Ruler - Use this ruler to help correctly identify the screws









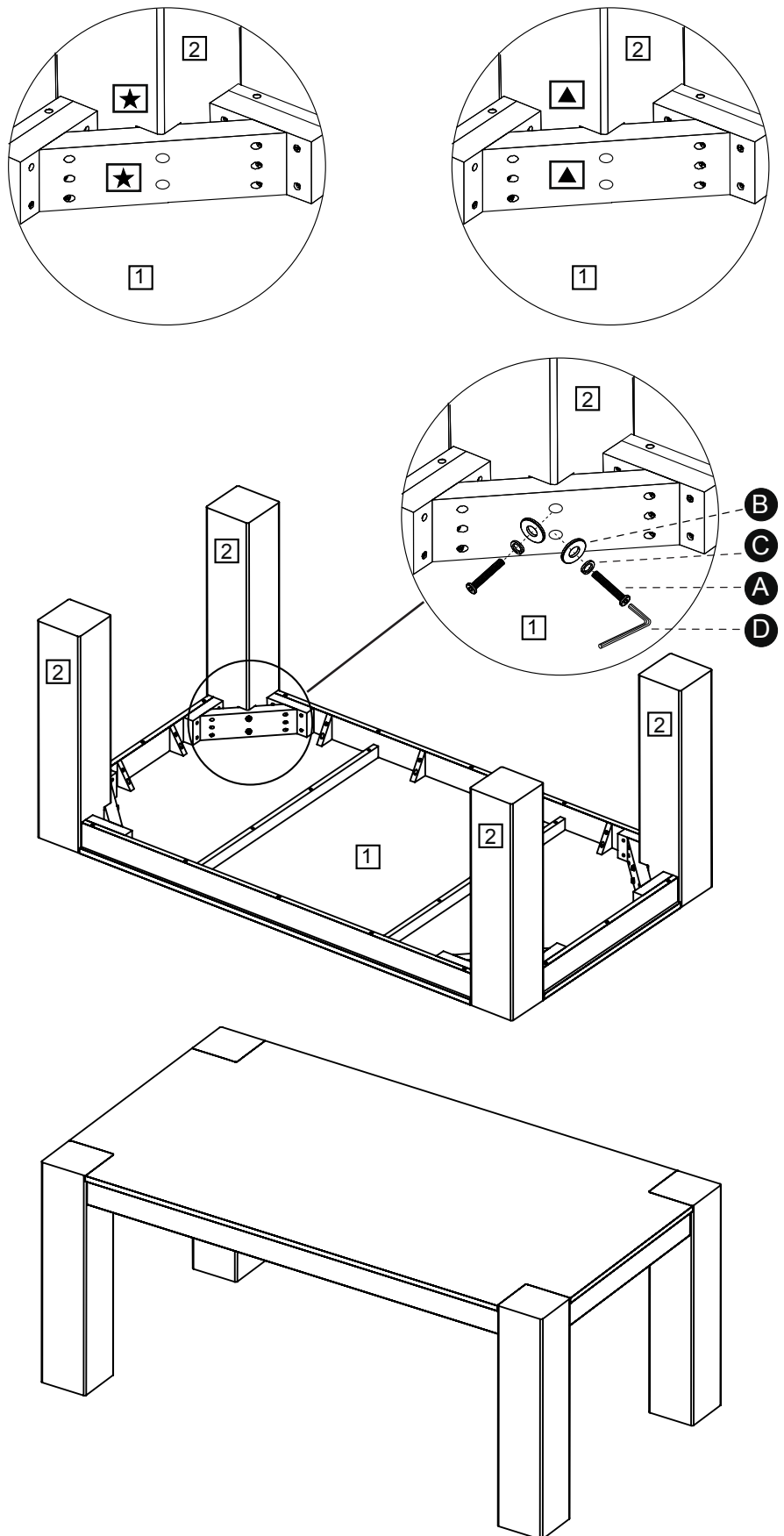
Assembly Instructions

Step 1

Attaching legs

Match the legs and table top corners by the symbols  & .

Attach four legs  to top  using washer  spring washer  and bolt . Tighten the bolts with hex key .

Turn the table over carefully.

Assembly is complete.

