IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

WARNING – TO REDUCE THE RISK OF BURNS, ELECTROCUTION, FIRE OR INJURY TO PERSONS:

- 1 This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been supervised/instructed and understand the hazards involved. Children shall not play with the appliance. Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be done by children unless they are older than 8 and supervised. Keep the appliance and cable out of reach of children under 8 years.
- 2 Don't submerge the shaver in liquid such as a bath, basin or any other vessel for extended periods.
- 3 Keep the power plug and cord away from heated surfaces.
- 4 Do not leave the appliance unattended while plugged in.
- 5 Do not use attachments other than those we supply.
- 6 Do not twist or kink the cable, or wrap it round the appliance.
- 7 Store the product at a temperature between 15°C and 35°C.
- 8 Do not use the appliance if it is damaged or malfunctions.
- 9 If the supply cord of this unit becomes damaged, discontinue use immediately and return the appliance to your nearest authorised Remington® service dealer for repair or replacement in order to avoid a hazard.

GETTING STARTED

 It is recommended that you use your new shaver daily for up to four weeks to allow time for your beard and skin to become accustomed to the new shaving system.

★ CHARGING YOUR SHAVER

- Ensure the appliance is turned off.
- · Connect the shaver to the adapter and then to the mains.
- · Charge for at least 24 hours when using for the first time.
- · When charging the blue indicator will show.
- · After the shaver is fully charged, the blue indicator light will turn off.
- · Use product until the battery is low. This is indicated by illuminated red light.
- · When empty, the battery will be fully charged within 90 minutes.
- To preserve the life of your batteries, let them run out every 6 months then recharge for 24 hours.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

★ SHAVING

- · Make sure your shaver is properly charged.
- · Switch the shaver on.
- Stretch the skin with your free hand so the hairs stand upright.
- Only apply light pressure on the shaving head while shaving (pressing too hard can damage the heads and make them vulnerable to breakage).
- · Use short, circular strokes.

★ SHAVING WITH SHAVING GEL

· Follow the same instructions as dry shaving if using shaving gel.

★ CAUTION

 After use with shaving gel, please rinse the head and cutters under warm water to clean away any excess gel and debris.

★ Tips for best results

- Use moderate to slow stroking movements. The use of short circular motions in stubborn areas may obtain a closer shave, especially along the neck and chin line.
- DO NOT press hard against the skin in order to avoid damage to the rotary heads.

CARE FOR YOUR SHAVER

- Care for your appliance to ensure a long lasting performance.
- We recommend you clean your product after each use.
- The easiest and most hygienic way to clean the appliance is by rinsing the appliance head after use with warm water.

CLEANING CAUTIONS

☆ DAILY

- · Ensure the shaver is switched off.
- Open the shaver head by pressing the release button on the front of the shaver.
- Tap out excess hair shavings and use a cleaning brush if necessary.
- · Close head assembly.

★ MONTHIY

- · Perform the daily cleaning steps first.
- Open the shaver head by pressing the release button on the front of the shaver and flipping open the head away from the body of the shaver.
- Release the inner cutter carrier away from the inner cutters.
- Thoroughly brush hairs from the inner and outer cutters and rinse out any remaining debris.
- · Replace the inner cutter.
- Place the inner cutter carrier back onto the upper hair pocket and lock into
 place by rotating the locking arms clockwise until the arms 'click' into place.
- This shaver is a wet shaver, the hand-held part of which may be used in a bath or shower.

☆ TROUBLESHOOTING

 If your shaver battery is completely empty or the shaver has not been used for an extended period of time, the shaver may not start when operated using the cord. If this occurs, a 5 minute quick charge will allow for 3 minutes of shaving.

BATTERY REMOVAL

- The battery must be removed from the appliance before it is scrapped.
- The appliance must be disconnected from the supply mains when removing the battery.

- · Remove the headquard and the hair pocket from the shaver.
- Using a small screwdriver, pry off the front housing carefully.
- Using a screwdriver, remove 6 screws from the front of the shaver and remove the rear housing.
- · Pry the PCB assembly out of the shaver housing.
- Cut or break the wire stamps on the both end of the batteries and remove the batteries.
- The battery is to be disposed of safely.
