the panel.








### Step 3


#### Attach the drawer sides to the drawer front

Push the left drawer side 10 and right drawer side 11 onto the back of the drawer front 9.

Turn the small locking nuts **B** on the left drawer side 10 and right drawer side 11.

Note: Turn the locking nuts B clockwise to secure panels - more than 1/2 a turn.






### Step 4

#### Fit the drawer base

Slide the drawer base 13 down the grooves in the drawer sides 10 and 11 and down into the groove in the drawer front 9.




### Step 5

#### Fit the drawer back

Fit the drawer back 12 between the drawer sides 10 and 11. Make sure that the drawer base 13 fits into the groove in the drawer back 12.


Hold the drawer back 12 in position and tap the knock-in pegs (2) through the holes in the drawer sides 10 and 11.



### Step 6

#### Fit the wedgefixes

Turn the drawer assembly over and slide 2 wedgefixes into the front and back grooves, as shown, and tighten up the screws.






### Step 7

## Fit runners to the drawers

Fit the runner **Oc** to the bottom edge of the left drawer side **10**, as shown, making sure that it is pushed up against the back of the drawer front **9**. Use a bradawl to mark the fixing positions, then secure with 2 screws **1**.


Fit the runner **Od** to the bottom edge of the right drawer side **11** using the same method.



### Step 8

#### **Prepare the top**

Screw 8 metal dowels **A** into the top **4**.



### Step 9

#### **Prepare the right end**


Insert 2 large locking nuts **©** into the right end **2**.

**Note:** The arrow on the locking nuts **must** point towards the hole in the edge of the panel.

Tap 2 wooden dowels **D** into the right end **2**.

**Note:** Wooden dowels must not stick out from the edge by more than 10mm or they may damage other panels.

Push 2 shelf studs (s) into the right end 2 and tighten the screws up.




### Step 10

## Fit the right end to the top

Push the right end 2 onto the top 4.

Use a screwdriver to tighten the 2 large locking nuts • fitted to the right end • .


**Note:** Turn the large locking nuts **(C)** as far as they will go - more than 1/2 a turn.



## Step 11

#### **Prepare the right back**

Insert 2 large locking nuts **©** into the right back **8**].




### Step 12

## Fit the right back to the top

Push the right back 8 onto the top 4.


Use a screwdriver to tighten the 2 large locking nuts • fitted to the right back 8.



### Step 13

#### **Prepare the left back**

Insert 4 large locking nuts **©** into the left back **7**.



### Step 14

#### **Prepare the divider**

**a:** Fit a runner **Ob** to the divider **3**.

The 1st screw **H** uses the 1st hole in from the front of the runner.

The 2nd and 3rd screws

use the holes that line
up with the other panel
holes.

**b:** Fit a screw **1** into the 2nd hole in at the top of the runner **2 b**.


**C:** Screw 2 metal dowels **A** into the divider **3**.

Insert 2 large locking nuts (a) into the divider (3).

Tap 2 wooden dowels **D** into the divider **3**.

#### Turn the divider over

**d:** Push 2 shelf studs into the divider 3 and tighten the screws up.




### Step 15

## Fit the left back to the divider

Push the left back 7 onto the divider 3.

Use a screwdriver to tighten the 2 large locking nuts • fitted to the divider 3.



### Step 16

#### Prepare the left end

**a:** Fit a runner **O**a to the left end **1**.

The 1st screw **H** uses the 1st hole in from the front of the runner.


The 2nd and 3rd screws use the holes that line up with the other panel holes.


**b:** Fit a screw **1** into the 2nd hole in at the top of the runner **2 a**.

Screw 2 metal dowels (A) into the left end 1.

**C:** Insert 2 large locking nuts **©** into the left end **1**.

Tap 2 wooden dowels **D** into the left end **1**.






### Step 17

## Fit the left end to the left back

Push the left end 1 onto the left back 7.

Use a screwdriver to tighten the 2 large locking nuts • fitted to the left back 7.




### Step 18

## Fit the left end and divider to the top

Push the left end 1 and divider 3 onto the top 4.


Use a screwdriver to tighten the 4 large locking nuts **©** fitted to the left end **1** and divider **3**.



## Step 19

#### Fit the base

Attach the base 6 to the assembly using screws 6 and tighten them using the allen key N.




### Step 20

## Fit the leg brackets to the base

Screw each leg bracket to the base 6 using 2 screws 6 into the mark holes.

Then use another 2 screws **G** into the other 2 holes.



## Step 21


#### Fit the legs

Screw the legs **M** into the leg brackets **L**.

Carefully stand the unit up for the next step.




**Warning:** The unit is heavy. Lift with care.



### Step 22

#### Fit the shelf


Insert the shelf 5 and push it down onto the shelf studs **(K**).



### Step 23


#### Fit the drawer

Slide the wheels of the runners fitted to the drawer, over the wheels of the runners fitted to the left side and divider, and push the drawer into position.



### Step 24

#### **Assembly is complete**
