

- Check you have all the components and tools listed on the following pages.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.

- During assembly do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.
- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.



• To reduce the likelihood of damaging your product please ensure that your

power drill is set on a low torque setting.

Care and maintenance

- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do no use bleach or abrasive cleaners.
- From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit.
- This product should not be discarded with household waste.

Ruler - Use this ruler to help correctly identify the screws

The screws length is measured from the head to the point (30mm screw shown).

Step 1

Attaching runners and hinges

a: Position the Left outside runners **(C)** in from front edge of the Left side panel **(2)**.

Use Screws **A** to fix the Left outside runners **B** onto the Left side panel **2**.



b: Position the Right outside runners **1** in from front edge of the Right side panel **1**.

Use Screws (a) to fix the Right outside runners (b) onto the Right side panel [1].



Step 1 - continued


C: Use Screws **B** to fix the Door hinges **①** 'back plates' onto the Left side panel **2**.

Insert Dowels into the Left side panel 2.

Screw Locking pins **G** into the Left side panel **2** .

Note: Insert locking pins as far as shown.

Do not over tighten.



d: Use Screws **B** to fix the Door hinges **J** 'back plates' onto the Right side panel **1**.



Insert Dowels **(F)** into the Right side panel **(1)**.

Screw Locking pins **©** into the Right side panel **1**.

Note: Insert locking pins as far as shown.

Do not over tighten.




Step 2

Attaching bottom panel

a: Use Screws • to fix Plastic supports • onto the Front panel 8.



b: Use Screws **©** to fix Front panel **8** onto the Bottom panel **5**.


Insert Dowels into the Bottom panel 5.


Step 2 - continued

b: Carefully locate the Left panel 1 onto the Middle panel 7 and Bottom panel 5.

Insert 3 Locking nuts tinto the Middle panel 7 and Bottom panel 5.

Use a screwdriver to turn Locking nuts $oldsymbol{\Theta}$ clockwise to lock.



e: Carefully locate the Right panel 2 onto the unit.

Insert 3 Locking nuts (1) into the unit.

Use a screwdriver to turn Locking nuts $m{\Theta}$ clockwise to lock.




Step 3

Attaching top panel

a: Screw Locking pins **(G)** into the Top panel **(4)**.

Note: Insert locking pins as far as shown.

Do not over tighten.




b: Carefully locate the Top panel 4 onto the unit.

Insert 4 Locking nuts (1) into the unit.

Use a screwdriver to turn Locking nuts ① clockwise to lock.




Step 4

Fixing back panel

Attach Back panel 3 using nails • .


Drawer assembly

a: Screw Locking pins **G** into the Drawer front panel **10**.

Note: Insert locking pins as far as shown.

Do not over tighten.








b: Fix Drawer right panel 14, Drawer support 15 and Drawer left panel 13 on to Drawer front panel 10.

Insert 5 Locking nuts
into the Drawer right panel
14, Drawer support 15
and Drawer left panel 13.

Use a screwdriver to turn Locking nuts (1) clockwise to lock.



C: Carefully slide the Drawer bottom panel 12 into the grooves.



d: Position the Drawer back panel 11 onto the unit using Screws **D**.



e: Turn the unit upside down carefully.

Use Screws **A** to fix the Left inside runners **N** and Right inside runners **L** onto the unit.


Inserting drawers

With help, carefully stand unit upright.



Warning:
The unit is heavy.
Lift with care.

Slide the assembled drawers fully onto runners.




Step 7

Attaching shelf panel

a: Slide Support covers onto Shelf supports on Insert Shelf supports (Support covers are included) into the unit. Ensure they are well fitted before inserting the Shelves.

Note: Set the shelf supports to the desired height.

b: Slide Shelf panel 6 into the unit.



Step 8

Attaching door hinges and handles

Fix 4 Door hinges **1** to Door panel **9** using Screws **3**.

Attach Handle Susing Screws .

Tear off the protective backing from the Door Pads ①.

Carefully stick the Door pads onto the Door panel 9.


Hanging doors


a: With help, slot Door hinges **①** onto 'hinge plates'.

b: Tighten screw shown to lock hinges in position.

Repeat **a** and **b** for opposite door.

See 'Hinge adjustment' in step 10 if the doors need adjusting.







Step 10

Hinge adjustment

a: To move doors up or down: loosen screws shown and move doors to suit.


Once doors are aligned, re-tighten Screws **B**.






b: To move doors in or out: loosen screw shown and move doors to suit.


Re-tighten screws.






C: To move doors left or right: loosen screw shown and move doors to suit.

Re-tighten screws.






Step 11
