

 We do not recommend the use of power drill/drivers for inserting screws,


as this could damage the unit. Only use hand screwdrivers.








1 Left Side (DF3581)




Right Side (DF3582) (171.1 x 59.2cm)

Step 1

Prepare the top and base

Place 2 plastic tracks O down onto each of the top 4 and base 4 panels, making sure that they are flush with the edges of the panel.

Gently tap along the length of the plastic tracks o until they are fitted flat to the surface of the panel.


Turn the top and the base panels over


Tap 4 wooden dowels (A) into each of the top 4 and base 4 panels.

Note: Wooden dowels must not stick out from the edge by more than 10mm or they may damage other panels.


Insert 4 large locking nuts C into each of the top 4 and base 4 panels.

Note: The arrow on the locking nut **must** point towards the hole in the edge of the panel.









Step 2


Prepare the divider

Tap 4 wooden dowels **A** into the divider **3**.

Fit a rail holder S by screwing through the top hole with screw H and into the mark hole drilled in the divider 3. Make sure that it is fitted straight, in line with the panel edges and then fit another screw H using the lower hole.

Turn the divider over


Fit another rail holder S by screwing through the top hole with screw H and into the mark hole drilled in the divider 3. Make sure that it is fitted straight, in line with the panel edges and then fit another screw H using the lower hole.



Step 3

Fit the top and base to the divider

Attach the top 4 and the base 4 to the divider 3 using 4 screws **6**.




Step 4

Prepare 1 of the shelves

Tap 2 wooden dowels **A** into the shelf **5**.

Insert 4 large locking nuts **©** into the shelf **5**.



Step 5

Fit the shelf


a: Push the shelf **5** onto the divider **3**.

Tap 2 double metal dowels **R** through the divider **3** and into the shelf **5** until they "bottom out".

Tap 2 large wooden dowels **①** through the divider **③** and into the shelf **⑤** until they "bottom out".

b: Use a screwdriver to tighten the 2 large locking nuts **©** fitted to the shelf **5**.

Note: Turn the large locking nuts **©** as far as they will go - more than 1/2 a turn.




Step 6

Prepare the left side

Screw 6 metal dowels **B** into the left side **1**.

Note: Tighten the metal dowels up fully against the panels.


Fit a rail holder S by screwing through the top hole with screw 1 and into the mark hole drilled in the left side 1. Make sure that it is fitted straight, in line with the panel edges and then fit another screw 1 using the lower hole.



Step 7

Prepare the 2 rails

Insert 4 large locking nuts **©** into each of the 2 rails **6**.




Step 8

Fit a rail

a: Tap 2 double metal dowels **R** through the divider **3** and into a rail **6** until they "bottom out".

b: Use a screwdriver to stighten the 2 large locking nuts • fitted to the rail •.

Note: Support the rail until the left side has been fitted in the next step.




Step 9

Fit the left side

a: Push the left side onto the assembly.

Tap 2 mushroom head pins **P** into the holes on the outside of the left side **1**.


b: Use a screwdriver to tighten the 8 large locking nuts **©** fitted to the top **4**, base **4**, shelf **5** and rail **6**.

Step 10

Prepare the other shelf

Tap 2 wooden dowels **A** into the shelf **5**.

Insert 4 large locking nuts **©** into the shelf **5**.




Step 11

Fit the other shelf

Push the shelf **5** onto the divider **3**.

Use a screwdriver to tighten the 2 large locking nuts • fitted to the shelf • .




Step 12

Prepare the right side

Screw 6 metal dowels **B** into the right side **2**.

Note: Tighten the metal dowels up fully against the panels.

Fit a rail holder S by screwing through the top hole with screw H and into the mark hole drilled in the right side 2. Make sure that it is fitted straight, in line with the panel edges and then fit another screw H using the lower hole.




Step 13

Fit the other rail

Push the rail 6 onto the divider 3.

Use a screwdriver to tighten the 2 large locking nuts • fitted to the rail •.

Note: Support the rail until the right side has been fitted in the next step.




Step 14


Fit the right side

a: Push the right side onto the assembly.

Tap 2 mushroom head pins **P** into the holes on the outside of the right side **2**.



b: Use a screwdriver to tighten the 8 large locking nuts **©** fitted to the top **4**, base **4**, shelf **5** and rail **6**.



Step 15


Fit back panels

a: Square up the unit by making sure that measurement **x:x equals y:y.**

Place the 2 backs 9 onto the unit, as shown.

Make sure that the 2 backs are pushed up tight against each other and that they meet in the centre of the divider's back edge.

The measurement from top corner X to bottom corner X must be equal to the measurement from top corner Y to bottom corner Y



b: Nail **•** around the outside edges of the 2 backs.


Note: Do not nail where the 2 backs meet.


C: Push the nail screws
through the back
holders (and tap them
down between the 2
backs (and into the
back edge of the divider

Keep tapping the nail screws in until the back holders dig into the 2 backs.

Note: If ever you need to take the backs off to dismantle the unit, the nail screws can be taken out using a screwdriver.






Step 18

Prepare the right hand door

Important: Check that the holes are in the same place as the diagram.

Push 2 top glides **M** into 1 of the doors **8**.

Push 2 bottom glides N into the same door 8 and secure each one with 2 screws 1.



Step 19


Prepare the left hand door

Important: Check that the holes are in the same place as the diagram.

Fit the buffer bracket onto the other door using 2 screws .

Push 2 top glides **M** into the door **8**].

Push 2 bottom glides N into the door 8 and secure each one with 2 screws 1.



Step 20

Fit the doors


a: With the top of the right hand door 8 leaning back at an angle, insert the bottom glides 1 into the rear track 0.


Push the top of the right hand door **8** in and locate the top glides **M** into the rear track **O**.


b: With the top of the left hand door 8 leaning back at an angle, insert the bottom glides 1 into the front track 0.

Push the top of the left hand door **8** in and locate the top glides **M** into the front track **O**.

Note: For more information about fitting the doors please refer to the relevent diagrams.








You may have been supplied with a top glide that differs slightly to the one shown. It may have a switch that just moves up and down and does not lock into postion.

Step 21

Adjust the doors if needed


If your doors are not running smoothly, please follow these instructions to adjust the bottom glides.

IF YOUR DOORS DO NOT RUN SMOOTHLY




Before adjusting the doors, use a spirit level to check the base (or top) of the unit is level, front-to-back and side-to-side in the 3 positions shown.


Use suitable packing pieces (not supplied) to make the unit level BEFORE making any adjustment, as shown.



To raise the door, loosen the screws and swivel the glide towards the '+' arrow. Re-tighten the screws.



To lower the door, loosen the screws and swivel the glide towards the '-' arrow. Re-tighten the screws.




Once the doors have been adjusted and are running smoothly, use 2 screws 1 to hold each of the bottom glides in position.

Step 22

Attach the handles

Attach a handle to each of the doors a using screws .



Step 23


Fit the overbalance protector

To prevent possible overbalancing we recommend that this unit is secured to a suitable wall by fitting of the overbalance protector kit to the unit, or an alternative fixing method of your choice.

Wall fixings are not supplied as they will need to suit the wall type.

Note: Take care when drilling the wall that you do not drill into any pipes, wires etc. If in doubt, consult an expert.
