Solid Wood/ Real wood veneers

• This product has been finished using natural materials. As a living material, you may notice some variation in the grain and colour shade between the different components.

• Unlike a synthetic or man-made material which has uniform finish, a feature of natural wood is its variation in grain and colour. We wish to reassure you that this is quite normal and is not the result of any manufacturing fault.

• Where sheets of wood are joined together, a line may be detected. Again, this is normal and is not an imperfection.

• The natural finish should be cared for by the periodic application of a good quality 'wax' based domestic furniture polish (Not silicone!!). Occasional / small spills should be removed immediately using a damp cloth.

• Do not allow hot articless to come into contact with the surface, as damage will occur .

Cleaning Guidance

 Minor Stains and spillages should be removed immediately from cushion fabric, by wiping over lightly with a damp cloth and mild soapy water. • Light marking can also be removed using this method.

• To remove more stubborn stain or marking, a good quality proprietary domestic fabric cleaner can be used, although it should first be tested on and inconspicuous area of the fabric.


Assembling Back Rest

Carefully align seat pad 2 onto back rest 1 and secure using fixings (A, D) and (B).








Step 3

Whilst applying a firm downward pressure to the seat, tighten all screws.






Assemble table legs

a:Fix table leg 1 and 2 by using bolt **B**, wooden dowels **f**.



b:Fix screws **G** and insert wooden dowels **()** into table legs.







Step 2

Assemble support bars

a:Attach support bars 3 and 4 to table legs, then fix with connectors 6, plain washers 0 and nuts









Important note: Do not fully tighten bolts at this stage.

Step 3

Assemble table top


Two people are needed here.

Place table top **5** upside down on a clean protected surface.

Fix the assembled unit frame onto table top using bolts (A), plain washers (D).

Step 4


Assemble cap
