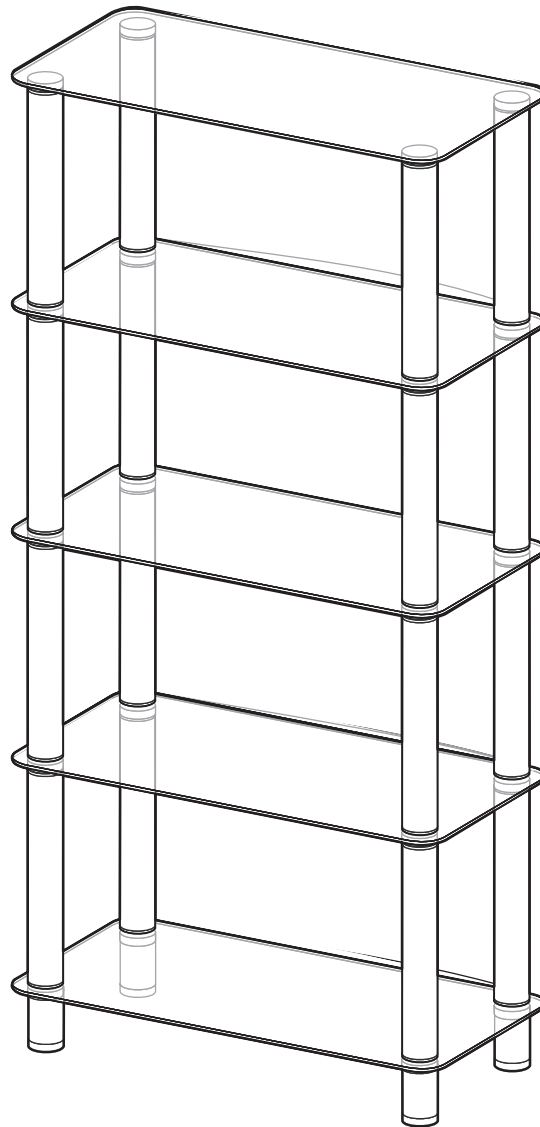

Safety and Care Advice

Important - Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

- Check you have all the components and tools listed on pages 2.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.

- Do not stand on the product, this could cause damage.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.
- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.



- We do not recommend the use of power drill/drivers for inserting screws, as this could damage the unit. Only use hand screwdrivers.
- Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.

Care and maintenance

- Only clean using a damp cloth **and mild detergent, do not use bleach or abrasive cleaners.**
- From time to time check that **there are no loose screws on this unit.**
- This product should not be **discarded with household waste. Take to your local authority waste disposal centre.**

