



Step 1

Attaching the seat

Place the backrest 1 on a flat protected surface. Position the seat 2 on the backrest 1 as shown. Align the holes and fix using bolts 4 and washers 6. Tighten the bolts using allen key 6.



Important:

Peel off bottom cloth cover of seat to be able to fix the bolts. Pull the cloth from the back side of the seat.

Step 2

Attaching legs

Carefully turn and place the chair onto a raised protected surface as shown. Insert the legs 3 into the holes of the seat 2. Align the holes and fix using bolts A and washers B. Tighten the bolts using allen key 6.


Step 3

Re-attaching the bottom cloth cover

Re-attach the bottom cloth cover as shown and fasten with the magic tape.

Carefully turn over the chair.

Assembly is complete.







Step 1

Attaching legs

Place the seat 2 upside down on a flat protected surface.

Insert the legs 3 into the holes of the seat as shown and fix using bolts A, spring washers B and washers G.



Important:

Fasten bolts using allen key but do not fully **D** tighten at this stage.

Note:

Use oval head of allen key **①** on tight angles.

Step 2

a: Attaching the seat

Place the backrest 1 on a flat protected surface.

Position the seat 2 on the backrest 1 as shown and fix using bolts A, spring washers B and washers C.



Important:

Fasten bolts using allen key but do not fully tighten at this stage.




Use oval head of allen key **①** on tight angles.

b: Attaching foot pads

Remove backing from foot pads **(E)** and carefully position on the bottom of the legs **(1)** & **(3)**.

Carefully turn over the chair.





Step 3

Aligning & securing the legs

Carefully turn the chair upright and place on a flat surface.

a: Tighten all bolts using allen key **D**.

Note:

Use oval head of allen key **①** on tight angles.

Note: This step is essential to prevent the chair from wobbling due to uneven legs.


b: Carefully sit on the chair and make adjustments to ensure the legs are flat even on the floor.

C: After the sitting test, re-tighten bolts again if any adjustment is needed.

Note: It is highly recommended to re-tighten all bolts after using the chair for 7 days.

Note: Keep allen key to re-tighten bolts when required.



Assembly Instructions

Step 1

Place table top upside down being careful to not scratch the table top surface (Leaving the product within its cardboard packaging will assist you in being able to do this)

a: Now attach the legs

2 (x4) to each of the corners, by first step insert spring washers B and washers into all the bolts A. Then screw the bolts A through the corner blocks and into the holes in the legs 2.


Tighten bolts by using the allen key D.

Tighten all 8 bolts securely.

b: 2 people are required for this next stage.
