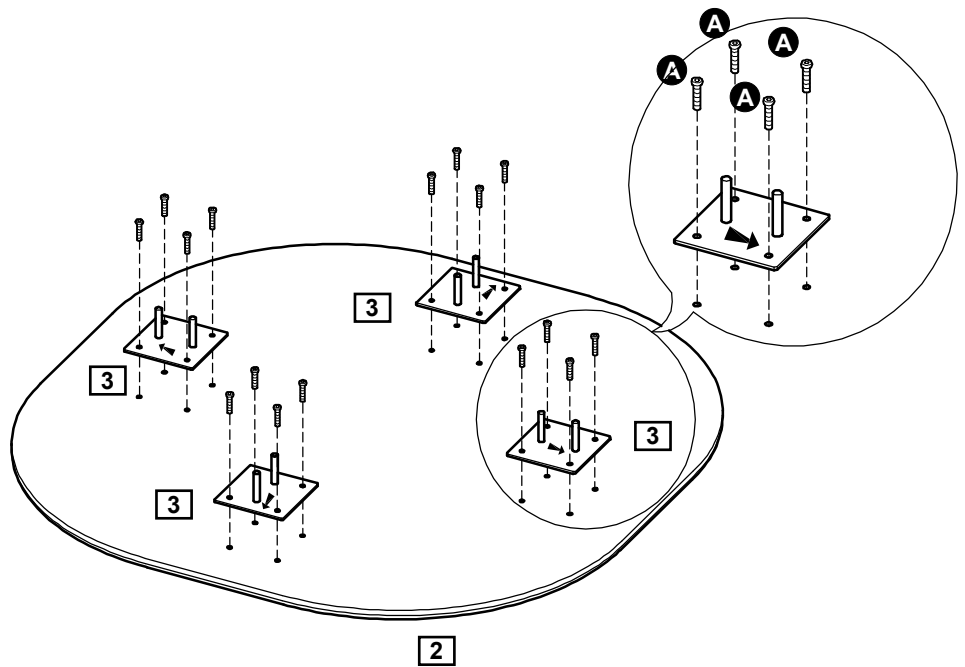
## Step 1

### Assemble table top

Place table top **2** upside down on a clean, flat surface.

Fix connecting plate **3** onto the table top using bolts **A** by using Hex key **D**

**Note:** The direction of the arrows should be pointed outward as shown in the figure.



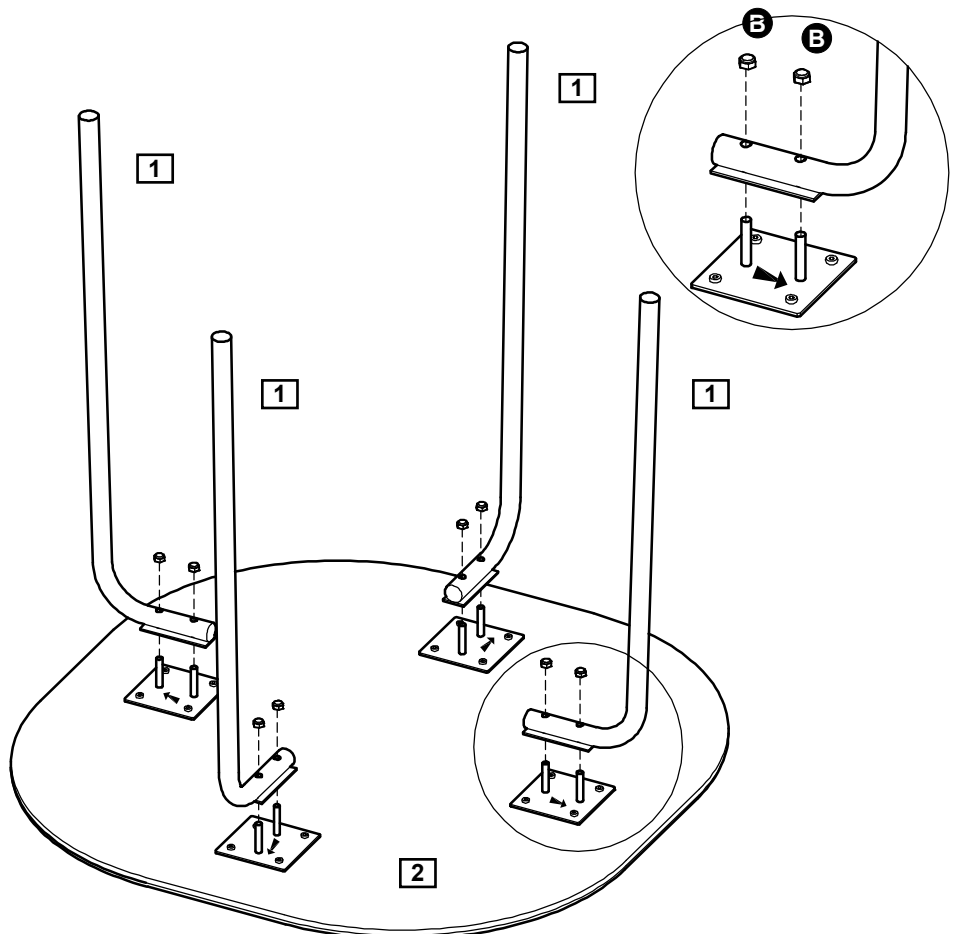
## Step 2

### Assemble legs

Position leg **1** over the connecting board and secure using nuts **B** by using wrench **C**.