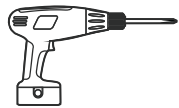


Wall mounting strap x 2

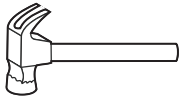

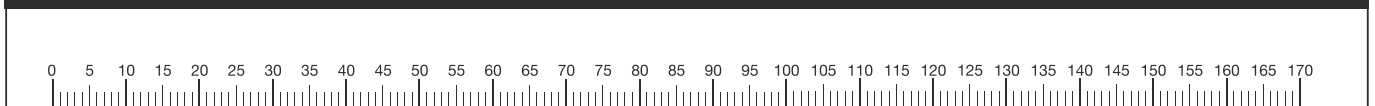

Ruler - Use this ruler to help correctly identify the screws

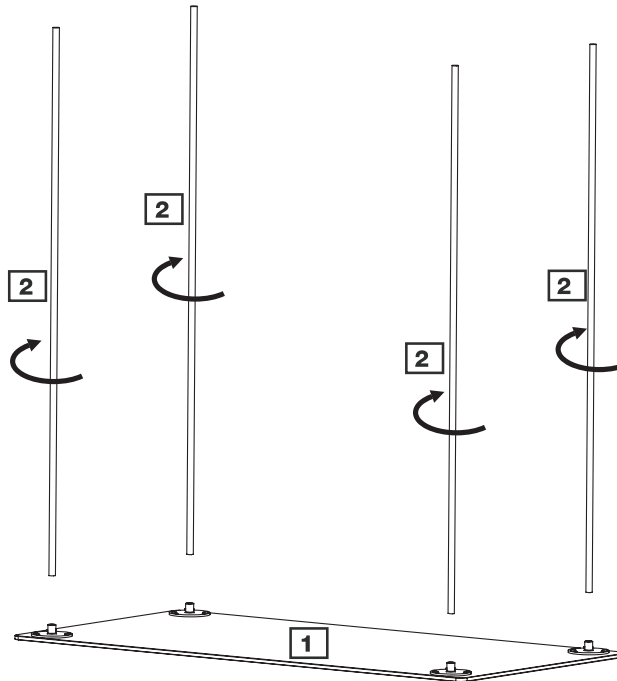


Assembly Instructions

Step 1

Fitting Metal Rod

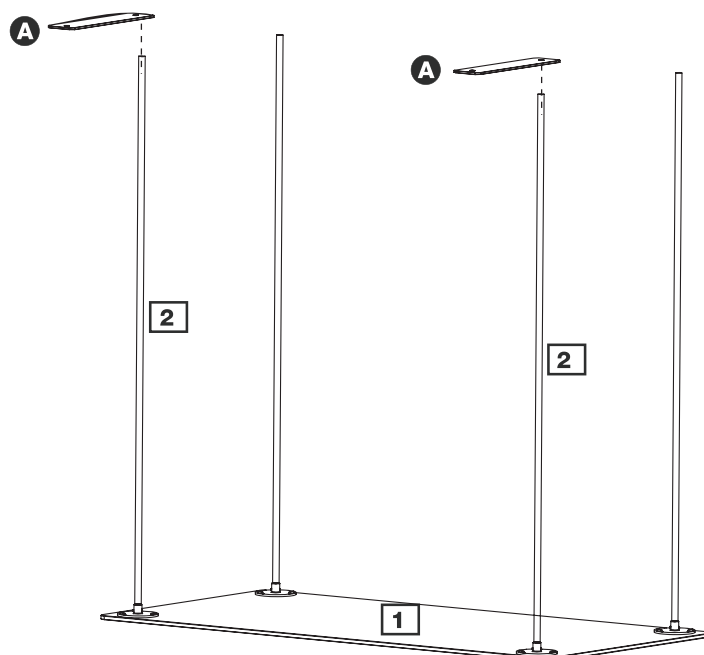
Finger tighten 4 pcs of metal rods **2** onto glass top **1** as shown.



Step 2

Fitting Wall Straps

Put 2 pcs wall strap **A** through metal rods **2** as shown.

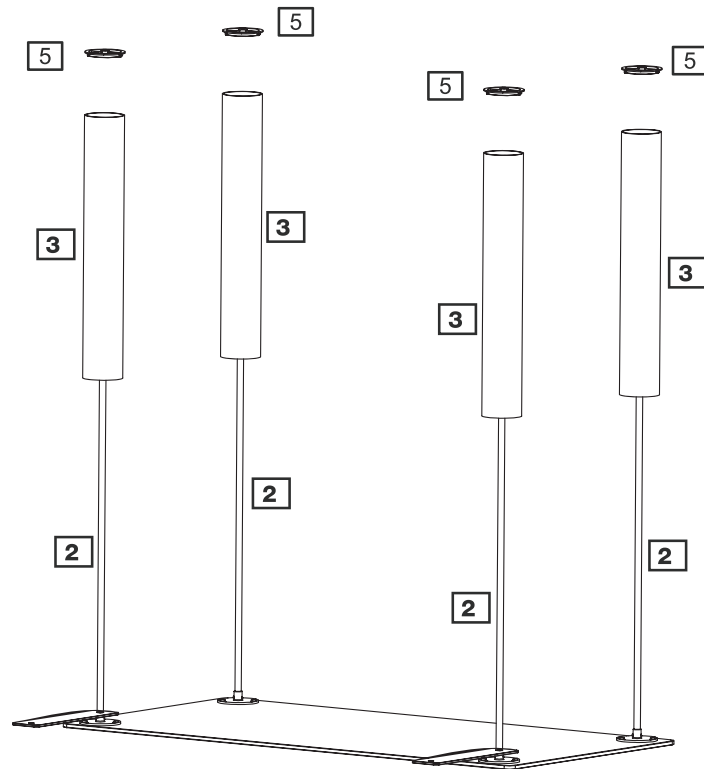

Step 3

Fitting Metal Tube

Attach 4 pcs of metal tubes **3** and 4 pcs of plastic pad **5** through 4 pcs of metal rods **2** as shown.

