Use a screwdriver to turn locking nuts clockwise to lock.


Fitting back panel

Attach back 3 to the back with the coloured surface facing the inside using nails . Use nail holder 1 to hold the nails reference vertical and at correct distance as you secure the back 3. Nails should be spaced about 150mm apart.



Important: Furniture MUST

be 'square' when back is attached.



Step - 7

Preparing drawer Insert locking nuts **(B)** into left drawer side **(B)** and right drawer side **10**.


