





ASSEMBLY



- 1) Carefully place top glass ① upside down onto a clean flat surface.
- 2) Screw nut (B) onto end of threaded rod (A).
- 3) Screw threaded rod (A) into the metal disc on the underside of large glass top (1).
- 4) Tighten nut (B) onto the metal discs.



 Ensuring black plastic plug is facing down , locate stem² over the threaded rod.




Carefully align bottom glass





Step 1


Attaching threaded rod

Screw nut **A** onto one end of threaded rod **B**.

Place glass top 1 upside down onto a clean flat surface.

Screw threaded rod **(B)** into the metal disc on glass top **(1)**.

Fully tighten nut **A** down onto the metal disc.




Step 2

Locating pedestal

Slide pedestal **2** over the threaded rod.

Ensure the end with the plastic cap is facing down.




Step 3

Attaching glass base

Carefully screw glass base 3 onto the end of threaded rod.

Do not overtighten.




Step 4

Attaching pads

a: Peel off the protective film from self adhesive pads **\Olimin**.

Stick self adhesive pads to the **G** glass base.

b: Turn the table upright.


Fitting the tube

a: Stick the Glass pads **B** onto the Base glass **2** .

b: Screw in Two end threaded bolt **(A)** onto Base glass **(2)**.

c: Screw in Tube 3 onto the unit.






Attaching the glass pad

b: Screw in Metal rod 4 onto Base glass 2.






Fitting the top