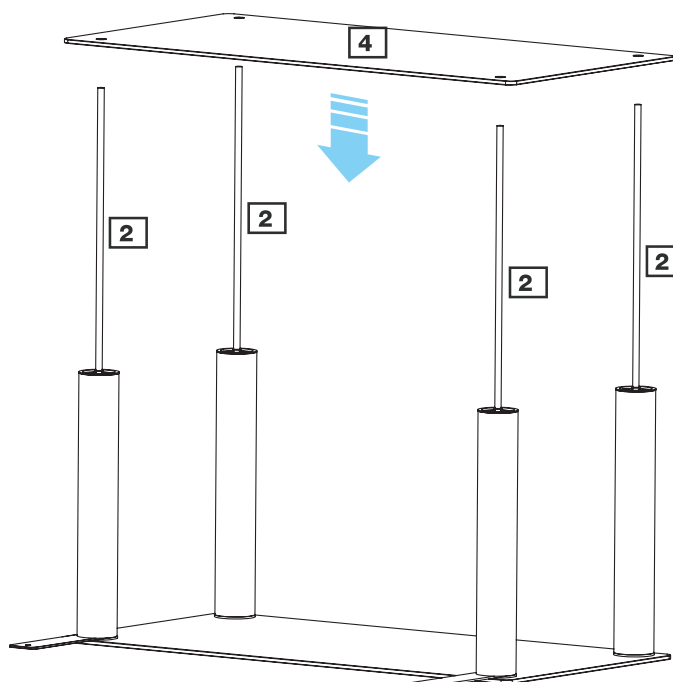


Matt surface

Attaching Glass Shelf

Please be careful to place glass shelf **4** through 4 pcs of metal rods **2** as shown.