**Note:** Make sure the direction of the table legs is the same as shown in the figure during assembling.

Assembly is complete.

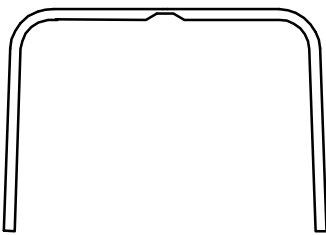
**1** Chair back x 4

## Ruler - Use this ruler to help correctly identify the screws





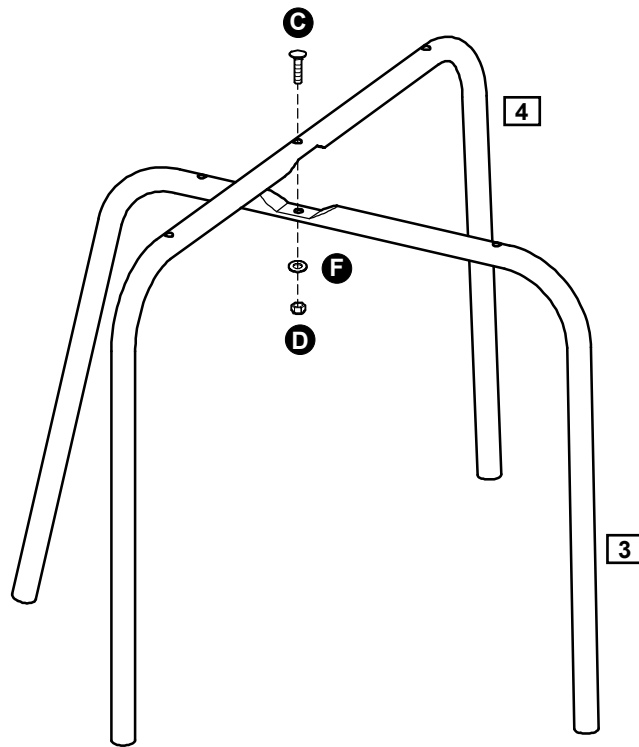
# Assembly Instructions

## Step 1

### Assemble legs

Assemble chair leg **3** and **4** using bolt **C**, plain washer **F** and nut **D**.

**Note: Do not fully tighten the bolts.**

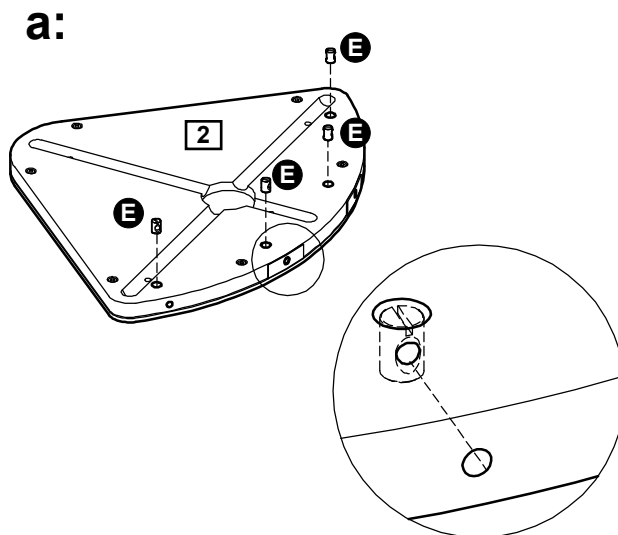


## Step 2

### Assemble seat and back

Two people are needed here

**a:** Place chair seat **2** upside down, put insert nuts **E** into the holes on the underside of the seat, make sure the threaded hole of the insert nut is aligned with the holes in the edge of the chair seat as shown in the figure.