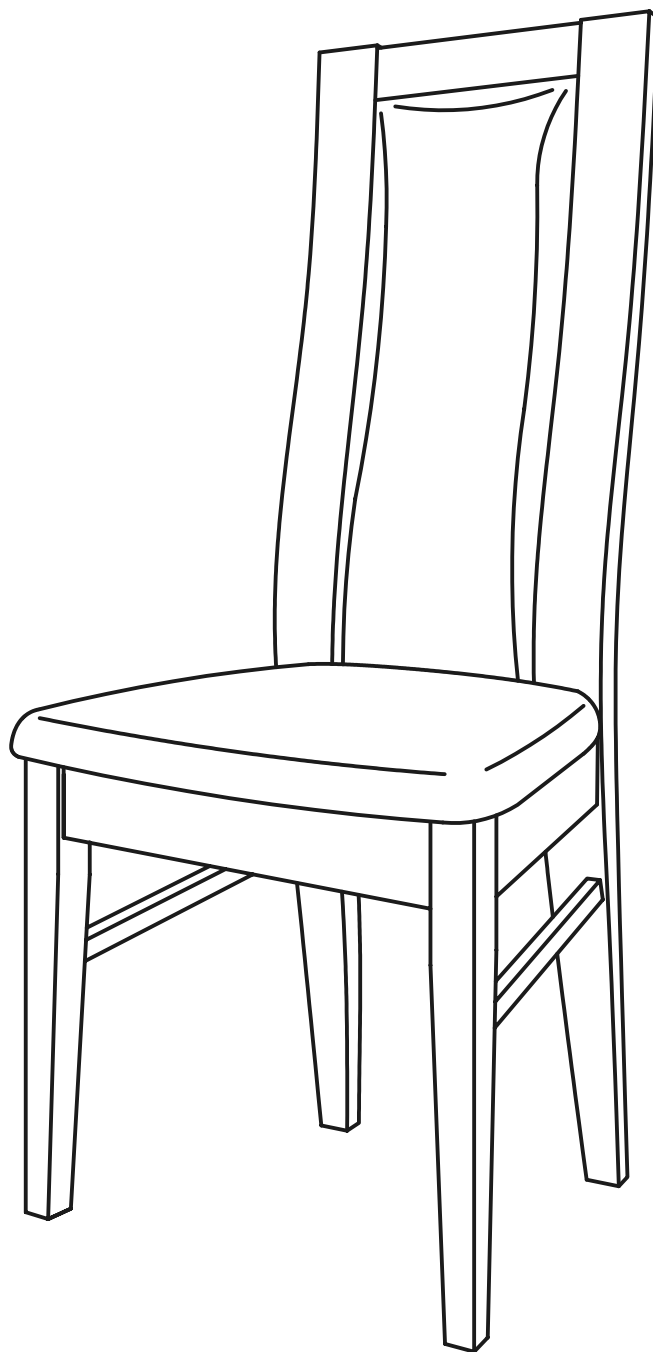

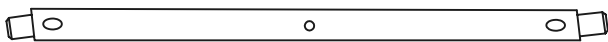

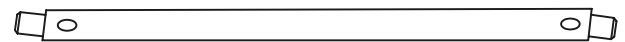

Assembly Instructions

Step 1

Fitting the Side Stretcher

Note: It would be useful to ask someone to help you at this stage.

a: Insert Screw **A**, Spring washer **B**, Flat washer **C** with Allen key **D** to fix side stretcher **3** **4** onto backrest. **1**

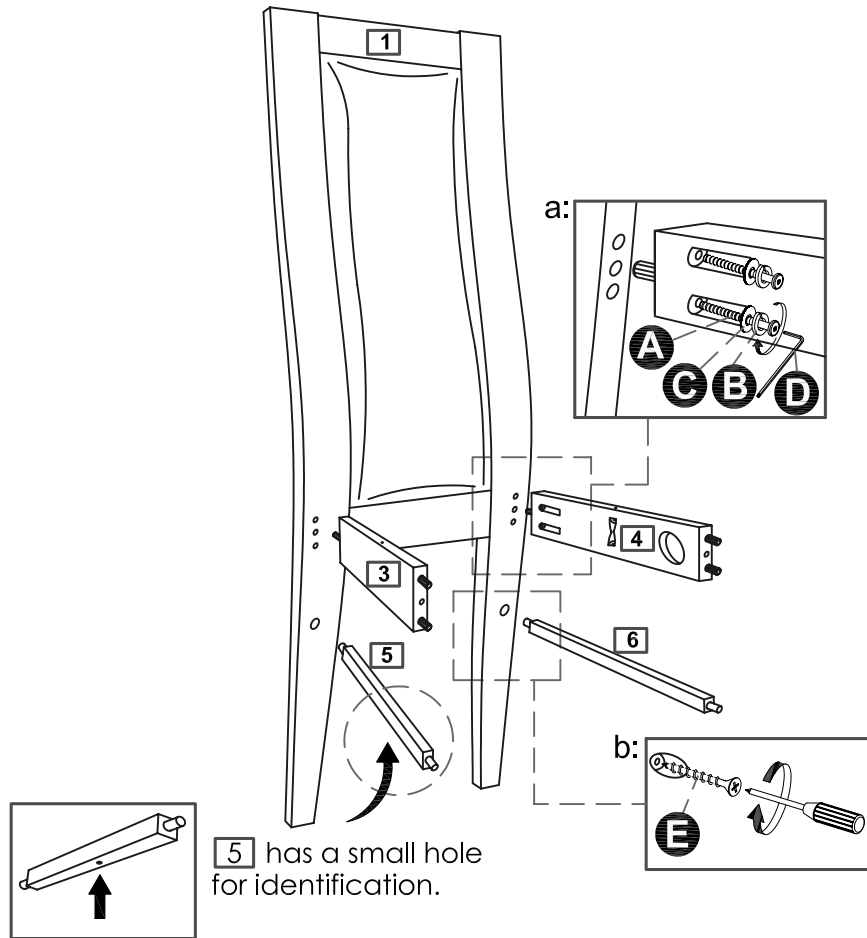
Note: Do not fully tighten all the screws

