Safety and Care Advice

Important - Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

- Check you have all the components and tools listed on the following pages.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.

- During assembly do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- · Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.
- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.



• To reduce the likelihood of damaging your product please ensure that your

power drill is set on a low torque setting.

Care and maintenance

- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do not use bleach or abrasive cleaners.
- From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit.
- This product should not be discarded with household waste. Take to your local authority waste disposal centre.

Handy Hints


- Assemble all parts and bolts loosely during assembly, only once the product is complete should you fully tighten the bolts.




Fitting Runners


a: Use screws **D** to fix Runners **G** onto panels **5** and **6**.

b: Insert dowels into panels 4 x2, 5, 6 and 7 x2.

C: Screw locking pins (A) into panels [5] and [6].

d: Screw cambolts **(a)** into panels **(4)** x2.


Fitting middle part

a: Attach panels 5, 6 and 7 x2 together.


b: Insert locking nuts **B** into the corresponding holes, and use a screw driver to tighten.

Step 2 - continued

C: Attach panels 4 x2 onto the assembled unit. Please ensure that the top of panels 5 and 6 where the bracket is fixed sits flush with panel 4 x2

d: Use half moon nuts and nuts to to fix cambolts onto panels and 6.

e: Tighten using the spanner **(1)**.

Step 3

Fitting Side panel

a: Screw cambolts **(3)** into panels **(2)** and **(3)**.

b: Use screws to fix lock onto panel 2.

C: Use screws **0** to fix angled bracket **6** onto panels **2** and **3**.

Step 4

Fitting Main Unit


a: Attach panels 2 and 3 onto the assembled unit.

b: Use half moon nuts and nuts to fix cambolts onto panels 4 x2.

C: Tighten using the spanner **(1)**.

Step 4 - continued

d: Use screws **D** to fix angled bracket **D** onto panel **4** x2.




Step 5

Fitting top panel

a: Attach panel 1 onto the assembled unit.

b: Use screws **1** to fix Runners **6** onto panel **1**


C: Once assembled, carefully lift and turn the table over. A minimum of two people are required to do this. When lifting, ensure that both locking locks are in place to prevent the top from sliding as it is turned. Ensure you are holding the table top securely closed and turn the table into an upright position, do not pivot the table on its legs as this could cause damage to the joints.



Step 5

a: Release the locks from underside of table and gently slide the table top over to expose tops of the legs, ensure that you support the overhanging table top whilst doing this. Apply pads onto the top of the legs and gently close the table top, securing it with the locks.

b: When the table top is closed, please use the lock 1 to secure the table top by locking into the recess on the underside of the table. To open the table ensure the lock is unlocked and gently slide the table top fully to the side whilst supporting the end of the table top as you do this. (Please do not slide the table top when it is open). Carefully open the table top and secure by locating the lock into the available recess on the underside of the table.
