

• Ensure that fingers and legs are clear of all adjustments when adjusting this product.

Important - Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

• Check you have all the components and tools listed on pages 2 and 3.

- Do not stand on the chair.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.
- Assembly of this product must be carried out by a competent adult.

- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.
- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.

• During assembly children should be kept away from the product due to possible risk of injury.



• To reduce the likelihood of damaging your product please ensure that your

power drill is set on a low torque setting.

- Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.
- Do not use this item if any components are missing or damaged.
- The max. safe weight should be 90kgs.
- Do not use the chair as step ladder.

Care and maintenance

• Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do no use bleach or abrasive cleaners. • From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit.

• This product should not be discarded with household waste. Take to your local authority waste disposal centre.


Handy Hints






The screws length is measured from the head to the point (30mm screw shown).

Components - Key Diagram Chair






Step 3

Mounting the right side onto the front rail and the back rail.

Press the right side 3 onto the front rail 4 and the back rail 5.

Fix the right side using screws (A) and allen key (B) through the holes indicated.



Step 4

Mounting the support rail onto the table top.

Press the support rail **6** onto the table top **1**.


Fix the support rail using screws through the holes indicated.

Step 5

Mounting the support rail onto the back rail

Press the support rail 6 onto the back rail 5.

Fix the support rail using screws through the holes indicated.



Step 6


Mounting the hinge onto the right side.

Fix the hinge (3) onto the right side (3) using screws (3) into the pre-drilled holes.

Step 7

Mounting the hinge onto the table top.

Fix the hinge () onto the table top (1) using screws () into the pre-drilled holes.



Assembly of the chair.

Step 8

Mounting the top plinth and the side rails onto the left leg.

Press the top plinth 10 and the side rails 11 onto the left leg 8.


Fix the top plinth and the side rails using screws (A) and allen key (B) through the holes indicated.

Step 9

Mounting the right leg onto the top plinth and the side rails.

Press the right leg 9 onto the top plinth 10 and the side rails 11.


Fix the right leg using screws (a) and allen key (b) through the holes indicated.



Step 10

Adding the seat to the chair.

Fix the side rails 11 onto the seat 12 using screws 10 through the holes indicated.



Assembly is complete.

Dear Customer.

Please note that the product you have purchased is a natural living timber.

Just like nature itself, wood varies in shape and colour. Knots, vein patterns, resin pockets and colour differences contribute to giving the piece of furniture its beauty and form - a natural part of solid wood.

Although the tree has been cut down and dried, it is still alive and therefore will react to high and low temperatures, light, humidity, drought and time.

In cold and dry periods, the wood contracts which may lead to small cracks in the piece of furniture. The reverse happens in warm and humid periods where the wood expands and this may result in slight unevenness.

The colour of the wood also changes with time, particularly if the furniture is place in a light place. This is a natural process and part of owning a piece of furniture made of solid wood.

Any flexing that has occurred during transport will re-correct it self once this product is correctly assembled.

Tighten all joints of the furniture after six months.
