





Tools required



Step 1


Prepare the drawer sides

a: Insert a large locking cam nut **B** into the left drawer side **9** and the right drawer side **10**.

Note: The arrow on the locking cam nut **must** point towards the hole in the end of the panel.

b: Push 1 of the quickfit dowels **A** as far as it will go into the left drawer side **9** and the right drawer side **10**.

Note: Only the plastic thread of the quickfit dowel sticks out from the panel.



Step 2

Fit the drawer sides to the drawer front


Push the left drawer side

9 and right drawer side

10 down onto the back
of the drawer front 8.

Turn the large locking cam nuts (3) clockwise as far as they will go to secure the panels.


Important: Make sure there is no gap between the fitted panels.



Step 3

Fit the drawer base

Slide the drawer base 12 down the grooves in the drawer sides 9 and 10 and down into the groove in the drawer front 8.




Step 4

Fit the drawer back

Fit the drawer back 11 between the drawer sides 9 and 10.

Make sure that the drawer base 12 fits into the groove in the drawer back 11.


Hold the drawer back 11 in position and tap the knock-in pegs 6 through the holes in the drawer sides 9 and 10.



Step 5

Fit the handle


Attach the handle **(K)** to the drawer front **(B)** using screw **(D)**.




Step 6

Fit the wedgefixes

Turn the drawer assembly over and slide 2 wedgefixes (a) into the front and back grooves, as shown, and tighten up the screws.





Important: Make sure that the drawer assembly is square before fitting the wedgefixes.

Step 7


Fit runners to the drawer

Fit the DL runner to to the bottom edge of the left drawer side , as shown, making sure that it is pushed up against the back of the drawer front . Use a bradawl to mark the fixing positions, then secure with 2 screws .

Fit the DR runner Ld to the bottom edge of the right drawer side 10 using the same method.

Step 8

Prepare the left side

a: Fit the CL runner La to the left side 1.

The 1st screw **H** uses the 1st hole in from the front of the runner.

The 2nd and 3rd screws use the holes that line up with the other panel holes.

b: Fit a screw **f** into the hole at the top of the runner **La**.

C: Insert 2 large locking cam nuts B into the left side 1.


Push 2 of the quickfit dowels **A** as far as they will go into the left side **1**.


Tap 2 wooden dowels **G** into the left side **1**.


Note: Wooden dowels must not stick out from the edge by more than 10mm or they may damage other panels.



Step 9

Prepare the right side

a: Fit the CR runner **b** to the right side **2**.

The 1st screw **H** uses the 1st hole in from the front of the runner.

The 2nd and 3rd screws


use the holes that line


b: Fit a screw **(F)** into the hole at the top of the runner **(L)**.


C: Insert 2 large locking cam nuts **B** into the right side **2**.

Push 2 of the quickfit dowels (A) as far as they will go into the right side [2].

Tap 2 wooden dowels **G** into the right side **2**.








Step 10

Prepare the shelf

Insert 4 large locking cam nuts **B** into the shelf **4**].

Push 4 of the quickfit dowels **A** as far as they will go into the shelf **4**.

Tap 4 wooden dowels **G** into the shelf **4**.



Step 11

Fit the shelf onto the left side

Push the shelf 4 down onto the left side 1.


Turn the 2 large locking cam nuts 3 clockwise as far as they will go to secure the panels.

Important: Make sure there is no gap between the fitted panels.



Step 12

Prepare the cross rail


Tap 4 wooden dowels **G** into the cross rail **7**.



Step 13

Fit the cross rail onto the left side

Push the cross rail 7 down onto the left side 1.




Step 14

Prepare the plinth

Insert 2 large locking cam nuts **B** into the plinth **5**.

Push 2 of the quickfit dowels **A** as far as they will go into the plinth **5**.

Tap 2 wooden dowels **G** into the plinth **5**.




Step 15

Fit the plinth

Push the plinth 5 down onto the left side 1.

Turn the large locking cam nut **B** clockwise as far as they will go to secure the panels.

Important: Make sure there is no gap between the fitted panels.




Step 16

Prepare the back rail

Insert 2 large locking cam nuts **B** into the back rail **6**.

Push 2 of the quickfit dowels (A) as far as they will go into the back rail [6]

Tap 2 wooden dowels **G** into the back rail **6**.




Step 17

Fit the back rail

Push the back rail 6 down onto the left side 1.

Turn the large locking cam nut **(B)** clockwise as far as they will go to secure the panels.

Important: Make sure there is no gap between the fitted panels.



Step 18


Fit the right side

Push the right side **2** down onto the assembly.

Turn the 4 large locking cam nuts **B** clockwise as far as they will go to secure the panels.

Important: Make sure there is no gap between the fitted panels.

Carefully stand the unit up for the next step.




Step 19

Fit the top

Push the top 3 down onto the assembly.

Turn the 4 large locking cam nuts clockwise as far as they will go to secure the panels.

Important: Make sure there is no gap between the fitted panels.



Step 20

Fit the back

Carefully lay the unit down onto its front edges for this step.

a: Square up the unit by making sure that measurement **x** to **x** equals **y** to **y**.

b: Place the back 13 onto the unit.


Nail **1** around the outside edges of the back **13**.

Note: Nails should be spaced out evenly.


The measurement from top corner X to bottom corner X must be equal to the measurement from top corner Y to bottom corner Y



Step 21

Fit the 4 plastic nails

Carefully stand the unit up for the next step.



Step 22


Fit the drawer

Slide the wheels of the runners fitted to the drawer, over the wheels of the runners fitted to the side panels and push the drawer into position.