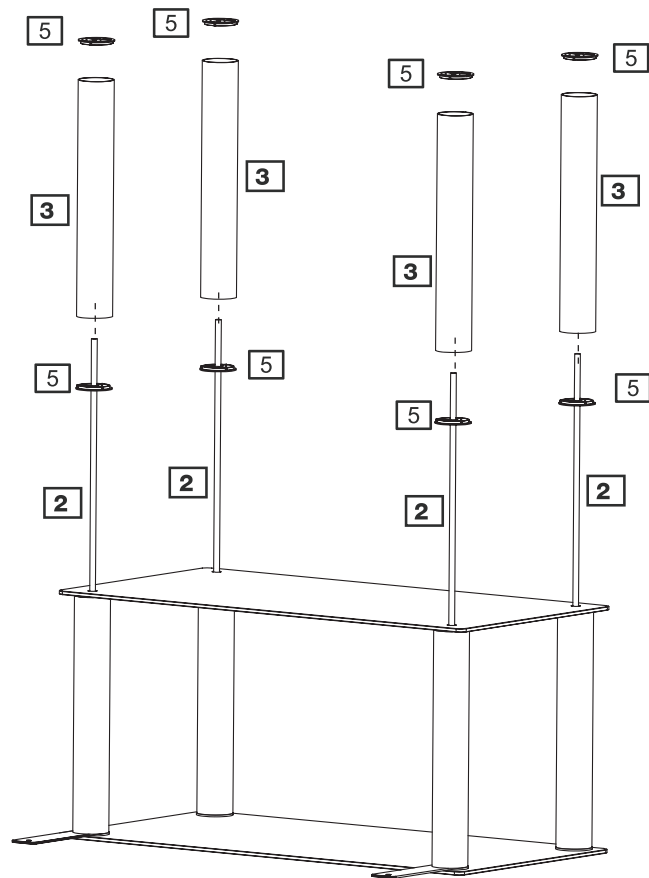

Step 5

Fitting Metal Tube

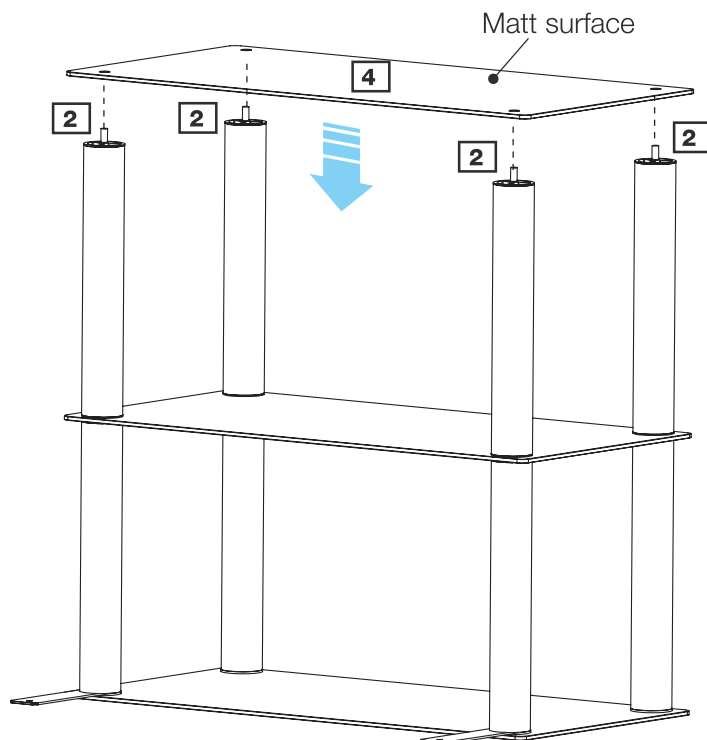
Attach 4 pcs of metal tubes **3** and 8 pcs of plastic pad **5** through 4 pcs of metal rods **2** as shown.



Step 6

Attaching Glass Shelf

Please be careful to place glass shelf **4** through 4 pcs of metal rods **2** as shown.

