


a: Use Screws **B** to fix the Plastic Supports **A** onto the Front Panel **9**.








Step 1

b: Position the Front panel 5 onto the Bottom panel 2 using Screws 3.




Step 2

Two persons assembly is required.




Step 3

Two persons assembly is required.




Step 4

Attaching top panel


a: With help, carefully stand TV unit upright.






