
a:Insert castors and into star base 7.


b:Turn star base **7** over and place it on the floor. Insert gas lift **6** into the center hole of star base **7**.

c:Place telescoping cover 5 over the gas lift 6.




Attach two armrests 2 to seat 3 with bolts **B** using allen key **D**.



Step 3


Assembling the backrest

Step 4


Use cap **6** to cover the hole of arms **2**.



Step 5


Attaching mechanism





- 2. Put Gas Lift in the Base unit. Then slide the Cover over the top. See fig. 2.

NOTE: Make sure the Metal Support is fixed tight and is fully inserted.

Stage 2 - The Seat Cushion

- Use the Screw to fix the Seat Support into the Seat Cushion
 See fig. 3.
- 2. Use the Screw Ato fix the Left Armrest and Right Armrest into the Seat Cushion. Then use Plastic Plug to cover the Screws. See fig. 4.



 Use the Screw to fix the Backrest in the Armrest. Then use the Plastic Plug to cover the Screws. See fig. 5.




Put Gas Lift ⑤ in the Base unit.

Armrest and Right Armrest into the Seat Cushion. Then use
Plastic Plug to cover the Bolts.
See fig. 4.