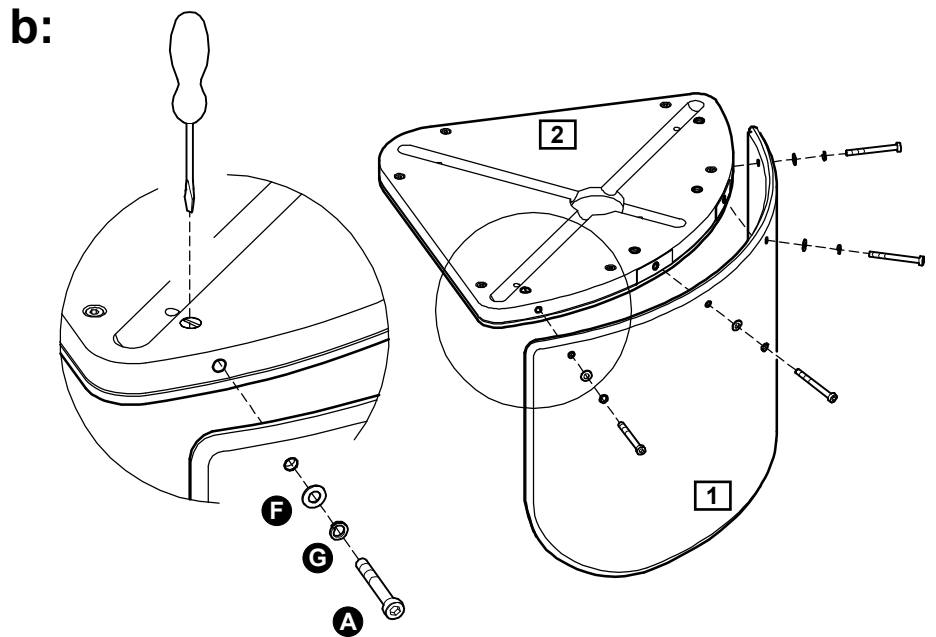

# Assembly Instructions

## Step 2 - continued

**b:** Assemble chair back **1** to the seat using bolts **A**, spring washers **G** and plain washer **F**, and secure tightly by using hex key **J**,

**Note:** Use a screwdriver to turn the insert nut slightly as shown in the figure if the bolt could not screw in.

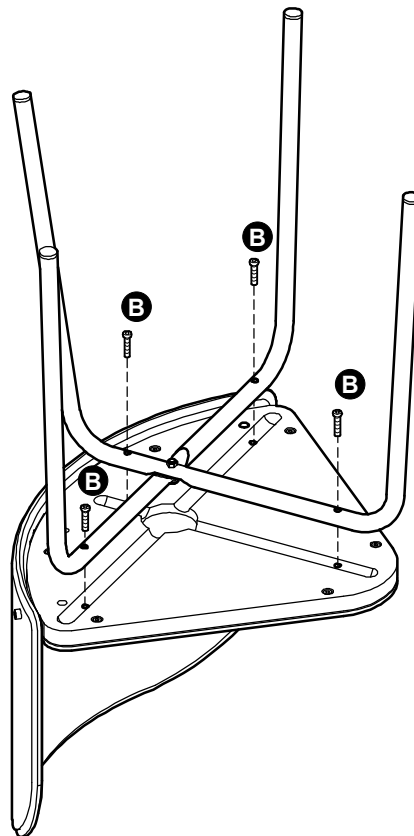


## Step 3

### Assemble legs

Fix the chair legs to the seat using bolts **B**.

**Note:** Re-tighten all the bolts and nuts.



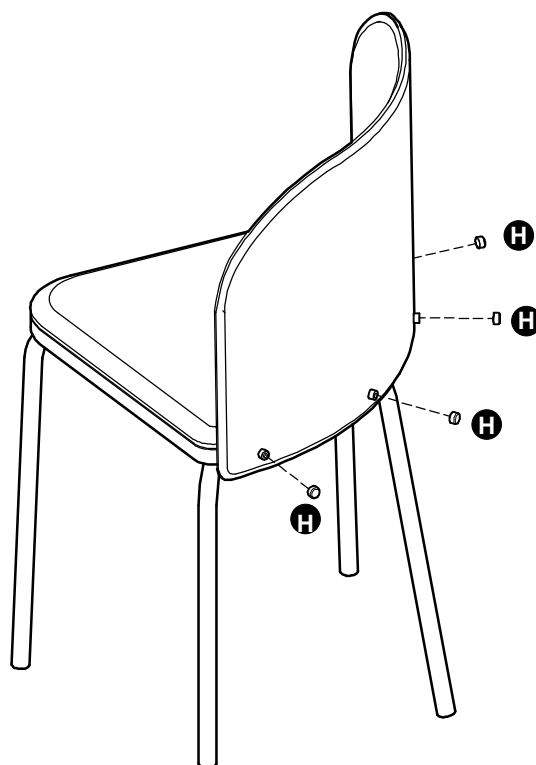

## Step 2 - continued

### Assemble bolt cap

Turn the chair to back to its up- right position, then cover the bolts on the back of the chair with bolt cap **H** .

**Assembly is complete.**