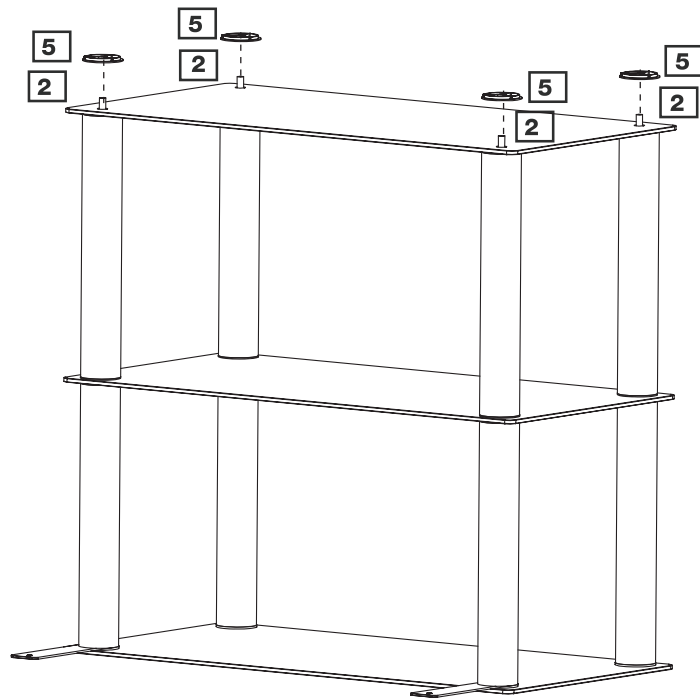

Step 7

Fitting Cap

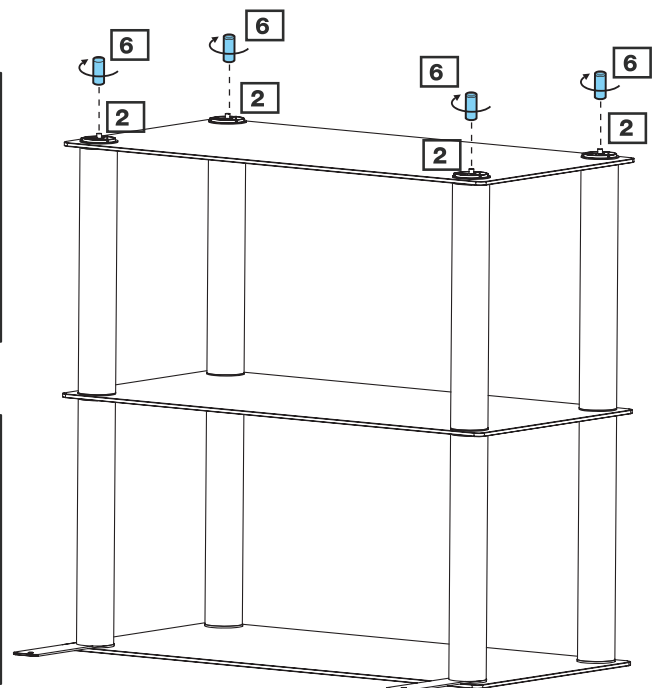
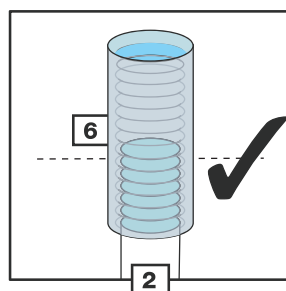
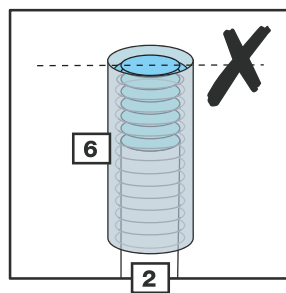
Attach 4 pcs of plastic pad **5** through 4 pcs of metal rods **2** as shown.



Step 8

Fitting connect tube

Screw connect tubes **6** halfway down onto metal rods **2** as shown.

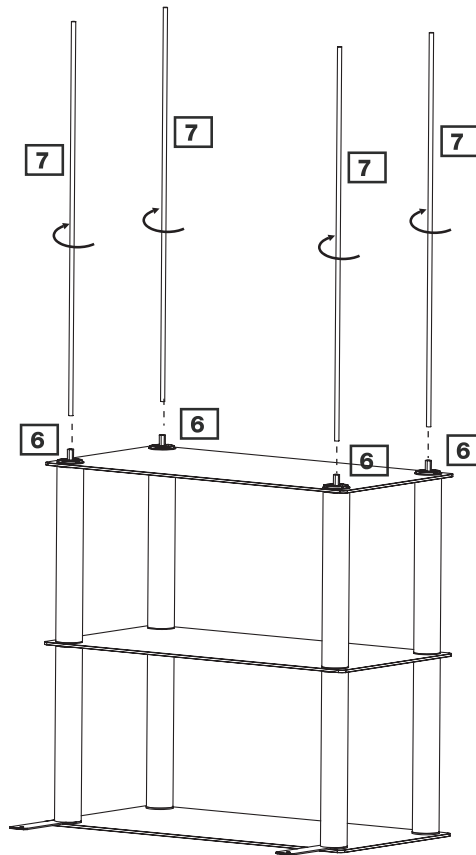

Fitting Metal Rod

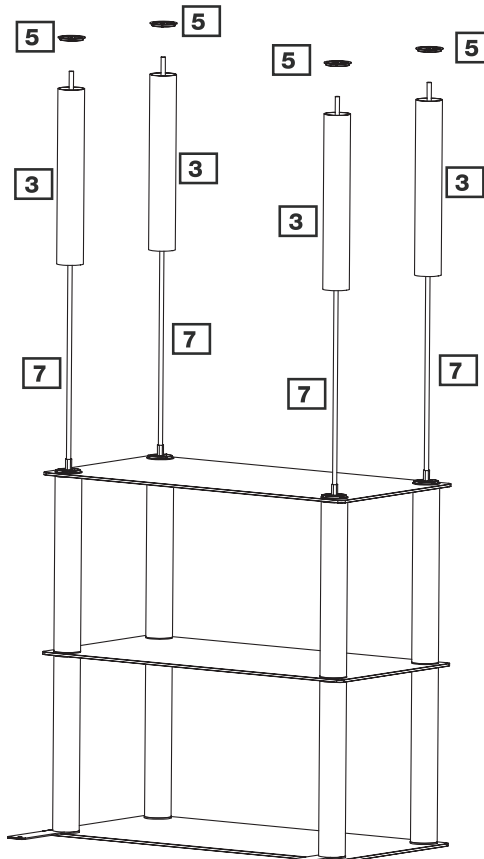
Finger tighten 4 pcs of metal rods **7** into connect tubes **6**.



