Important safety instructions

- ▶ Read the instruction manual carefully and completely before using the product.

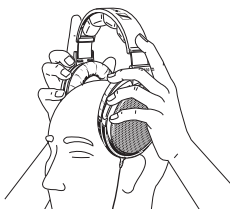

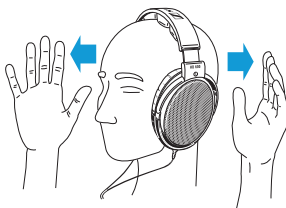

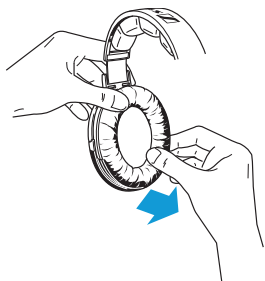

- ▶ Put on the headphones and adjust the headband.

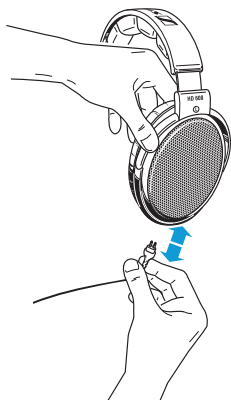


- ▶ Do not cover the transducers!