Fitting the Side Rail

Note: It would be useful to ask someone to help you at this stage.

b: Insert Screw **E** to fix side rail **5** **6** onto back rest **1**

Note: Do not fully tighten all the screws



Step 2

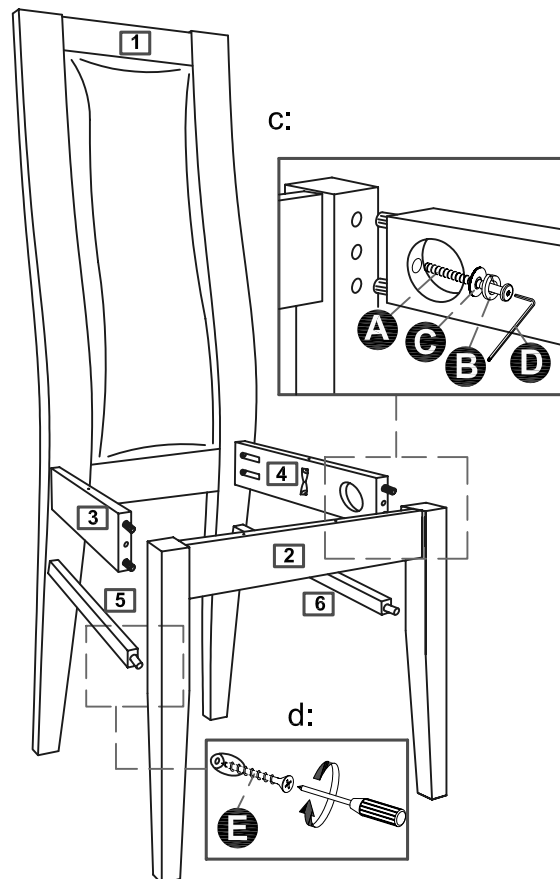
Fitting the Front Leg

Note: It would be useful to ask someone to help you at this stage.

c: Insert Screw **A**, Spring washer **B**, Flat washer **C** with Allen key **D** to fix front leg **2** onto side stretcher **3** **4**