Step 10

Fitting Metal Tube

Attach 4 pcs of Metal Tubes **3** and 4 pcs of plastic pad **8** through 4 pcs of metal rods **7** as shown.

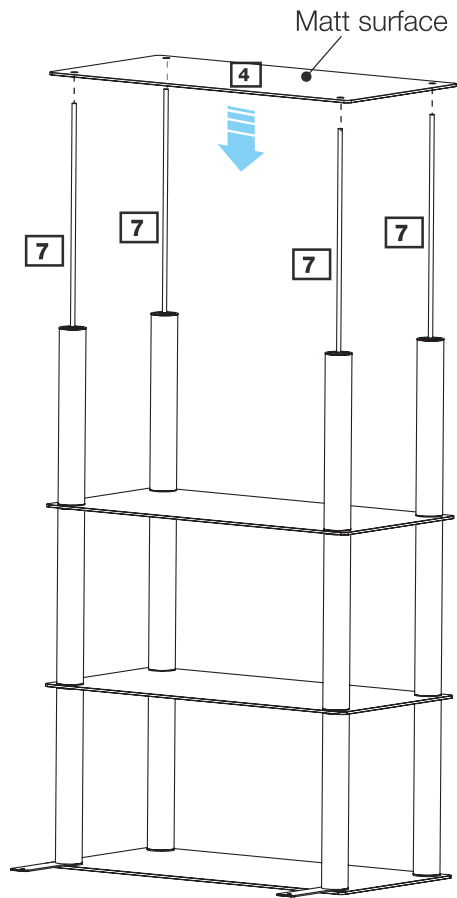

Step 11

Attaching Glass Shelf

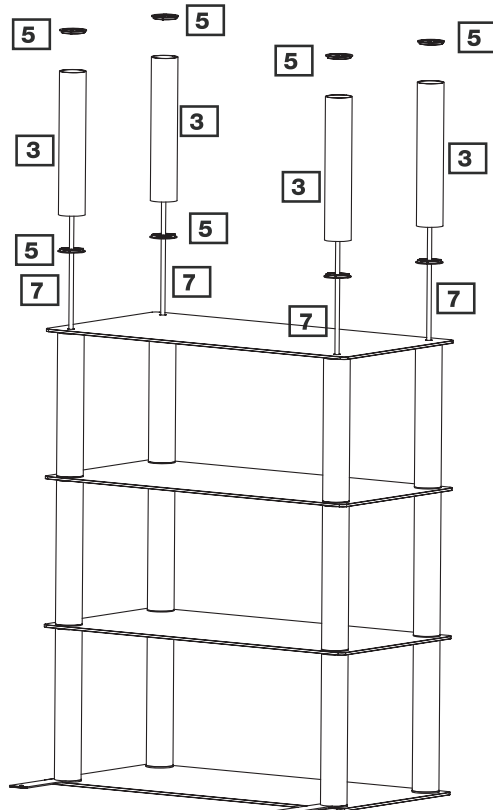
Please be careful to place glass shelf **4** through 4 pcs of metal rods **7** as shown.



Step 12

Fitting Metal Tube

Attach 4 pcs of Metal Tubes **3** and 8 pcs of plastic pad **5** through 4 pcs of metal rods **7** as shown.

