Fitting the Legs

a: Insert Wood Dowel C into Stool Apron 3

b: To Fix Short Stretcher
4 onto Right Side Frame
1 . Also, use Tool A and Screw 3 to fix Stool
Apron 3 and Long
Stretcher 5 onto
Right Side Frame 1 .

c: Use Tool and
Screw to fix Left Side
Frame onto the unit.

Fitting the Wooden Seat
