

Safety and Care Advice

Important – Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

- Check you have all the components and tools listed on pages 2 and 3.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.

- Do not stand or put excessive weight on the product, this could cause damage.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.
- Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.
- Place the product on flat and steady surface during use.

- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.
- Keep these instructions for further use.
- To ensure an easier assembly, we strongly advise that all fittings are only finger tightened during initial assembly. Only upon completion of the assembly should all fixing points be fully tightened.

- If the glass is chipped or broken, stop using the product and consult the Manufacturer of Supplier.


- WARNINGS

Care and maintenance


- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do no use bleach or abrasive cleaners.


Glass top (140 x 80cm)

Note: The quantities below are the correct amount to complete the assembly. In some cases more fittings may be supplied than are required.



Tools required

Ruler/tape measure

Ruler – Use this ruler to help correctly identify the screws

Step 1

Assembling leg frames

Place leg frame **1** upside down onto the floor.

Screw large threaded rods (A) into leg frames 1) as shown.

Note: Screw the short end in until it stops.

Locate leg spacers **B** over the threaded rods.

Screw legs **2** onto threaded rods and tighten.


Repeat for other leg frame.


Step 2


Assembling side rails

Place top frame **3** upside down onto a clean flat surface.

Assemble leg frames to the top frame using fixings **O D** and **3**.

Step 3


Preparing glass top


Place glass top **4** upside down onto a clean flat surface.

Screw medium threaded rods (F) into the metal discs on the underside of glass top (4).

Screw nuts **G** onto threaded rods and use the spanner to tighten onto the metal discs.

Screw threaded spacers (1) half way onto the threaded rods.





Step 4


Preparing extension leaves

Place extension leaves **5** upside down onto a clean flat surface.

Screw short threaded rods ① into the metal discs on the underside of extension leaves 5.

Locate rubber washers ver the rods.

Screw threaded spacers **()** onto the rods and tighten.






Step 5

Attaching extension leaves

With help, turn frame over into it's standing position.

Carefully align glass extension leaves **5** with the brackets on the frame.

Secure from underneath using fixings **G**.



Step 6

Attaching main glass top

With help, carefully lower main glass top **4** down into position.



Warning: The glass top is


heavy, lift with care.


Following the extension procedure described in step 7, raise the extension leaves into the extended position.


a: Threaded spacers **()** can be turned to adjust the height of the glass top and achieve alignment with the extension leaves.

b: Once alignment is achieved, secure main glass top using fixings **(M)** and **(N)**.

Small rubber pads O can be located onto the edge of the extension leaves to prevent direct glass to glass contact.







Step 7

Extending and closing

TO EXTEND Pull extension leaf out from below the main glass top until it stops.

Push down on the handlebar to raise the extension leaf.

Once raised, push the extension leaf back in until it touches the main glass top.


TO CLOSE

Repeat the above in reverse order, expect the handlebar should be raised to lower the extension leaf.



Warning: Keep fingers clear of glass

contact area when closing/extending the leaves!
