

### **Cleaning Guidance**

• Minor stains and spillages should be removed immediately from cushion fabric, by wiping over lightly with a damp cloth and mild soapy water. • Light marking can also be removed using this method.

• To remove more stubborn stains or marking, a good quality proprietary domestic fabric cleaner can be used, although it should first be tested on and inconspicuous area of the fabric.





**1** Seat frame x 4







*Note:* Ensure the fixing brackets are facing upwards as shown.




## Step 2



# Step 1

### Attaching legs



*Warning:* Carefully place

glass top 1 upside down onto a clean flat surface.

a: Screw nuts (B) onto the end of short threaded studs (A).

**b:** Screw short threaded studs (A) into the metal discs on the underside of glass top 1.


Use spanner **(c)** to fully tighten nuts **(c)** down onto the metal discs.


**C:** Screw legs **2** onto the threaded studs and tighten.


*Note:* Take care not to overtighten.
