

This child's bed is to be used with a 1900mm x 900mm mattress.

All assembly fixings should be checked periodically and re-tightened where necessary.

Children are likely to play, bounce, jump and climb on beds, therefore the child's bed should not be placed too close to other furniture or windows, blind cords, curtain pulls or other strings or cords, and should be placed either tight to any wall or have a gap of 300mm between the wall and the side of the bed.

Any additional or replacement parts should only be obtained from the manufacturer or distributor.

## Safety and Care Advice

- Check you have all the components and tools listed on pages 2 and 3.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.

- Do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.
- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.



• We do not recommend the use of power drill/drivers *for inserting screws*, as this could

damage the unit. Only use hand screwdrivers.

• Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.


#### Care and maintenance






## Components - Fittings

# **Assembly Instructions**

## Step 1

Attach the dowels **D** to bedsides **8**.

It may be necessary to tap the dowels in very gently with a small hammer.

### Step 2

Attach endrails 2 and 3 to leg 1 with screws using the allen key.

Repeat same procedure for second headboard


### Step 3

Slide T&G panel 7 between endrails 2 and 3.

Followed by 8 T&G panel 6 and finish with 1 T&G panel 5.

Attach leg 1 to endrails 2 and 3 with screws 4 using the allen key.

Repeat same procedure for second headboard



A variation of the width of the panels of  $\pm 2-3\%$  has to be expected as wood is a live material, i.e. variation of 2-3 cm per 1 meter.

Leaving some space at the panels, tongue & groove, should be distributed regularly along the bed end.

If there is too little space for the panels, these should be acclimatized for 2-5 days in order to adapt to the humidity of the room.


The reason for this problem might be that the wood has absorbed a little moisture during transportation/stocking.

## Assembly Instructions

## Step 4


Attach bedsides 8 to the legs 1 by pushing the barrel nuts 3 into the small holes in the bedsides 8. Push connecting bolts 4 through the legs 1 to meet the barrel nuts 3.

Then fasten with the allen key.



## Step 5

Repeat same procedure as described in "Step 4"



## **Assembly Instructions**

## Step 6

Place one slat 4 in the centre of the bed. Follow the measurement.

Place two slats 4 in the ends of the bed. Follow the measurement.


Push the bedsides 8 together whilst attaching middle slat 4 to the bed with two chipboard screws **©**.

## Step 7

Position the remaining eleven slats 4 in the bed with a distance of 73 mm between each.

Fasten each slat with two screws **G** 

Assembly is complete.



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