d: Insert Screw **E** to fix side rail **5** **6** onto front leg **2**

Note: Do not fully tighten all the screws

Step 3

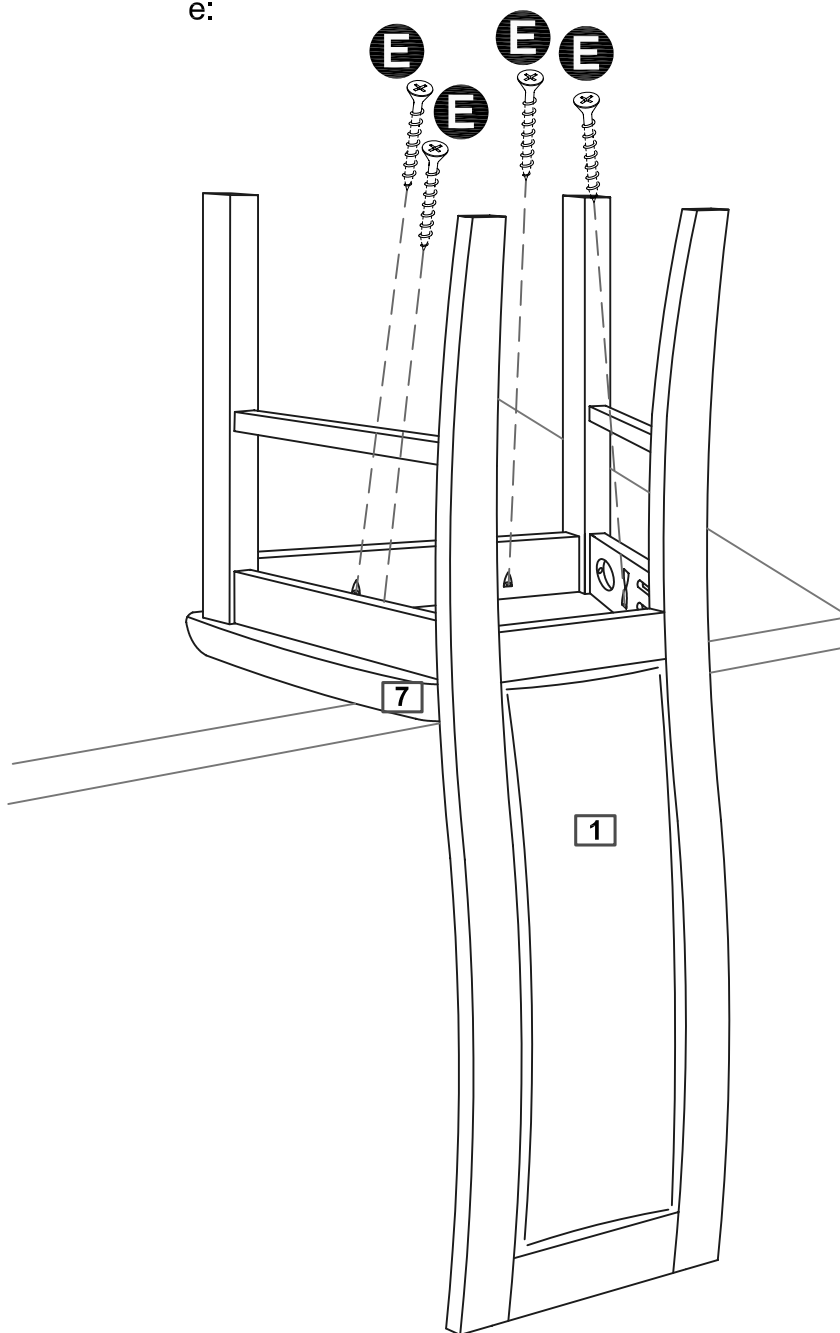
Fitting the Cushion

Note: It would be useful to ask someone to help you at this stage.

e: Use Screw **E** to fix cushion seat **7** onto the unit.

Note: Fully tighten all the screws now.

Step 4

Finishing the unit

Note: It would be useful to ask someone to help you at this stage.

With help, place the unit in the intended position.

Note: Before use always make sure the unit is secure.

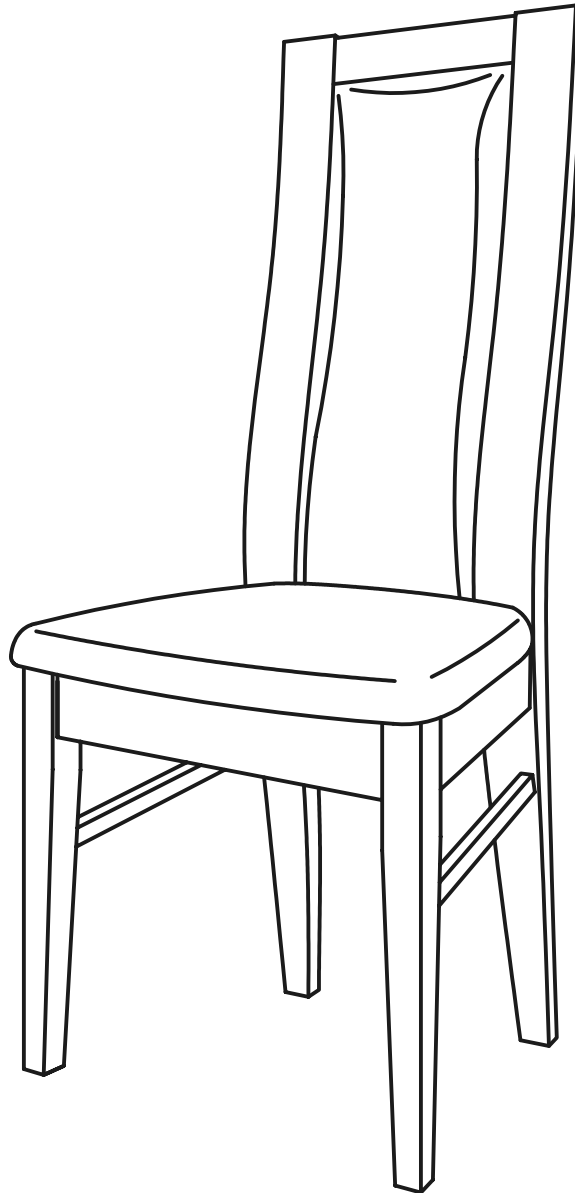
Note: The maximum safe weight of user: 110kg.
