




Attach the left leg 2 and right leg 3 onto the front leg 1 as shown using bolts **B**. Then tighten bolts using allen key **C**.






Step 2

Attach back rest 4 onto left leg 2 and right leg 3 as shown using bolts A. Then tighten bolts using allen key Cas shown.





Position the chair frame on the seat **5** as shown and attach through holes on the left **2** and right **3** legs using bolts **A**. Then tighten bolts using allen key **C**.

Step 1

Place the table frame 1 upside down on a flat protected surface.

Attach the legs 2 onto the table frame 1 as shown using bolts 4, spring washers D and flat washers C. Tighten bolts using allen key E.

Step 2

Carefully turn the table frame upright.


Remove backing from adhesive pads () and carefully paste on the table frame (1) as shown.

Then attach the glass top 3 panel using bolts Tighten bolts using allen key .