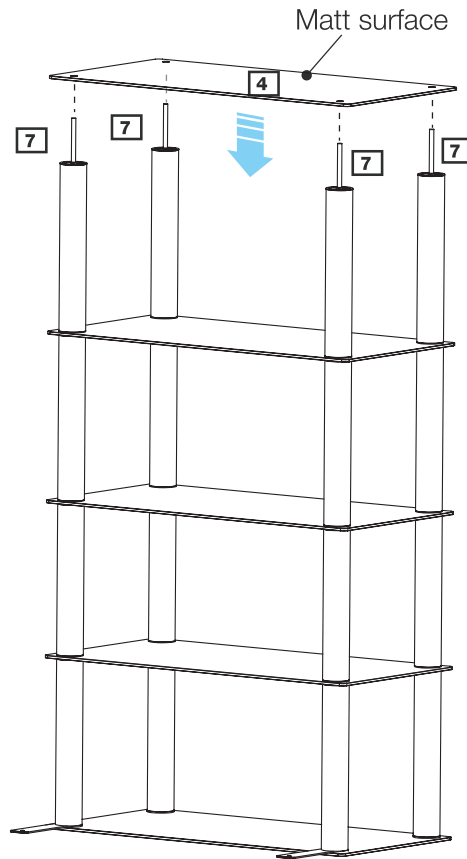

Attaching Glass Shelf

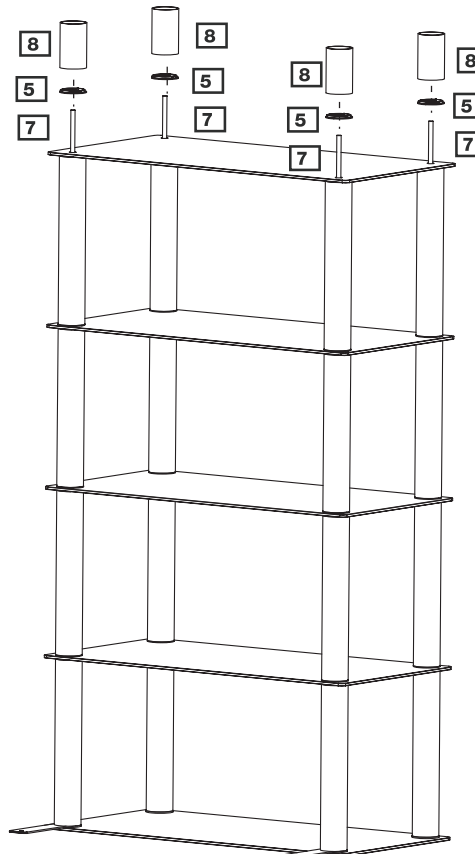
Please be careful to place glass shelf **4** through 4 pcs of metal rods **7** as shown.



Step 14

Fitting Metal Tube

Attach 4 pcs of Metal Tubes **8** and 4 pcs of plastic pad **8** through 4 pcs of metal rods **7** as shown.

Step 15

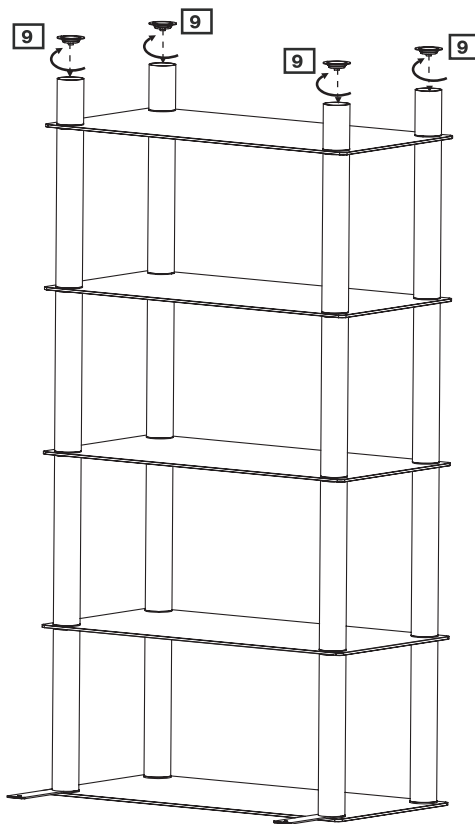
Tighten Feet

Tighten 4 pcs of feet **9** onto the unit by hand as shown.



Warning:
The unit is heavy.
Lift with care.

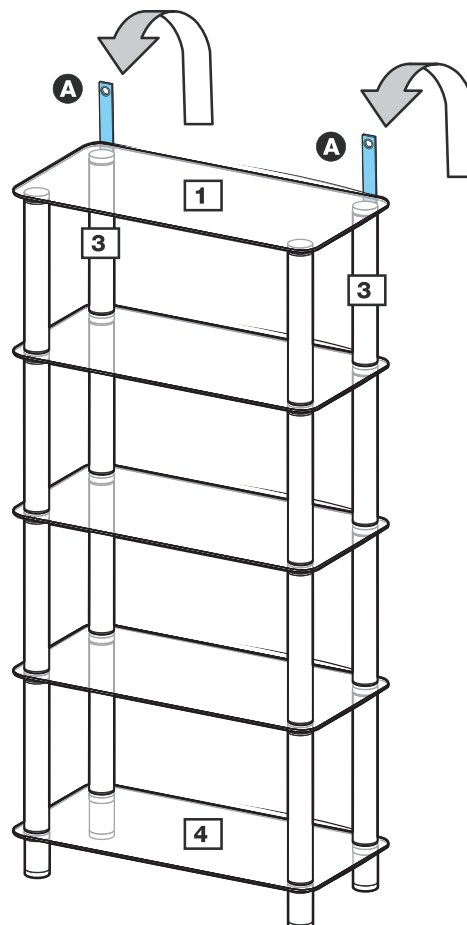
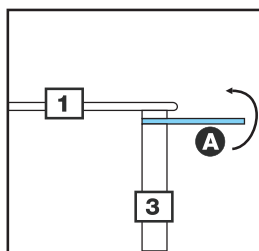
Turn the unit 180° upside down, prepare for Step 16.



Step 16

Adjust Wall Strap

Straighten up the wall strap **A** as shown.



Assembly Instructions

Step 17

Fixing to wall

It is recommended that the unit is fixed to a wall.

Fix wall strap to top of the unit by using screw.

With help, move the unit into position.



Warning:

The unit is heavy.

Lift with care.

Mark fixing hole on wall and remove the unit.

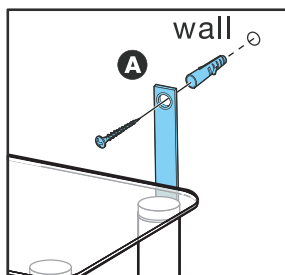
Drill 6mm hole and insert wall plug.

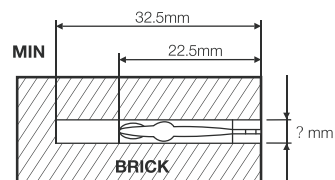
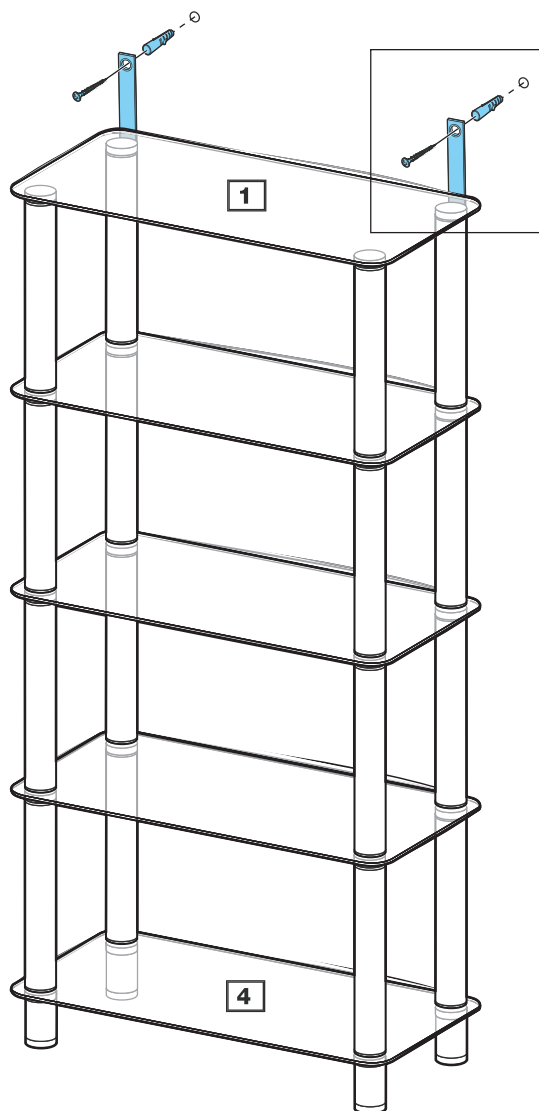
Before drilling, check wall for hidden pipes and cables.

Reposition the unit and fix wall strap by using screw.



Note: Wall plug supplied are for solid wall only.
